

# GET TO KNOW DENTISTRY

## Introduction

The dentist, together with the physician and surgeon, is a key member of the health services team, specialising in oral health. It is the responsibility of the dentist to ensure that the teeth and mouth of his or her patients are in a healthy state. The dentist has much in common with the work of a doctor of medicine in dealing with infections and their treatment. Dental courses are just as rigorous and of the same duration as medical courses.

In recent years, there has been much emphasis given to Preventive Dentistry, but the dentist still deals with dental problems, including Restorative Dentistry. New techniques and materials are constantly replacing old ones and the dentist has to keep up with these developments. As teeth are not only functional but also affect the appearance of a person, the dentist has to deal with dental problems in such a way that the patient leaves satisfied. As a dentist, you have to be considerate, patient and tactful, guided by the highest professional standards



## **Course Organisation**

Courses in Dentistry generally have 2-years pre-clinical and 3-years clinical components, but this division is becoming increasingly blurred by the introduction of clinical elements during the 2nd year or even earlier.

Through early contact with patients, students learn how to communicate with them and take down case histories.

## Course Content

The content of the courses covers similar subjects, but there is variation in the way it is organised and delivered. During the preclinical years, the basic medical sciences are studied: Anatomy, Physiology, Biochemistry, Behavioural Sciences, and more. The clinical period includes laboratory practical work and much clinical work with patients, under supervision. A whole range of applied subjects will also be covered: Operative Techniques (preparing and filling teeth, crown and bridge work), Anaesthetics, Dental Materials, Dental Prosthetics, Oral Pathology and Surgery, Paediatric Dentistry, Orthodontics, Preventive Dentistry, Radiology, and more.

All these have direct relevance to clinical practice.





# APPLYING FOR DENTISTRY

## How it works

Applications are via UCAS only. You will need to register and complete a UCAS form, with payment, by the set deadline. Colleges will usually set internal deadlines for their students but the UCAS deadline is October 15, 2026.

Applicants are advised to enter FOUR universities of their choice in the UCAS application form leaving the other option for alternative courses, should they fail to gain admission for Dentistry. This will not affect their chances for Dentistry.

## **Entry Requirements**

Entry requirements to Dentistry courses are generally high, due to the large number of applicants for limited places, with a quota for overseas students. A Levels grades required range from AAB to A\*AA. Of the three A Levels subjects required, one should be Chemistry, a second Science subject, and a choice of a third. It is common for three Science subjects to be offered. Most universities prefer Biology as a second subject.

A number of universities will require an additional admissions test called **The University Clinical Aptitude Test (UCAT)**.

#### Non Academic Requirements

**Hepatitis B**: Once accepted on to the course, students will come into contact with lots of people who are not well. To protect students from Hepatitis B, universities will require that all students have their immunity status for Hepatitis B checked on entry.

**Letter of Good Conduct**: Before acceptance into a Dentistry course, you will be required to get clearance from the Disclosure and Barring Service (DBS). Malaysians can obtain a letter of good conduct from the Ministry of Foreign Affairs. You can apply online through <a href="https://www.kln.gov.my">www.kln.gov.my</a>

Other non-academic requirements include clinical experience through shadowing dental practitioners and evidence

of continuous community service.



## Selectors' Attitude

The selection process at most universities will be done in stages.

The first stage might be where the student's previous and current academic performances are assessed along with scores from admissions tests such as the UCAT.

During the next stage, the student's personal statement and reference are assessed. Shortlisted candidates will then be called for an interview

Interviews take the form of short panel interviews or Multiple Mini Interviews and are designed to test a range of non-cognitive skills such as:

- Resilience
- Maturity and responsibility
- Interpersonal and communication skills
- Confidence
- Self-awareness
- Empathy
- Ethics and moral values
- Awareness of the demands of training as a dental surgeon

## **Personal Statement**

Student's personal statement are assessed for evidence

- of:
   Interest in Dentistry
  - Participation in activities that demonstrate teamwork and communications skills
  - Genuine interest in people

UCAS has implemented a system called the UCAS Similarity Detection Service to verify the authenticity of Personal Statements. If significant amounts of similarities are detected and the Verification staff decides to flag a personal statement, the university and the applicant will be notified via email by UCAS.

To practice as a Dentist in Britain, registration with the General Dental Council is necessary.

Registration with the Malaysian Dental Council is needed to practice locally.
