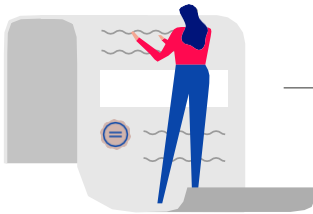

Introduction

Accounting is concerned with the provision of financial information for a variety of business purposes, including making decisions, planning and controlling activities, performance measurement and meeting external reporting and tax requirements. Accounting and Finance are woven into the fabric of our everyday lives and form an essential ingredient in any effective organisation.



Course Organisation

An Honours degree in England, Wales and Northern Ireland, would take 3 years in duration. An Honours degree in Scotland would take 4 years. However, Scottish universities do provide an ordinary degree at the end of the third year. Students with A level (or equivalent qualification), may also be able to obtain advanced entry, to some Scottish degrees (particularly Science and Engineering degrees), though not to all Accounting related degrees in Scotland – please check individual university requirements.

There are some programmes which incorporate a ‘sandwich’ element whereby students work under industrial placement for one year. The duration of these sandwich courses are therefore 4 years in total, indicated in the Course Codes & Fees section of this booklet as “4SW”. The tuition fees for the sandwich year is often a fraction of the normal fees and students are usually paid a salary.

Course Content

In general, introductory accounting is usually concerned with the principles of recording transactions, determining profits and valuing assets, as well as the presentation and interpretation of financial reports. Subsequent study may be a continuation of first year work, sometimes concentrating on particular aspects of financial accounting, or may concentrate on relating the subject to general problems of business, usually by dealing with cost and management accounting. Here, accounting is seen as a crucial aid to management decision making in the areas of costing, investment, budgetary control, external and internal financing and future financial planning.

The degrees included in the handout, while focused on Accountancy and Accountancy & Finance degrees, come with various titles – Accountancy, Accounting, Accounting & Finance, etc. Do not judge a degree by its title only. For example, do not assume that a degree titled Accountancy will not include any modules in Finance – most will. Please refer to official university websites and the UCAS website for information on other Accounting related degrees.

Make sure you find out about the syllabus of each degree, by looking this up on the university website – every degree has its own unique features i.e. subjects being offered, modes of assessment (for example, written exams or continuous assessment – or both), opportunities for industrial placement, etc.

You should decide on a degree which contains courses that meet your interests and expectations and which allows flexibility.



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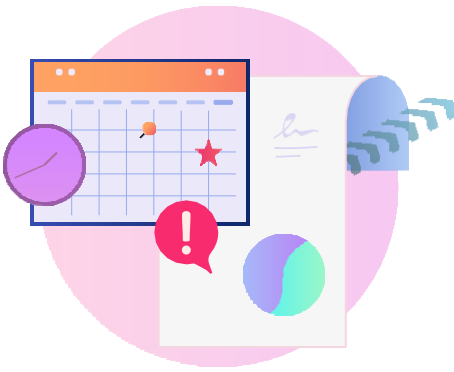

How it works

Applications for undergraduate degrees for most of the UK universities go via UCAS. You will need to register and complete the UCAS form, with payment, by the set deadline. Colleges will usually set internal deadlines for their students. With the exception of Oxford and Cambridge, the UCAS deadline for competitive universities is January 13, 2027.

The final deadline of UCAS application is June 30.

Personal Statement

Students need to outline personal characteristics, skills and attributes and how that relates to the current academic study and chosen degree course. Additional reading or relevant experiences in or outside of school which led you to choosing Accounting and Finance should also be included. Students' efforts and initiatives in making the most of the opportunities available to them to deepen their knowledge and understanding of their intended programme of study is highly desirable.

Extracurricular activities can also be included to indicate that you can multitask and have a wide range of interests and skills.

Career Path
