



Pater Noster used to give hope and direction to seafarers. Today the hotel is a guiding light in nature conservation by sponsoring an equivalent amount of rainforest for every cubic meter of accommodation at Pater Noster.




Meanwhile, scientists receive crucial data to understand and mitigate climate change, all based on a vetted methodology by Green Cubes.
