INTRODUCTION

We’re called to exercise citizenship worthy of the gospel of Christ (Philippians 1:27a).

We live in a country where God has entrusted us with the responsibility of choosing our leaders, so part of “citizenship worthy of the gospel” is learning how the Bible informs our vote. We know that’s what would honor God, but sorting through the noise is difficult. In our ultra-polarized culture, it’s easy for Christians and churches to tune out, abstain from voting, or vote for one party because we always have, all while avoiding the dirty work of researching the people or issues on our ballot.

But is this approach to voting how we are called to engage during election season? Like all of us, every individual on our ballots is flawed. But skipping this election or blindly casting your vote is not the answer. **God has given us the incredible gift of choosing our leaders at every level of government - let’s honor Him with it.** This guide will help you see where candidates stand on some of the issues most important to Christians in Minnesota so you can practice biblical citizenship. The answers aren’t always simple, but our goal is to help you and your family honor God with your votes this fall. Working with churches across the state, we’ve concluded that the issues in the following pages, though certainly not the only ones at stake in this election, are essential for Christians to think through as we prayerfully prepare to make a decision this fall.

..... ISSUES FOR CANDIDATES

ABORTION & LIFE Christians believe God knew each person before He formed him or her in the womb (Jeremiah 1:5) and has numbered all the days of each life (Job 14:5). Accordingly, our survey asked state candidates their positions on abortion being legal up to the moment of birth and protections for babies born alive during an abortion. Our survey asked federal candidates their position on taxpayer funding of abortions and state candidates their position on the legalization of commercial surrogacy.

SEXED IDENTITY AND MARRIAGE God created each person male or female (Genesis 5:2) and no child is born in the wrong body. Our survey asked candidates for their position on protecting women and girls in athletics and private facilities. We asked federal candidates for their positions on taxpayer funding of sex-rejecting procedures and the so-called “Respect for Marriage Act” which recognized same-sex unions as marriage in federal law.

SCHOOL CHOICE Christians believe parents should have responsibility for their children’s education choices. Our survey asked candidates for their position on making this easier for all Minnesota families, for example, by making school choice available.

RELIGIOUS FREEDOM Our survey asked state candidates their position on protecting religious freedom so that Minnesotans of faith can “live peaceably with all” (Romans 12:18).

PARENTAL RIGHTS Christians believe parents have been entrusted by God to bring their children up in the nurture and admonition of the Lord (Ephesians 6:4). Our survey asked statewide candidates for their position on Minnesota’s new law which allows courts to take temporary emergency jurisdiction of a child if the child has been unable to obtain sex-rejecting procedures. We asked federal candidates for their position on a parent’s fundamental right to direct the upbringing of their children.

LOCAL AND JUDICIAL RACES PRIMER

In addition to candidates for state and federal office, you will have the chance to vote in local and judicial elections. Local elections for school board, city council, sheriff, county attorney, county commissioner, and other races are very important - do your research and find out which candidates best represent your values.

You will also have the opportunity to vote in judicial races for State Supreme Court, District Court, and Court of Appeals. Judicial elections in Minnesota are nonpartisan, and many judges will be running for reelection unopposed by another candidate. Use the **myballotmn.sos**.

state.mn.us website to find your sample ballot and see if there are any contested judicial races in your area. Then, research the candidates and find out which, if any, best represent your values. Remember, you can leave this section of your ballot blank if you believe there are no good options.

..... SOURCED POSITIONS

Minnesota Family Council (MFC) extensively researched answers for all the candidates who declined to respond to the survey. You can access the sources for these answers on the digital version of this voter guide at MFC.org/voterguide. MFC does not speak for any candidate who has not answered the survey. However, in some cases, information relating to a candidate’s position on an issue is publicly available. This information may include a candidate’s voting records (if the candidate is an incumbent,) public statements, endorsement by a relevant nonprofit, or other credible sources. Based on this publicly available information, a vote on or authorship of a bill directly related to this issue is represented by a “Yes” “ or “No” .” Some candidate position statements have been determined after extensive research and are represented with “Yes*” (Yes based on statement, endorsement by a relevant organization, or vote on a related bill) or “No*” (No based on statement, endorsement by a relevant organization, or vote on a related bill.) If it is unclear or unknown where a candidate stands on a given issue, the answer has been marked with a “?”. Minnesota Family Council stands by the reliability of these sourced positions, but it is always possible that a candidate’s position has not been accurately represented in the public sources available to us. If you have concerns about the answers given for any particular candidate, or if you are dissatisfied with the sources used to infer a position, please contact the candidate directly for clarity.

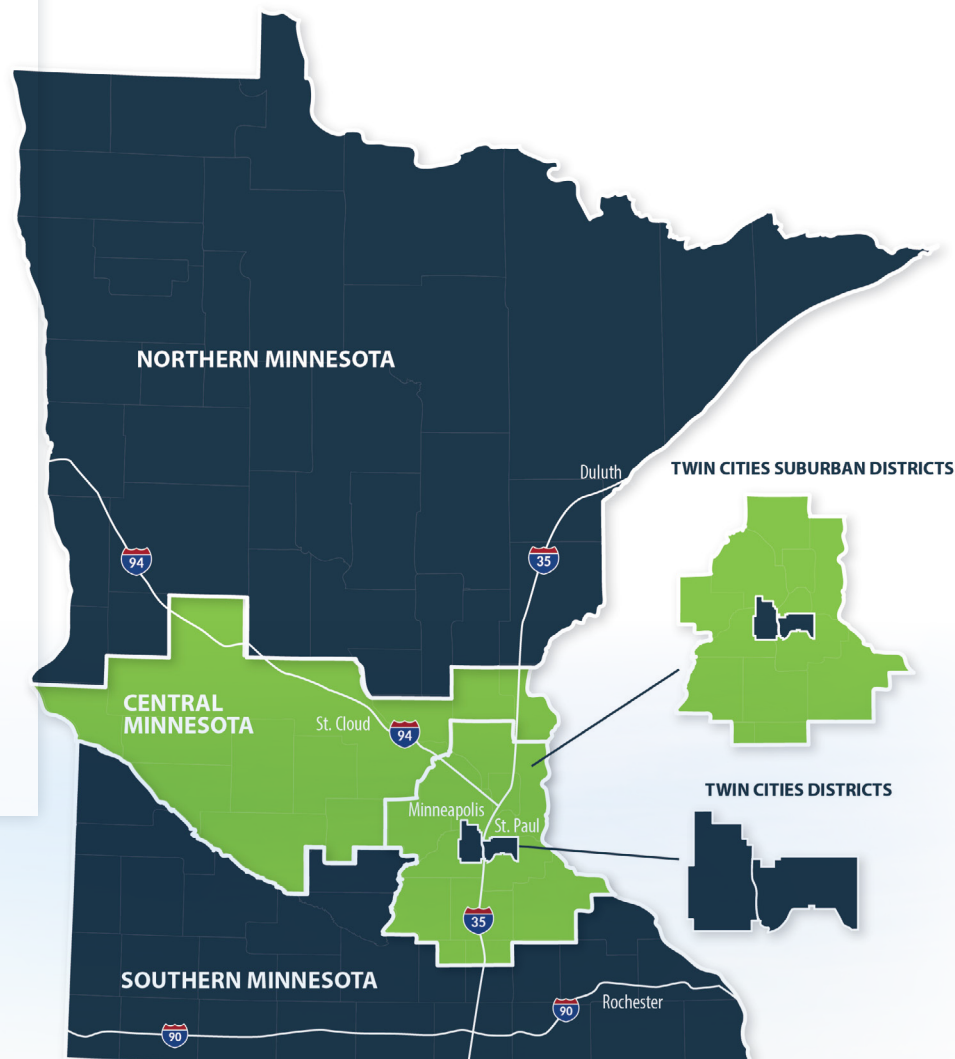
