





The layout gives you options: three private levels, a great room with soaring ceilings, a flexible loft, a family/media room for rainy-day movie marathons, and a gourmet kitchen that doesn't skimp. We're talking quartz and bluestone counters and name-drop appliances: Viking stove, Miele dishwasher, and a Fisher & Paykel refrigerator. Red oak hardwood runs through the upper levels, while radiant heated ceramic tile keeps the full, walk-out basement practical and cozy, complete with a freestanding fireplace. Custom Elfa closets throughout the home (plus sneaky underthe-stairs storage) means you've got plenty of ways to stay organized. 

The Grounds


Outside, the half-acre lot is tucked at the end of a private road, landscaped with stone walls, and buffered by HOA land so your backyard feels like it goes on forever. Two decks fill your outdoor dining and lounging quota, and the matching shed ties it all together with "yes, I have a place for my kayak" energy.

And about that HOA: this isn't your standard "pay us to mow the grass" situation. South Edgewood Lake HOA is a private, membersonly club of just 26 households with access to two private lakes, 73+ acres, and more outdoor activities than an L.L. Bean catalog. Fishing, swimming, boating, hiking, snowshoeing, berry-picking, wildlifespotting - you name it, it's in your backyard. Oh, and the HOA abuts New York State land so access to Waneta Lake and an additional 225 acres of recreation is literally next door. Affordable, private, and frankly a little idyllic.



The Location

Livingston Manor itself? It's the Catskills darling—charming Main Street shops and restaurants, buzzy breweries, fly-fishing mecca, farm-to-table everything.
