




The House

Natural light cascades across the original hardwood floors, connecting the living, dining and kitchen spaces on the main level. The front parlor features a rich wood mantle, antique light fixtures, and reclaimed wood chair rail and lower-wall paneling. Tucked down a hallway between the living room and stairwell, you'll find beautiful custom built-in storage - and a private powder room.

The dining room features a second decorative fireplace, and flows conveniently into the well-equipped kitchen. In addition to custom millwork, the kitchen also features marble countertops, subway tile backsplash, designer lighting, and stainless steel appliances.

Upstairs are two large bedrooms - each with vaulted ceilings, exposed beams, hardwood floors, and an array of windows. These bedrooms also both feature reclaimed wall wainscoting and window trim, in designer colors. A full bathroom on this level features a cast iron clawfoot tub, original built-in storage with concealed laundry chute, antique trough sink with double-faucets, and classic b&w tile on floor and walls.



The Grounds

Set back from the street front and neighboring homes, the charming clapboard facade and sunburst portico welcome the southwesterly glow. A bluestone path leads through a picket fence and lush perennial gardens, to the front entry.

A fenced pathway alongside the house leads to the back section of yard, where an 8 foot cedar privacy fence provides an inner-city oasis - with garden beds, established ornamental trees, a custom shed for outdoor storage, and a pea gravel area for seating and entertaining.



The Location

In addition to being one of the finest and most notable historic restorations in town - this home has ideal access. Located less than a half mile to both the Uptown Stockade and Midtown Broadway shopping and dining corridors – and with popular cafe and daytime hub, Camp Kingston, just around the corner.
