Surviving a crisis

- Stop all financial activity
- Address the cause of the emergency

What changed?

- Figure out how much your income has changed
- Replacing lost income

Categorizing spending

Separate wants from needs

Reducing discretionary spending

- Cut all spending on "wants"
- Stick with the budget, even if it's painful
- Reintroduce wants slowly

Reducing Necessary Spending

- Cutting spending on "needs"
- Housing: What about renting?
- When to Refinance
- Reducing Utility Bills
- Cutting phone bills
- Lowering Transportation expenses
- Cutting Food Costs
