TEAM NOTES

- The Toronto Raptors (7-23) play their second straight road game Thursday night when they visit the Memphis Grizzlies (20-10) at FedExForum. The Raptors have dropped a season-high eight straight games (Dec. 5-23). Toronto split the season-series in 2023-24 with Memphis after each team won on the road. RJ Barrett and Scottie Barnes averaged 21.5 and 21.0 points, respectively, in two games against the Grizzlies last season. The road team has won the last eight matchups in the all-time series. Darko Rajaković spent three seasons as an assistant coach with Memphis (2020-23) prior to being named the 10th head coach in Raptors history in June of 2023.
- Rookie Ja'Kobe Walter scored in double figures for the second consecutive game with a bench tying-high 16 points in 25 minutes Monday night at New York. He poured in a career-best 27 points Sunday against Houston. Through 10 games in December, Walter currently ranks fifth among rookies in scoring (11.2 ppg). Walter was picked 19th overall by the Raptors in the 2024 NBA Draft. He missed nine games in October and early November with a right AC joint sprain.
- Scottie Barnes finished with team highs of 24 points and eight assists, along with three rebounds, Monday
 night at New York. Barnes is one of just five players in the NBA averaging at least 19.0 points, 7.0 rebounds
 and 7.0 assists this season, along with Cade Cunningham, Luka Doncic, LeBron James and Nikola Jokic.
- Monday night marked Toronto's 14th different starting lineup this season, and seventh different starting group in the
 month of December. The Raptors used 30 different starting lineups last season. The quintet of Immanuel Quickley, Gradey Dick, Scottie Barnes, RJ Barrett and Jakob Poeltl has yet to play in a game together this season.
- Chris Boucher led the bench in scoring for a team-high 15th time this season with 16 points (5-6 FG, 4-5 3PT, 2-2) Monday night against the Knicks. He also matched a season high with four three-pointers. Boucher has now scored 10+ points in four of his last five games played (Dec. 5-23), averaging 11.0 points during this span.
- **Jamison Battle** signed with the Raptors as an undrafted free agent over the summer. Battle currently leads all undrafted rookies in games played (27), and total minute (375), points (163) and rebounds (54). His .432 (38-88) three-point percentage also ranks second among all rookies, behind only Ajay Mitchell (.444).

- Averaging career highs of 11.6 points, 4.1 rebounds, 1.8 assists and 30.7 minutes through 30 games.
- Has scored 10+ points in 18 games; something he did 16 times in 78 games last season.
- Shooting a career-best .430 (52-121) from three-point range; ranks second on the team with 52 threes.

F-RJ BARRETT #9 MIN: 34.3 REB: 6.7 AST: 6.1 STL: 0.72 TO: 3.4 BLK: 0.44 PTS: 23.5

- · Returned to the lineup Monday night at New York after missing the previous two games due to illness.
- Has dished out 10+ assists five times; something he didn't do once in his first five NBA seasons.
- Averaging a team-high 24.9 points (8 GP), and is shooting .497 (57-124) from the floor, in December.

C - JONATHAN MOGBO #2 MIN: 17.9 REB: 4.6 AST: 1.8 STL: 0.80 TO: 0.9 BLK: 0.43 PTS: 5.6

- Averaging 6.3 points, 5.2 rebounds, 2.3 assists and 25.3 minutes in six starts this season.
- Tied for second among rookies in total steals (24) and ranks fourth in total rebounds (137).
- One of only two Raptors, along with Ochai Agbaji, to appear in all 30 games this season.

G - GRADEY DICK #1 MIN: 32.3 REB: 3.4 AST: 2.2 STL: 0.88 TO: 1.7 BLK: 0.24 PTS: 18.2

- Ranks third among sophomores in scoring (18.2 ppg), behind only Victor Wembanyama and Brandon Miller.
- Has scored 20+ points nine times; something he did four times in 60 games as a rookie.
- Leads the Raptors with 64 three-point field goals; has made multiple threes in 19-of-25 games played.

G - SCOTTIE BARNES #4 MIN: 33.9 REB: 7.9 AST: 7.2 STL: 1.29 TO: 3.5 BLK: 0.71 PTS: 19.6

- Averaging a career and team-high 7.2 assists; has tallied seven or more assists in 10-of-17 games played.
- Recorded 1,000th career assist Oct. 26 at MIN; became the youngest Raptor to reach this milestone.
- Has missed 11 games this season due to a right orbital fracture and two with a right ankle sprain.

NEW YORK — Karl-Anthony Towns had 31 points, 10 rebounds and seven assists, OG Anunoby also scored 31 points and shot 13 for 15 from the field, and the New York Knicks beat the Toronto Raptors 139-125 ... Cam Payne had 19 points off the bench for the Knicks, who put seven players in double figures and won their fourth straight ... Mikal Bridges finished with 14 points and Jalen Brunson had 12 points and seven assists ... Scottie Barnes had 24 points and eight assists, and RJ Barrett scored 23 points for Toronto, which dropped its eighth straight game ... The Raptors gave up at least 110 points — New York had 111 through three quarters — for the 10th time in their past 11 games and fell to 1-13 on the road this season ... The Knicks shot 59% from the field, despite Brunson's uncharacteristic off night shooting (4 for 13 from the field, 0 for 5 from 3-point range) ... They had 70 at halftime even though Brunson only had three ... After a lackluster first quarter when the Raptors shot 52%, New York ran away in the second, keyed by Payne, who had two 3-pointers and scored 11 points in the period ... Buoyed by Payne's energy, the Knicks outscored the Raptors 40-24 in the second quarter, turning a 32-30 deficit into an 18-point halftime advantage.

GAME 29 - DECEMBER 22, 2024 HOUSTON 114, TORONTO 104

TORONTO — The Toronto Raptors blew an early 16-point lead and saw their NBA losing streak reach seven games in a tight 114-110 defeat to the Houston Rockets on Sunday at Scotiabank Arena ... Dillon Brooks of Mississauga, Ont., made the most of his lone scheduled trip to Toronto this season, leading the Rockets (19-9) with 27 points while adding six rebounds and making 13 of his 14 free-throw attempts ... Jalen Green also chipped in with 22 points and seven rebounds for Houston ... Rookie Ja'Kobe Walter scored a career-high 27 points to pace the Raptors (7-22) ... He fouled out with two minutes 40 seconds remaining in the game and left to an ovation from the Raptors crowd ... Fellow first-year player Jamal Shead recorded his first career double-double with 11 points and 10 assists ... After going down 7-3, Raptors head coach Darko Raiakovic called a timeout less than two minutes into the game ... The Raptors responded with an 8-0 run during which Walter made all the Toronto baskets ... They led 35-24 after the first frame and 57-51 at halftime ... But the Rockets — who allow the third-fewest points per game in the league — tightened up their defence the rest of the way ... Toronto had a chance to tie the game with 22 seconds remaining and trailing 113-110, but forward Kelly Olynyk couldn't handle a deflected pass and the ball rolled out of bounds.

Scottie Barnes added 20 points and 10 assists for Toronto ... Jacob Poeltl had 12 points, 13 rebounds and six assists ... Dejounte Murray led Atlanta with 24 points ... De'Andre Hunter added 22 points ... With the Hawks down 121-118 with 18 seconds left, Murray stepped out of bounds on a dribble handoff from Bogdan Bogdanovic, and the Raptors sealed it with Bruce Brown's breakaway dunk with 11 seconds to play ... Hawks All-Star Trae Young, who averaged 34.3 points in the three previous games against the Raptors this season, was held to 11 points on 4-for-13 shooting ... He had seven assists ... Hawks coach Quin Snyder was ejected with 4:25 remaining in the second guarter for storming on the court after Young appeared to injure his right thigh fighting through a screen set by Poeltl ... Young hopped on one leg and went to the ground for a minute, but was able to stay in the game ... In addition to Snyder's double-technical, Young and Hunter also received first-half technical fouls.

As the Toronto Raptors celebrate their 30th Anniversary season, the team retired **Vince Carter's** iconic number 15 jersey, the first in franchise history to be raised to the Scotiabank Arena rafters. The ceremony took place at halftime on Saturday, Nov. 2 against the Sacramento Kings.

In addition to retiring his jersey, the Raptors will pay tribute in February to the 25th Anniversary of Carter's iconic NBA Slam Dunk Contest win at the 2000 NBAAll-Star Weekend. The 30th Anniversary season will also see the team wear new uniforms that recognize Carter.

Following his 22-year playing career, the longest in NBA history, Carter was elected to the Naismith Memorial Basketball Hall of Fame in April and was officially inducted in a ceremony in October. Carter was acquired by the Raptors in a trade at the 1998 NBA Draft after originally being selected with the fifth pick by the Golden State Warriors.

DARKO RAJAKOVIĆ

HEAD COACH

The passion Darko Rajaković (rye-AHK-oe-vich) has for the game of basketball has led him around the world. From Madrid, Spain to Tulsa, Oklahoma, each of these experiences have added to Rajaković's beliefs and philosophies, shaping him into the coach, father, and leader he is today.

Raised in Serbia during a civil war, Rajaković fell in love with basketball during a time of unrest in his homeland. The basketball court became his safe haven, a place where he and his friends could gather and play until the wee hours of the morning.

It was fitting Rajaković started his coaching career in his hometown of Cacak, Serbia. At just 16 years of age, he embarked on a life-long journey of teaching others a game that brought him such joy. This started with the local Borac Cacak Youth Team in 1996. After three seasons with the club, he was named the head coach of the U20 and U18 teams of Red Star Belgrade, leading Red Star to two Serbian Youth championships during his eight-year tenure (1999-2007).

Rajaković then ventured to Spain where he coached Espacio Torrelodones for three successful seasons (2009-12). In his first year with the franchise, he led the team to the championship of the Primera Division de Baloncesto in Madrid.

From 2004-11, Rajaković held his first formal job with an NBA team, serving as a European scouting consultant and NBA Summer League assistant coach for the San Antonio Spurs.

His time in Serbia, Spain and San Antonio ultimately led Rajaković to the Oklahoma City Thunder, where he spent seven seasons (2012-19). Rajaković joined the organization in 2012 as the head coach of the Tulsa 66ers – the franchise's then NBA G League affiliate, and became the first head coach born outside of North America in league history. Under his guidance, the team went 51-49 (.510) over two seasons and reached the 2013 G League semifinals. In 2014, Rajaković was honoured as one of Oklahoma City's assistant coaches at the NBA All-Star game in New Orleans.

Rajaković transitioned from the G League to the NBA at the start of the 2014-15 campaign, in what would be his first of five seasons as an assistant coach with the Thunder (2014-19). Oklahoma City averaged 49 wins during his time on the coaching staff and earned four playoff appearances - including a trip to the 2016 Western Conference Finals.

Rajaković also spent time in the NBA as an assistant coach with the Phoenix Suns (2019-20) and Memphis Grizzlies (2020-23), before being named the 10th head coach in Toronto Raptors history in June of 2023.

On the international stage, Rajaković was as an assistant coach for Serbia at the 2019 FIBA

World Cup in China, helping his country to a fifth place finish at the tournament, which included a win over the United States in the classification round.

Rajaković prides himself on being a life-long learner. He earned a basketball coaching degree from the Belgrade Basketball Academy in 2004 and a degree in sports management from Alfa BK University in Belgrade in 2006.

He and his wife, Gaga, reside in Toronto with their son, Luka.
