TEAM NOTES

- The **Toronto Raptors** are hosting the Orlando Magic on Friday evening for the first game of a four-game season series. The Magic enter play having won three consecutive games against the Raptors after sweeping the 2023-24 season series. Wednesday's contest marks the second game of a three-game homestand for the Raptors who will also host the Milwaukee Bucks on Monday ahead of a three-game road swing (Jan. 8-11).
- The Raptors are coming off a 130-113 win over the Brooklyn Nets on Wednesday evening at Scotiabank Arena marking the largest home win since Feb. 22, 2024 which was also against the Brooklyn Nets (121-93, +28). The win snapped a season-long 11-game losing skid (Dec. 5-31) and also stopped a seven-game losing streak at home. Toronto shot a season-high 59.1% (52-for-88) from the field against the Nets including a season-high 50% (16-for-32) from beyond the arc. The Raptors improve to 5-4 this season when shooting .500-or-better and 118-25 all-time when shooting 50% from the field including from three-point range.
- The Raptors also recorded a season-high 33 fast break points on Wednesday and finished with a +12 advantage in that category against the Nets. The Raptors are currently ranked fifth in fast break points per game (17.6).
- Scottie Barnes** led the way for the Raptors vs. Brooklyn who recorded game highs of 33 points and 13 rebounds — falling one short of his season-high — for his ninth double-double of the season. He also added five assists, two steals and one block in a game-high 38 minutes. Wednesday's contest marked Barnes' eighth career 30/10/5 game which is third-most in franchise history behind Pascal Siakam (16) and Vince Carter (10).
- Immanuel Quickley** returned to the starting lineup for the first time since Nov. 10 at LA Lakers. He had missed the previous 22 games (Nov. 12 – Dec. 31) due to a left elbow partial UCL tear. In his fourth game of the season, Quickley recorded 21 points, a season-high 15 assists and four rebounds in 32 minutes of play. Quickley is the second Raptor (RJ Barrett) and one of 10 players in the NBA to record a 20+ point and 15+ assist game this season.
- Toronto fielded a starting lineup of Scottie Barnes, Ochai Agbaji, Jakob Poeltl and Grady Dick for just the second time this season and the first since the 2024-25 season opener on Oct. 23 vs. Cleveland.

- Has shot .600-or-better from the field three times this season; Raptors are 3-0 in those games.

F - OCHAI AGBAJI #30 MIN: 30.1 REB: 3.9 AST: 1.9 STL: 0.85 TO: 0.9 BLK: 0.53 PTS: 11.1

- Averaging career highs of 11.1 points, 3.9 rebounds, 1.9 assists and .503 field goal percentage.
- Has recorded a steal or a blocked shot in 27 of 34 games played this season.
- Has recorded multiple three-point field goals in 15 games this season; Second on team in 3PT FG (56).

C - JAKOB POELTL #19 MIN: 31.9 REB: 10.9 AST: 2.7 STL: 1.17 TO: 2.1 BLK: 1.31 PTS: 15.0

- Has shot 50% or better in nine of last 10 games (Nov. 27 - Jan. 1); Shooting team-high 62.4% in that span.
- Has scored double digit points in 22 of 29 games played this season; Averaging career-high 15.0 points.
- Leads the team in total rebounds (315), total blocks (38) and in total steals (34).

G - GRADEY DICK #1 MIN: 31.9 REB: 3.5 AST: 2.1 STL: 1.04 TO: 1.8 BLK: 0.21 PTS: 17.8

- Fourth youngest (21 years, 42 days) and seventh fastest (88 games) Raptor to reach 1,000 career points.
- Has recorded 20+ points 10 times this season; Recorded 20+ points four times in rookie campaign.
- Ranked third in scoring average (17.8) among all first and second year players this season.

G - IMMANUEL QUICKLEY #5 MIN: 24.9 REB: 2.5 AST: 6.8 STL: 0.50 TO: 1.3 BLK: 0.00 PTS: 16.8

- Joins Jose Calderon (7) and Kyle Lowry (2) as only Raptors to record multiple 20-point, 15-assist games.
- Eight of career 12 point-assist double-doubles have come as a member of the Toronto Raptors.
- Missed 30 games this season due to a right pelvic contusion (8) and left elbow partial UCL tear (22).

TORONTO — Immanuel Quickley had a double-double in his return to Toronto's lineup as the Raptors defeated the Brooklyn Nets 130-113 on Wednesday to snap an 11-game losing skid ... Quickley had 21 points and 15 assists for Toronto (8-26) after missing the last 22 games with a partially torn ulnar collateral ligament in his right elbow ... Scottie Barnes also had a double-double for the Raptors, with a game-high 33 points and 13 rebounds ... Gradey Dick added 22 points ... Cam Johnson led Brooklyn (12-21) with 24 points ... Nic Claxton had a double-double with 16 points and 10 rebounds ... D'Angelo Russell came off the bench for 22 points and eight assists ... The Nets also lost Noah Clowney (lower back) and Maxwell Lewis (left knee) to injury in the game ... Quickley was hurt in Toronto's home opener Oct. 23 when he fell hard on his tailbone ... He returned from that injury to play on Nov. 9 and 10, but then hurt his elbow ... RJ Barrett (illness) of Mississauga, Ont., was inactive ... Veteran forward Bruce Brown (injury management) rested for the second half of the Raptors' back-to-back.

The Celtics outscored the Raptors 45-18 in the third, using an onslaught of 3-pointers to pull away and close out 2024 with a blowout ... Boston made 10 of 12 shots from beyond the arc in the period ... Tatum hit four 3s and Jrue Holiday and Sam Hauser each hit two as Boston shot 74% for the period ... Holiday returned after missing three games with a right shoulder injury, finishing with 14 points ... Payton Pritchard scored 19, Derrick White had 16 and Hauser finished with 12 points ... Jaylen Brown added 12 points and nine rebounds in the win ... Scottie Barnes led Toronto with 16 points and 13 rebounds ... Jakob Poeltl grabbed 13 rebounds for the Raptors, who went 2-11 in the month of December.

Gary Trent Jr. scored 15 points, and Immanuel Quickley and Bruce Brown each had 12 ... Nwora scored 12 straight Toronto points in the third quarter after Orlando opened a 17-point lead ... Bobby Portis added 17 points off the bench for Milwaukee ... Brook Lopez scored 13 points while AJ Green and Ryan Rollins had 12 apiece ... Gradey Dick paced the Raptors with 32 points, a career high for the second-year player ... Jakob Poeltl scored 13 points and Chris Boucher had 12 ... The Bucks began to pull away midway through the third quarter and pushed their lead to 21 points early in the fourth ... Toronto got within 10 points with less than five minutes remaining but did not get closer ... The Bucks were without star guard Damian Lillard, who is in the concussion protocol, while the Raptors' Immanuel Quickley sat out with an elbow injury ... Dick had 22 first-half points, which included making 12 of 14 free throws ... Milwaukee attempted 31 3-pointers in the first half as the Raptors focused their defensive attention on Antetokounmpo in and around the paint ... The Bucks finished 16 of 56 (28.6%) from deep ... The Bucks led 54-43 at halftime, but the Raptors went on an 11-0 run to start third quarter ... The Bucks responded with an 11-2 run, capped by Green's 3-pointer.

VINSANITY

As the Toronto Raptors celebrate their 30th Anniversary season, the team retired **Vince Carter's** iconic number 15 jersey, the first in franchise history to be raised to the Scotiabank Arena rafters. The ceremony took place at halftime on Saturday, Nov. 2 against the Sacramento Kings.

In addition to retiring his jersey, the Raptors will pay tribute in February to the 25th Anniversary of Carter's iconic NBA Slam Dunk Contest win at the 2000 NBA All-Star Weekend. The 30th Anniversary season will also see the team wear new uniforms that recognize Carter.

Following his 22-year playing career, the longest in NBA history, Carter was elected to the Naismith Memorial Basketball Hall of Fame in April and was officially inducted in a ceremony in October. DARKO RAJAKOVIĆ

HEAD COACH

The passion Darko Rajaković (rye-AHK-oe-vich) has for the game of basketball has led him around the world. From Madrid, Spain to Tulsa, Oklahoma, each of these experiences have added to Rajaković’s beliefs and philosophies, shaping him into the coach, father, and leader he is today.

Raised in Serbia during a civil war, Rajaković fell in love with basketball during a time of unrest in his homeland. The basketball court became his safe haven, a place where he and his friends could gather and play until the wee hours of the morning.

It was fitting Rajaković started his coaching career in his hometown of Cacak, Serbia. At just 16 years of age, he embarked on a life-long journey of teaching others a game that brought him such joy. This started with the local Borac Cacak Youth Team in 1996. After three seasons with the club, he was named the head coach of the U20 and U18 teams of Red Star Belgrade, leading Red Star to two Serbian Youth championships during his eight-year tenure (1999-2007).

Rajaković then ventured to Spain where he coached Espacio Torrelodones for three successful seasons (2009-12). In his first year with the franchise, he led the team to the championship of the Primera Division de Baloncesto in Madrid.

From 2004-11, Rajaković held his first formal job with an NBA team, serving as a European scouting consultant and NBA Summer League assistant coach for the San Antonio Spurs.

His time in Serbia, Spain and San Antonio ultimately led Rajaković to the Oklahoma City Thunder, where he spent seven seasons (2012-19). Rajaković joined the organization in 2012 as the head coach of the Tulsa 66ers – the franchise’s then NBA G League affiliate, and became the first head coach born outside of North America in league history. Under his guidance, the team went 51-49 (.510) over two seasons and reached the 2013 G League semifinals. In 2014, Rajaković was honoured as one of Oklahoma City’s assistant coaches at the NBA All-Star game in New Orleans.

Rajaković transitioned from the G League to the NBA at the start of the 2014-15 campaign, in what would be his first of five seasons as an assistant coach with the Thunder (2014-19). Oklahoma City averaged 49 wins during his time on the coaching staff and earned four playoff appearances - including a trip to the 2016 Western Conference Finals.

Rajaković also spent time in the NBA as an assistant coach with the Phoenix Suns (2019-20) and Memphis Grizzlies (2020-23), before being named the 10th head coach in Toronto Raptors history in June of 2023.

On the international stage, Rajaković was as an assistant coach for Serbia at the 2019 FIBA

World Cup in China, helping his country to a fifth place finish at the tournament, which included a win over the United States in the classification round.

Rajaković prides himself on being a life-long learner. He earned a basketball coaching degree from the Belgrade Basketball Academy in 2004 and a degree in sports management from Alfa BK University in Belgrade in 2006.

He and his wife, Gaga, reside in Toronto with their son, Luka.
