### TEAM NOTES

- The Toronto Raptors travel to Milwaukee on Friday to face the Bucks at Fiserv Forum. The Raptors have won two in a row after snapping a 10-game winless streak against Boston with a 110-97 victory over the Celtics on Wednesday. Toronto shot .506 (45-89) from the field and grabbed a season-high 56 rebounds in the win. Friday night is the third and final meeting with Milwaukee this season. The Bucks have an opportunity to sweep the season-series for the first time since 2012-13 (0-3). Toronto has not won three straight games this season.
- The Raptors had all five starters score in double figures for the 10th time this season in Wednesday's victory over Boston. Toronto's starting five combined for 78 points and shot .596 (34-for-57) from the floor against the Celtics.
- Jakob Poeltl** recorded his second consecutive double-double with 16 points (8-8 FG) and a game-high 11 rebounds Jan. 15 vs. Boston. Wednesday night marked Poeltl's fourth career double-double, and second with the Raptors, where he shot perfect from the field. Poeltl currently leads the Raptors with 16 double-doubles after posting 20 such games in 50 contests last season.
- Toronto outscored Boston in the paint 60-to-40 (+20) on Wednesday night and has now scored 40-or-more points in the paint in all eight games played this month, including 60+ three times. The Raptors currently rank fourth in the NBA in points in the paint (54.0). The duo of **RJ Barrett** (12.4) and **Jakob Poeltl** (12.1) rank 11th and 15th, respectively, in the NBA in points in the paint.
- Scottie Barnes** has recorded three-or-more steals (STL+BLK) in a career-high six straight games (Jan. 6-15). He has totaled 10 steals and 11 blocks during this span. Through 28 games played, Barnes is averaging career highs of 20.3 points, 6.5 assists and 1.46 steals.
- Rookie **Jamal Sheard** is averaging 7.3 points and shooting .525 (21-40) from the field, including .500 (10-20) from three-point range, through eight games in January. Since Dec. 1, Sheard is shooting .442 (19-43) from beyond the arc in 17 games after shooting .289 (11-38) from three-point territory in 20 games in October and November. Sheard currently ranks fourth among rookies in assists per game (3.4) and fifth with a .370 (30-81) three-point percentage. **Jamison Battle** ranks second among rookies in three-point percentage (.423).

**F - RJ BARRETT #9** MIN: 33.8 REB: 6.7 AST: 5.9 STL: 0.76 TO: 3.3 BLK: 0.39 PTS: 22.4

- Recorded eighth double-double (22 pts, 10 rebs) Jan. 15 vs. Boston; had two double-doubles last season.
- Ranks second in the NBA in fast break points per game (5.0) and 11th in points in the paint (12.4).
- Averaging 26.1 points in 16 home games this season, compared to 18.9 points in 17 contests on the road.

**F - SCOTTIE BARNES #4** MIN: 34.8 REB: 8.0 AST: 6.5 STL: 1.46 TO: 3.4 BLK: 0.89 PTS: 20.3

- One of only five players in the NBA averaging at least 20.0 points, 8.0 rebounds and 6.0 assists.
- Averaging a team-high 21.6 points and is shooting .518 (73-141) from the field through eight games in January.
- Has recorded three-or-more steals (STL+BLK) in a career-high six straight games (Jan. 6-15).

**C - JAKOB POELTL #19** MIN: 32.0 REB: 10.6 AST: 2.7 STL: 1.19 TO: 2.0 BLK: 1.22 PTS: 14.9

- One of five players in the NBA, and only one in the East, with 40+ steals and 40+ blocks this season.
- Ranks seventh in the NBA with a .613 (233-380) FG% - his eighth straight season shooting 60% from the floor.
- Leads the team in total rebounds (381), steals (43), blocks (44) and double-doubles (16).

**G - GRADEVY DICK #1** MIN: 30.6 REB: 3.4 AST: 2.1 STL: 0.86 TO: 1.7 BLK: 0.20 PTS: 16.2

- Ranks third in scoring average (16.2 ppg) among all rookies and sophomores (min. 20 GP).
- Leads the team with 84 three-point field goals; has made multiple threes in 25-of-35 games played.
- Has scored 20+ points in 10 games; something he did four times in 60 games as a rookie.

**G - DAVION MITCHELL #45** MIN: 24.4 REB: 2.1 AST: 4.5 STL: 0.75 TO: 1.7 BLK: 0.19 PTS: 6.0

- Averaging 8.2 points, 5.8 assists, 2.5 rebounds and 30.2 minutes in 16 starts.
- Scored in double figures for the ninth time this season with 10 points Jan. 15 vs. Boston.
- Has recorded 11 assists, compared to just one turnover, over the last two games (Jan. 13-15).

**TORONTO** — RJ Barrett had 22 points and 10 rebounds, and the Toronto Raptors snapped a 10-game losing streak against Boston with a 110-97 victory over the Celtics on Wednesday night ... Jakob Poeltl added 16 points and 11 rebounds as the Raptors won consecutive games for the third time ... Scottie Barnes scored 18 points ... Toronto, which beat Golden State on Monday, has yet to win three straight this season ... Peyton Pritchard scored 20 points, Kristaps Porzingis had 18 and Jayson Tatum added 16 for Boston ... The Celtics shot 16 for 46 from 3-point range ... It was Boston's first loss to Toronto since March 28, 2022 ... Toronto's third win in 19 games was a major turnaround from the Raptors' previous meeting with the Celtics ... Toronto lost by a franchise-worst 54 points, 125-71, on Dec. 31 at Boston ... Raptors guard Immanuel Quickley sat for the second straight game ... He has a left hip injury ... Guard Ochai Agbaji needed three stitches to close a cut on his right hand after being injured in the second quarter ... He did not return ... Jamal Sheard's 3 with 7:36 to play capped a 12-4 Toronto run to start the fourth quarter and gave the Raptors a 100-86 lead, their biggest of the game at that point.

**TORONTO** — Ochai Agbaji scored two key baskets late in the fourth quarter to lift the Toronto Raptors to a 104-101 victory over the Golden State Warriors on Monday night at Scotiabank Arena ... He gave Toronto a one-point lead with 93 seconds left and helped ice the win with a dunk with 39.8 seconds to play ... Golden State's Buddy Hield attempted a deep three-pointer at the buzzer but came up short ... Scottie Barnes had 23 points for the Raptors, who ended their five-game losing streak ... Jakob Poeltl added 13 points and 13 assists ... Stephen Curry led Golden State with 26 points ... Raptors guard Immanuel Quickley was ruled out before the game due to left hip soreness ... Warriors forward Draymond Green sat out due to illness ... Guard Jamal Sheard provided some spark off the bench for Toronto late in the first quarter with back-to-back three-pointers ... The Raptors led 28-26 after 12 minutes and took a 52-50 lead into the half ... Lindy Waters III gave Golden State an 86-77 lead by hitting his second straight three-pointer with 9:27 remaining ... Montreal's Chris Boucher answered with back-to-back three-pointers of his own to keep Toronto close ... Boucher finished with 18 points and seven rebounds.

Orlando guard Jalen Suggs was wheelchaired off the court with three minutes left in the first half after he crumpled to the ground, clutching his back ... ## VINSANITY

As the Toronto Raptors celebrate their 30th Anniversary season, the team retired **Vince Carter's** iconic number 15 jersey, the first in franchise history to be raised to the Scotiabank Arena rafters. The ceremony took place at halftime on Saturday, Nov. 2 against the Sacramento Kings.

In addition to retiring his jersey, the Raptors will pay tribute in February to the 25th Anniversary of Carter's iconic NBA Slam Dunk Contest win at the 2000 NBA All-Star Weekend. The 30th Anniversary season will also see the team wear new uniforms that recognize Carter.

Following his 22-year playing career, the longest in NBA history, Carter was elected to the Naismith Memorial Basketball Hall of Fame in April and was officially inducted in a ceremony in October. Carter was acquired by the Raptors in a trade at the 1998 NBA Draft after originally being selected with the fifth pick by the Golden State Warriors.

## DARKO RAJAKOVIĆ

### HEAD COACH

The passion Darko Rajaković (rye-AHK-oe-vich) has for the game of basketball has led him around the world. From Madrid, Spain to Tulsa, Oklahoma, each of these experiences have added to Rajaković's beliefs and philosophies, shaping him into the coach, father, and leader he is today.

Raised in Serbia during a civil war, Rajaković fell in love with basketball during a time of unrest in his homeland. The basketball court became his safe haven, a place where he and his friends could gather and play until the wee hours of the morning.

It was fitting Rajaković started his coaching career in his hometown of Cacak, Serbia. At just 16 years of age, he embarked on a life-long journey of teaching others a game that brought him such joy. This started with the local Borac Cacak Youth Team in 1996. After three seasons with the club, he was named the head coach of the U20 and U18 teams of Red Star Belgrade, leading Red Star to two Serbian Youth championships during his eight-year tenure (1999-2007).

Rajaković then ventured to Spain where he coached Espacio Torrelodones for three successful seasons (2009-12). In his first year with the franchise, he led the team to the championship of the Primera Division de Baloncesto in Madrid.

From 2004-11, Rajaković held his first formal job with an NBA team, serving as a European scouting consultant and NBA Summer League assistant coach for the San Antonio Spurs.

His time in Serbia, Spain and San Antonio ultimately led Rajaković to the Oklahoma City Thunder, where he spent seven seasons (2012-19). Rajaković joined the organization in 2012 as the head coach of the Tulsa 66ers – the franchise's then NBA G League affiliate, and became the first head coach born outside of North America in league history. Under his guidance, the team went 51-49 (.510) over two seasons and reached the 2013 G League semifinals. In 2014, Rajaković was honoured as one of Oklahoma City's assistant coaches at the NBA All-Star game in New Orleans.

Rajaković transitioned from the G League to the NBA at the start of the 2014-15 campaign, in what would be his first of five seasons as an assistant coach with the Thunder (2014-19). Oklahoma City averaged 49 wins during his time on the coaching staff and earned four playoff appearances - including a trip to the 2016 Western Conference Finals.

Rajaković also spent time in the NBA as an assistant coach with the Phoenix Suns (2019-20) and Memphis Grizzlies (2020-23), before being named the 10th head coach in Toronto Raptors history in June of 2023.

On the international stage, Rajaković was as an assistant coach for Serbia at the 2019 FIBA

World Cup in China, helping his country to a fifth place finish at the tournament, which included a win over the United States in the classification round.

Rajaković prides himself on being a life-long learner. He earned a basketball coaching degree from the Belgrade Basketball Academy in 2004 and a degree in sports management from Alfa BK University in Belgrade in 2006.

He and his wife, Gaga, reside in Toronto with their son, Luka.
