TEAM NOTES

- · The Toronto Raptors travel to Houston for a midday matchup to take on the Rockets at Toyota Center. Sunday's contest is the second and final game of a two-game season series against Houston, who took the first game 114-110 against the Raptors on Dec. 22 in Toronto. The Raptors' last win against the Rockets comes exactly a year before Sunday's game (Feb. 9, 2024). Sunday is the second game of a three-game road trip (Feb. 7-11). Toronto will conclude their road trip against the Philadelphia 76ers on Tuesday.
- The Raptors fell to the Oklahoma City Thunder at Paycom Center on Friday night, losing the season series 0-2. Toronto has now dropped three straight games (Feb. 4-7) and are 16-36 on the season. The Raptors rookies combined to score 40 points against the Thunder. Toronto is ranked third in total points scored by rookies (937), behind only Memphis (1,013) and Washington (1,299).
- · Scottie Barnes scored a team-high 21 points and a season-high four three-point field goals, adding five rebounds and four assists in his 250th career game. Friday night's game marked the 21st time he recorded 20+ points this season, which is the second-most on the team, behind RJ Barrett (23). This was also the first time in this career he had four blocks and three steals and is just the 11th player to do so this season.
- Gradey Dick recorded 17 points and tied his season-high with seven rebounds. Dick has scored 15+ points 23 times this season and has now scored in double figures in six straight games (Jan. 27 - Feb. 7), the fourth time he has done so this season and is just one game shy of tying his career-high.
- The Toronto Raptors announced Friday they have converted forward Jamison Battle to a standard NBA contract. He scored 11 points on 4-of-5 shooting against the Thunder, including 3-of-4 from beyond the arc. Battle is ranked first among all rookies in the NBA in three-point field goal percentage this season (minimum 100 FGA) shooting 42.9% from beyond the arc. The Raptors also announced Friday they have signed Orlando Robinson to a two-way contract. Robinson finished with six points, five boards, and four assists against the Thunder. He is averaging 4.0 points, 3.0 rebounds, and 11.9 minutes in eight games as a Raptor.

- Picked in the second round (31st overall) by Toronto in the 2024 NBA Draft.

OKLAHOMA CITY — Jalen Williams scored 27 points, Shai Gilgeous-Alexander added 25 and the Oklahoma City Thunder beat the Toronto Raptors 121-109 on Friday night in Chet Holmgren's return from injury ... Holmgren, the runner-up for rookie of the year last season, played for the first time in three months after recovering from a pelvic fracture ... The 7-foot-1 forward had four points, five rebounds and four blocks in 22 minutes ... Aaron Wiggins added 18 points for the NBA-best Thunder (41-9), who won their fourth straight ... Scottie Barnes scored 21 points and Gradey Dick added 17 for the Raptors, who lost their third in a row ... Toronto was short-handed ... Scoring leader RJ Barrett was in the concussion protocol. Brandon Ingram, acquired from New Orleans before the trade deadline, was with the team but didn't play ... The Raptors made 20 of 50 shots inside the 3-point line as the Thunder's front line of Holmgren and the 7-foot Isaiah Hartenstein created problems.

Jackson added five rebounds and four assists as Memphis (35-16) won its fourth straight ... Ja Morant had 26 points, including 16 in a dominant third quarter. He contributed five boards and four assists ... Grizzlies rookie centre Zach Edey had a double-double in his first-ever NBA game in his hometown, finishing with 13 points and 14 rebounds ... Ja'Kobe Walter, Jamal Shead and reserve Ochai Agbaji had 14 points apiece as Toronto (16-35) had seven players hit double digits in scoring. Scottie Barnes had an off night, scoring just 11 points and dishing out nine assists ... Toronto was without three of its regular starters ... Swingman RJ Barrett (concussion protocol) of Mississauga, Ont., centre Jakob Poeltl (right hip pointer) and point guard Immanuel Quickley (scheduled rest) were all unavailable.

TORONTO — The Toronto Raptors blew an early 16-point lead and saw their NBA losing streak reach seven games in a tight 114-110 defeat to the Houston Rockets on Sunday at Scotiabank Arena ... Dillon Brooks of Mississauga, Ont., made the most of his lone scheduled trip to Toronto this season, leading the Rockets (19-9) with 27 points while adding six rebounds and making 13 of his 14 free-throw attempts ... Jalen Green also chipped in with 22 points and seven rebounds for Houston ... Rookie Ja'Kobe Walter scored a career-high 27 points to pace the Raptors (7-22) ... He fouled out with two minutes 40 seconds remaining in the game and left to an ovation from the Raptors crowd ... Fellow first-year player Jamal Shead recorded his first career double-double with 11 points and 10 assists ... After going down 7-3, Raptors head coach Darko Rajakovic called a timeout less than two minutes into the game ... The Raptors responded with an 8-0 run during which Walter made all the Toronto baskets ... They led 35-24 after the first frame and 57-51 at halftime ... But the Rockets who allow the third-fewest points per game in the league — tightened up their defence the rest of the way. Toronto had a chance to tie the game with 22 seconds remaining and trailing 113-110, but forward Kelly Olynyk couldn't handle a deflected pass and the ball rolled out of bounds.

DARKO RAJAKOVIĆ

HEAD COACH

The passion Darko Rajaković (rye-AHK-oe-vich) has for the game of basketball has led him around the world. From Madrid, Spain to Tulsa, Oklahoma, each of these experiences have added to Rajaković's beliefs and philosophies, shaping him into the coach, father, and leader he is today.

Raised in Serbia during a civil war, Rajaković fell in love with basketball during a time of unrest in his homeland. The basketball court became his safe haven, a place where he and his friends could gather and play until the wee hours of the morning.

It was fitting Rajaković started his coaching career in his hometown of Cacak, Serbia. At just 16 years of age, he embarked on a life-long journey of teaching others a game that brought him such joy. This started with the local Borac Cacak Youth Team in 1996. After three seasons with the club, he was named the head coach of the U20 and U18 teams of Red Star Belgrade, leading Red Star to two Serbian Youth championships during his eight-year tenure (1999-2007).

Rajaković then ventured to Spain where he coached Espacio Torrelodones for three successful seasons (2009-12). In his first year with the franchise, he led the team to the championship of the Primera Division de Baloncesto in Madrid.

From 2004-11, Rajaković held his first formal job with an NBA team, serving as a European scouting consultant and NBA Summer League assistant coach for the San Antonio Spurs.

His time in Serbia, Spain and San Antonio ultimately led Rajaković to the Oklahoma City Thunder, where he spent seven seasons (2012-19). Rajaković joined the organization in 2012 as the head coach of the Tulsa 66ers – the franchise's then NBA G League affiliate, and became the first head coach born outside of North America in league history. Under his guidance, the team went 51-49 (.510) over two seasons and reached the 2013 G League semifinals. In 2014, Rajaković was honoured as one of Oklahoma City's assistant coaches at the NBA All-Star game in New Orleans.

Rajaković transitioned from the G League to the NBA at the start of the 2014-15 campaign, in what would be his first of five seasons as an assistant coach with the Thunder (2014-19). Oklahoma City averaged 49 wins during his time on the coaching staff and earned four playoff appearances - including a trip to the 2016 Western Conference Finals.

Rajaković also spent time in the NBA as an assistant coach with the Phoenix Suns (2019-20) and Memphis Grizzlies (2020-23), before being named the 10th head coach in Toronto Raptors history in June of 2023.

On the international stage, Rajaković was as an assistant coach for Serbia at the 2019 FIBA

World Cup in China, helping his country to a fifth place finish at the tournament, which included a win over the United States in the classification round.

Rajaković prides himself on being a life-long learner. He earned a basketball coaching degree from the Belgrade Basketball Academy in 2004 and a degree in sports management from Alfa BK University in Belgrade in 2006.

He and his wife, Gaga, reside in Toronto with their son, Luka.
