TEAM NOTES

- The **Toronto Raptors** are in Chicago to face the Bulls in the second game of a four-game road trip (Feb. 26 - Mar. 4) on Feb. 28 at United Center. The Raptors enter play looking for their first win against Chicago this season having lost their first two matchups at home; with two games remaining in the four-game season series.
- The **Toronto Raptors** fell in the second game of their 11th back-to-back set of the season on Wednesday night to the Indiana Pacers. Toronto is now 18-41 on the season and 5-22 on the road. Six players scored in double-digits, marking the 20th time six-or-more Raptors have finished in double-digits this season, moving to 8-12 in those games.
- Immanuel Quickley** led Raptors scorers with 18 points, six assists, and two rebounds, going 8-for-15 from the field. Quickley has now recorded double digit points and five-or-more assists in a season-high three consecutive games. Quickley has finished in double-digit points in all but one road game this season, and has dished out 5+ assists in three of his last four games played on the road.
- RJ Barrett** added 16 points, five assists, and two rebounds against Indiana, marking his 25th game with 15+ points and 5+ assists this season, ranked second-most on the team, just behind **Scottie Barnes (29)**. Barrett is averaging 25.5 points, 7.0 rebounds, and 6.0 assists against Chicago this season.
- Jakob Poeltl** returned to the starting lineup after missing the previous eight games with a right hip pointer (Feb. 5-25). Poeltl finished with 10 points, five rebounds, and two assists on four-of-eight from the field in 24 minutes of action. Poeltl is now six defensive rebounds away from securing 2,500 on his career.
- Ochai Agbaji** made his first start since Feb. 11 at Philadelphia, recording 10 points, four rebounds, and one steal in 30 minutes of play. Agbaji is averaging 11.0 points, 3.9 rebounds, 1.7 assists and 30.1 minutes in 38 starts this season.
- Jonathan Mogbo** led all reserves for the fifth time this season with 16 points, just one point shy of tying his season-high. In 22 minutes off the bench, Mogbo added six rebounds, two steals, and a block. His 16 points against Indiana are his career high on the road.

- Averaging 18.5 points, 6.0 rebounds, 6.0 assists, and 33.3 minutes on the road this season.
- Shooting a team-best 53.1% among Raptors starters in last five games, going 43-of-81 from the field.
- Has recorded 5+ assists in 27 contests including 10+ seven times; Averaging career-high 5.6 assists.

F - OCHAI AGBAJI #30 MIN: 27.5 REB: 3.7 AST: 1.5 STL: 0.85 TO: 0.8 BLK: 0.53 PTS: 10.1

- Shooting a team-leading .556 (5-of-9) from the three-point field goal line in the Raptors' last three games.
- Has scored in double-digit points 29 times this season and is averaging a career-high 10.1 points per game.
- Shooting a perfect 7-of-7 from inside the arc against Chicago this season through two contests.

C - JAKOB POELTL #19 MIN: 30.7 REB: 10.0 AST: 2.8 STL: 1.13 TO: 1.9 BLK: 1.26 PTS: 14.1

- One of two players in the NBA with 400+ rebounds, 50+ steals and shooting over 60% from the field.
- Ranked seventh in the NBA in field-goal percentage (.608). Eighth straight season shooting 60% from the floor.
- Six blocks away from reaching 750 career blocks, ranks 10th in franchise history (288) in a Raptors jersey.

G - GRADEV DICK #1 MIN: 29.5 REB: 3.5 AST: 1.9 STL: 0.92 TO: 1.6 BLK: 0.19 PTS: 14.7

- Ranks fourth among all sophomores in total points scored (762) and third in three-point field goals (111).
- Has scored in double digits in 39 of 52 contests this season after doing so 24 times in rookie season.
- Averaging 20.0 point, 4.0 rebounds, 1.6 assists in two games against the Bulls this season.

G - IMMANUEL QUICKLEY #5 MIN: 28.1 REB: 3.2 AST: 5.7 STL: 0.55 TO: 1.8 BLK: 0.15 PTS: 15.9

- Has scored 15+ points in six of his last seven games, shooting 44.6% (45-of-101) in that span.
- Recorded five or more assists in 11 out of 20 total games played this season, averaging career-best 5.7.
- Averaged 21.2 points, 7.8 assists and 5.7 rebounds in 18 games following the All-Star break last season.

INDIANAPOLIS — Tyrese Haliburton had 33 points and 11 assists to help the Indiana Pacers beat the Toronto Raptors 111-91 on Wednesday night ... Haliburton was 12 of 15 from the field, going 7 of 9 from 3-point range ... Myles Turner added 18 points and 10 rebounds and Pascal Siakam had 15 points ... Immanuel Quickley scored 18 points for Toronto. RJ Barrett and Jonathan Mogbo each had 16 ... Haliburton scored 17 points in the first half to lead Indiana to a 51-41 lead ... Toronto played without Scottie Barnes because of a left hip contusion. He played Tuesday night against Boston ... Jakob Poeltl returned after being sidelined by a right hip injury since Feb. 4. He had 10 points and five rebounds in 24 minutes ... T.J. McConnell missed his second consecutive second game because of a sprained right ankle, leaving the Pacers short at point guard. The Pacers turned to RayJ Dennis when Andrew Nembhard picked up his fifth foul early in the fourth quarter ... After the Raptors closed to 97-86, Haliburton and Turner hit back-to-back 3-pointers to give the Pacers a 103-86 lead with 4:12 to go ... The Pacers were 15 of 36 from 3-point range compared to 6 of 27 for the Raptors.

TORONTO — Jaylen Brown scored 24 points, Derrick White had 22 and the Boston Celtics extended their winning streak to six games by beating the Toronto Raptors 111-101 on Tuesday night ... Payton Pritchard scored 20 points and Jayson Tatum had 19 points and 11 assists as the Celtics improved to 24-6 on the road ... RJ Barrett scored 22 points and Scottie Barnes had 21 but the Raptors lost for the seventh time in their past nine. Grady Dick scored 12 points and Immanuel Quickley added 10 ... Toronto finished 5 for 32 from 3-point range, its fewest made 3s of the season ... Kristaps Porzingis was scratched shortly before tip-off because of a non-COVID illness ... Torrey Craig replaced Porzingis in the starting lineup, his first start with Boston ... The Celtics were also without Jrue Holiday (rest), Al Horford (left big toe) and Luke Kornet (personal) ... Toronto snapped a 10-game losing streak against Boston when they last met on Jan. 15 but couldn't build on that victory in their latest encounter with the Atlantic leaders ... Toronto trailed by 17 early in the fourth but cut the deficit to seven, 102-95, on Jamal Shae'd's basket with 4:18 remaining. Tatum scored with 2:42 left, then stole the ball from Dick. White's sixth 3-pointer restored Boston's double-digit edge.

Toronto came in 0-23 in such games ... Dick had 10 points in the third, including two dunks, as the Raptors outscored Orlando 40-20 to turn a five-point halftime deficit into a 15-point advantage ... Paolo Banchero had 26 points and 12 rebounds for Orlando, which couldn't hold on after taking leads of 10-0 and 32-11 in the opening period ... The Magic have lost four straight ... The last time the Raptors trailed by at least 21 points in the first quarter and rallied to win was a 93-85 home victory over Dallas on Jan. 22, 2014 ... Kentavious Caldwell-Pope scored 20 points, Anthony Black had 17, and Wendell Carter Jr. fouled out with 10 points and 10 rebounds as the Magic lost for the sixth time in seven ... 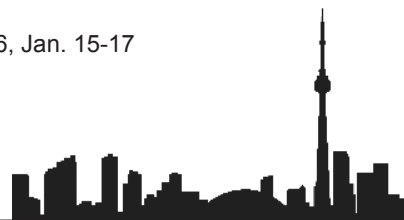

DARKO RAJAKOVIĆ

HEAD COACH

The passion Darko Rajaković (rye-AHK-oe-vich) has for the game of basketball has led him around the world. From Madrid, Spain to Tulsa, Oklahoma, each of these experiences have added to Rajaković's beliefs and philosophies, shaping him into the coach, father, and leader he is today.

Raised in Serbia during a civil war, Rajaković fell in love with basketball during a time of unrest in his homeland. The basketball court became his safe haven, a place where he and his friends could gather and play until the wee hours of the morning.

It was fitting Rajaković started his coaching career in his hometown of Cacak, Serbia. At just 16 years of age, he embarked on a life-long journey of teaching others a game that brought him such joy. This started with the local Borac Cacak Youth Team in 1996. After three seasons with the club, he was named the head coach of the U20 and U18 teams of Red Star Belgrade, leading Red Star to two Serbian Youth championships during his eight-year tenure (1999-2007).

Rajaković then ventured to Spain where he coached Espacio Torrelodones for three successful seasons (2009-12). In his first year with the franchise, he led the team to the championship of the Primera Division de Baloncesto in Madrid.

From 2004-11, Rajaković held his first formal job with an NBA team, serving as a European scouting consultant and NBA Summer League assistant coach for the San Antonio Spurs.

His time in Serbia, Spain and San Antonio ultimately led Rajaković to the Oklahoma City Thunder, where he spent seven seasons (2012-19). Rajaković joined the organization in 2012 as the head coach of the Tulsa 66ers – the franchise's then NBA G League affiliate, and became the first head coach born outside of North America in league history. Under his guidance, the team went 51-49 (.510) over two seasons and reached the 2013 G League semifinals. In 2014, Rajaković was honoured as one of Oklahoma City's assistant coaches at the NBA All-Star game in New Orleans.

Rajaković transitioned from the G League to the NBA at the start of the 2014-15 campaign, in what would be his first of five seasons as an assistant coach with the Thunder (2014-19). Oklahoma City averaged 49 wins during his time on the coaching staff and earned four playoff appearances - including a trip to the 2016 Western Conference Finals.

Rajaković also spent time in the NBA as an assistant coach with the Phoenix Suns (2019-20) and Memphis Grizzlies (2020-23), before being named the 10th head coach in Toronto Raptors history in June of 2023.

On the international stage, Rajaković was as an assistant coach for Serbia at the 2019 FIBA

World Cup in China, helping his country to a fifth place finish at the tournament, which included a win over the United States in the classification round.

Rajaković prides himself on being a life-long learner. He earned a basketball coaching degree from the Belgrade Basketball Academy in 2004 and a degree in sports management from Alfa BK University in Belgrade in 2006.

He and his wife, Gaga, reside in Toronto with their son, Luka.
