TEAM NOTES

- The **Toronto Raptors** are set to host the Brooklyn Nets at Scotiabank Arena for the sixth and final game of the pre-season. The Raptors enter play with a 3-2 record after splitting their two-game road trip (Oct. 12-15) with Washington and Boston. Toronto will begin their 2025-26 campaign on the road against the Atlanta Hawks next Wednesday (Oct. 22) and will return home to host the Milwaukee Bucks for their home opener on Friday (Oct. 24).
- Brandon Ingram** scored a team-high 20 points (8-22 FG, 2-5 3PT, 2-2 FT) on Wednesday against the Celtics and added a team-high tying 10 rebounds in a team-high 32 minutes of action. He has scored 20+ points in consecutive games and in two of three games played in thie pre-season.
- Toronto acquired Ingram from New Orleans on Feb. 6 and signed a contract extension on Feb. 12. Ingram joined the Raptors following six seasons in New Orleans where he averaged 23.0 points, 5.5 rebounds, 5.2 assists and shot .472 from the field, including .372 (560-1506) from three-point range. He averaged more than 20.0 points in all six seasons and was named an NBA All-Star in 2020. Ingram also captured the NBA's Most Improved Player Award that same season.
- The Raptors announced Thursday they have waived two-way centre Ulrich Chomche, guard Jared Rhoden, forward David Roddy and centre Olivier Sarr.
- Toronto announced Friday they have signed forward **Julian Reese**. He averaged 11.1 points, 7.6 rebounds and 26.4 minutes in 134 career games (102 starts) across four seasons at Maryland. He ranks second on the Terrapins' all-time rebounds list (1,015) and joined Len Elmore as the only players in program history to total at least 1,000 points and 1,000 in their career.
- The Raptors' roster now stands at 17 including two two-way players.

- Missed the final 58 games of the season (Dec. 8 - Apr. 13) due to a left ankle sprain.
- Acquired from New Orleans in exchange for Bruce Brown, Kelly Olynyk, first and second round draft picks.
- Signed multi-year extension with the Raptors on Feb. 12.

F - RJ BARRETT #9 MIN: 32.2 REB: 6.3 AST: 5.4 STL: 0.79 TO: 2.9 BLK: 0.29 PTS: 21.1

- Averaged career-high 5.4 assists last year; Has averaged 6+ rebounds and 20+ points in consecutive seasons.
- Became the second-youngest Canadian to reach the 7,000 career point milestone.
- Was one of four in the Eastern Conference and one of eight in the NBA to average 20/6/5 last season.

C - JAKOB POELTL #19 MIN: 29.6 REB: 9.6 AST: 2.8 STL: 1.16 TO: 1.9 BLK: 1.25 PTS: 14.5

- Averaged career highs of 14.5 points, 9.6 rebounds, 1.2 steals and 29.6 minutes this season.
- Ranked fifth overall in the NBA in field goal % (.627) last season; Eighth straight season shooting at least .600.
- Finished as only one of two players in the league to shoot 60%+ from the field and record 60+ steals.

G - SCOTTIE BARNES #4 MIN: 32.8 REB: 7.7 AST: 5.8 STL: 1.43 TO: 2.8 BLK: 0.97 PTS: 19.3

- Only player in the NBA to finish with 500+ rebounds, 300+ assists, 90+ steals and 60+ blocks in 2024-25.
- Became the fastest player in franchise history to reach 2,000+ rebounds and 1,000+ assists (267 games).
- Set single-season bests in double-doubles (26) total points scored (1,252) and in total assists dished (378).

G - IMMANUEL QUICKLEY #5 MIN: 27.8 REB: 3.5 AST: 5.8 STL: 0.70 TO: 1.8 BLK: 0.12 PTS: 17.1

- Averaging career highs of 17.9 points, 6.3 assists and 30.7 minutes in 71 career games with Toronto.
- Recorded 191 assists last season marking the most through first 33 games of a season in career.
- Missed 39 games last year including 22 contests due to a partial UCL tear in the left elbow.

After jumping out to a 27-22 first-quarter lead, Atlanta went cold from the field in the second quarter, shooting 32 per cent, Toronto outscored the Hawks 33-21 on 54 per cent shooting over that span ... Toronto overcame a slow first quarter by shooting 54 per cent from the field in both the second and third quarters ... The Raptors also hit 50 per cent of their shots from 3-point range during the span.

MILWAUKEE — Giannis Antetokounmpo had 35 points and 12 rebounds to lead the Milwaukee Bucks to a 130-112 victory over the Toronto Raptors on Friday night ... Damian Lillard added 26 points and eight assists for Milwaukee, which swept the three-game season series from Toronto ... Bobby Portis scored 15 and Khris Middleton had 13 points in 24 minutes off the bench ... Antetokounmpo posted his 12th straight double-double, the second-longest active streak in the NBA ... The Bucks attempted 41 free throws and made 33 as Toronto committed 31 fouls ... RJ Barrett led the Raptors with 21 points and 10 assists ... Bruce Brown scored 17 ... Toronto cut an early 20-point deficit in half after scoring the first six points of the fourth quarter to trail 107-97, but the Bucks made another push to seal their third straight win ... Toronto had won two in a row at home — beating Golden State and Boston — following a 10-game losing streak ... Scottie Barnes went 1 for 11 from the field and 0 of 5 from 3-point range in the first half while picking up three fouls guarding Antetokounmpo ... Barnes finished with 10 points and 10 rebounds but was 4-of-16 shooting and 0 for 6 from beyond the arc ... Toronto challenged a foul call on Barnes with 3.9 seconds left in the first half but lost, resulting in three free throws by Lillard. Milwaukee held a 72-57 halftime lead.

ADDITIONAL TEAM NOTES ...

- Maple Leafs Sports and Entertainment further extended the contract of Raptors General Bobby Webster on Aug. 18.
- The Raptors signed centre Jakob Poeltl to a multi-year contract extension on Jul. 8. Poeltl averaged career highs of 14.5 points, 9.6 rebounds and 29.6 minutes in 57 games (56 starts) last season. He ranked fifth in the NBA with a .627 (363-579) field goal percentage, his eighth consecutive season shooting better than 60 percent from the floor.
- Toronto selected forward Collin Murray-Boyles with the ninth overall pick in the first round of the 2025 NBA Draft. Murray-Boyles, 6-foot-7, 239 pounds, was an All-SEC Second Team selection after averaging 16.8 points, 8.3 rebounds, 2.4 assists and 30.6 minutes in 32 games (all starts) as a sophomore at South Carolina last season.
- The Raptors also selected guard Alijah Martin with the 39th overall pick (second round) in the 2025 NBA Draft. Martin, 6-foot-2, 208 pounds, was drafted following one season at the University of Florida, where he helped the Gators capture the 2025 national championship. He averaged 14.4 points, 4.5 rebounds, 2.2 assists, 1.5 steals and 30.4 minutes in 38 games (36 starts). Martin shot .452 (189-418) from the field, including 35 percent (79-226) from three-point range.

DARKO RAJAKOVIĆ

HEAD COACH

The passion Darko Rajaković (rye-AHK-oe-vich) has for the game of basketball has led him around the world. From Madrid, Spain to Tulsa, Oklahoma, each of these experiences have added to Rajaković's beliefs and philosophies, shaping him into the coach, father, and leader he is today.

Raised in Serbia during a civil war, Rajaković fell in love with basketball during a time of unrest in his homeland. The basketball court became his safe haven, a place where he and his friends could gather and play until the wee hours of the morning.

It was fitting Rajaković started his coaching career in his hometown of Cacak, Serbia. At just 16 years of age, he embarked on a life-long journey of teaching others a game that brought him such joy. This started with the local Borac Cacak Youth Team in 1996. After three seasons with the club, he was named the head coach of the U20 and U18 teams of Red Star Belgrade, leading Red Star to two Serbian Youth championships during his eight-year tenure (1999-2007)

Rajaković then ventured to Spain where he coached Espacio Torrelodones for three successful seasons (2009-12). In his first year with the franchise, he led the team to the championship of the Primera Division de Baloncesto in Madrid

From 2004-11, Rajaković held his first formal job with an NBA team, serving as a European scouting consultant and NBA Summer League assistant coach for the San Antonio Spurs.

His time in Serbia, Spain and San Antonio ultimately led Rajaković to the Oklahoma City Thunder, where he spent seven seasons (2012-19). Rajaković joined the organization in 2012 as the head coach of the Tulsa 66ers – the franchise's then NBA G League affiliate and became the first head coach born outside of North America in league history. Under his guidance, the team went 51-49 (.510) over two seasons and reached the 2013 G League semifinals. In 2014, Rajaković was honoured as one of Oklahoma City's assistant coaches at the NBA All-Star game in New Orleans.

Rajaković transitioned from the G League to the NBA at the start of the 2014-15 campaign, in what would be his first of five seasons as an assistant coach with the Thunder (2014-19). Oklahoma City averaged 49 wins during his time on the coaching staff and earned four playoff appearances - including a trip to the 2016 Western Conference Finals.

Rajaković also spent time in the NBA as an assistant coach with the Phoenix Suns (2019-20) and Memphis Grizzlies (2020-23), before being named the 10th head coach in Toronto Raptors history in June of 2023.

On the international stage, Rajaković was as an assistant coach for Serbia at the 2019 FIBA World Cup in China, helping his country to a fifth place finish at the tournament, which included a win over the United States in the classification round.

Rajaković prides himself on being a life-long learner. He earned a basketball coaching degree from the Belgrade Basketball Academy in 2004 and a degree in sports management from Alfa BK University in Belgrade in 2006.

He and his wife, Gaga, reside in Toronto with their son, Luka.
