KEY STAT

Led by Giannis Antetokounmpo's 20 rebounds, the Milwaukee Bucks outrebounded the Toronto Raptors 51 to 41. Antetokounmpo is one of four players to have a 30-point, 20-rebound game against the Raptors and was the most recent player to achieve this feat before tonight (January 4, 2023).

RAPTORS NOTES

- The Toronto Raptors fell 122-116 to the Milwaukee Bucks in their second game of the season, and their first game at home. Toronto has now dropped four straight games against Milwaukee, including three at home. They will now travel to Dallas where they will face the Mavericks on Sunday for their first back-to-back set of the season, facing the Spurs on the road Monday night.
- Brandon Ingram made his regular season debut in a Raptors jersey and finished with 29 points, six rebounds, and three assists. Ingram's 29 points (10-20 FGM) are the second-most a Raptor has scored in their debut at home in franchise history, just behind Alvin Robertson on Nov. 3, 1995. This was also Ingram's first 20+ point game since Dec. 5, 2024 with New Orleans.
- Immanuel Quickley finished with 19 points, a game-high eight assists, and grabbed seven rebounds. He has dished out eight-or-more assists in consecutive games for the first time since he did it in three straight (Mar. 28 Apr. 4).
- RJ Barrett added 20 points on .750 shooting from the field (9-12 FGM) and six rebounds. Barrett has scored 20+ points in two straight games for the first time since he did it for three consecutive games from Mar. 2-8.
- Scottie Barnes added 17 points, eight of which came in the third quarter. He grabbed five rebounds, three assists, and three steals.
- Jamison Battle fired off a perfect three-for-three from beyond the arc to lead the bench with nine points. Last season,
 Battle made 3+ three-point field goals in 20 games, ranked second-most among rookies and a team-high.

BUCKS NOTES

- The Milwaukee Bucks are improve to 2-0 to start the season after defeating the Raptors 122-116 on Friday evening.
 Milwaukee has now four consecutive games against Toronto and three straight at Scotiabank Arena. The Bucks will end their two-game road trip (Oct. 24-26) against the Cleveland Cavaliers on Sunday ahead of their three-game homestand (Oct. 28 Nov. 1).
- The Bucks shot 52.2% (47-90) from the field tonight and have now shot 50%-or-better in two straight games. They did so 32 times last season and finished with a 25-7 record in those games which was eighth-most in the league last season.
- Giannis Antetokounmpo recorded game highs of 31 points (11-14 FG) and 20 rebounds while adding seven assists
 and one block in 38 minutes of action. He has recorded a double-double in consecutive games to start the season,
 something he did in nine straight games (Oct. 23 Nov. 10) to start the season last year. Antetokounmpo ranked
 fifth in the league last season in double-doubles with 55.
- Former Raptor Gary Trent Jr. scored 20 points shooting 7-15 from the field in 29 minutes of play. He averaged 11.1 points, 3.3 rebounds, 1.2 assists and 25.6 minutes in 74 games (nine starts) with the Bucks last season.
- Cole Anthony led all reserves with 23 points (9-14 FG) and added seven assists, four rebounds and two steals in 27 minutes. He scored 23 of the Bucks' 45 bench points. Milwaukee outscored the Raptors 45-to-25 (+20) in bench points.
- Kyle Kuzma recorded eight points (4-5 FG) in 18 minutes off the bench before leaving the game due to a left ankle sprain in the third quarter.
