TEAM NOTES

- The **Toronto Raptors** begin a brief road trip for their first back-to-back set of the regular season, starting in Dallas for a Sunday night matchup against the Mavericks. Toronto is looking to snap a three-game skid against Dallas, including one on the road. Last season, the Raptors went 6-24 (.200) in back-to-backs, and 3-12 (.200) in the first game of each set.
- **Toronto** opened their 2025-26 home campaign with a 122-116 loss to the Milwaukee Bucks, despite a double-digit comeback in the second quarter. The Bucks outrebounded the Raptors 51-to-41, but Toronto improved to .407 from beyond the arc after shooting .286 against the Atlanta Hawks in their season opener on Oct. 22.
- **Brandon Ingram** made his home debut in a Raptors jersey and scored a team-high 29 points, adding six rebounds and three assists. Ingram's 29 points (10-20 FGM) are the second-most a Raptor has scored in their debut at home in franchise history, just behind Alvin Robertson on Nov. 3, 1995. This was also his first 20+ point game since Dec. 5, 2024.
- **RJ Barrett** continued his scoring streak, adding 20 points on .750 shooting from the field (9-12 FGM) and six rebounds. Barrett has scored 20-or-more points in two straight games for the first time since he did it for three consecutive games from Mar. 2-8.
- **Immanuel Quickley** and **Scottie Barnes** combined for 36 points on the night. **Quickley** dished out a game-high eight assists and grabbed seven rebounds. Quickley has now recorded eight-or-more assists in consecutive games to start the season, and the first time since he did it in three straight games last season (Mar. 28 – Apr. 4). Eight of **Barnes'** 17 points came within the third quarter, along with five rebounds, three assists, and three steals.

- Acquired from New Orleans in exchange for Bruce Brown, Kelly Olynyk, first and second round draft picks.
- Signed multi-year extension with the Raptors on Feb. 12.

G - SCOTTIE BARNES #4 MIN: 33.8 REB: 5.5 AST: 6.0 STL: 2.00 TO: 2.0 BLK: 1.00 PTS: 19.5

- Only player in the NBA to finish with 500+ rebounds, 300+ assists, 90+ steals and 60+ blocks in 2024-25.
- Became the fastest player in franchise history to reach 2,000+ rebounds and 1,000+ assists (267 games).
- Set single-season bests in double-doubles (26) total points scored (1,252) and in total assists dished (378).

C - JAKOB POELTL #19 MIN: 24.5 REB: 5.5 AST: 2.0 STL: --- TO: 1.5 BLK: 0.50 PTS: 10.0

- Begins the season shooting .769 from the field, was ranked fifth in the NBA in field goal % (.627) last season.
- Averaged career highs of 14.5 points, 9.6 rebounds, 1.2 steals and 29.6 minutes during the 2024-25 season.
- Finished as only one of two players in the league to shoot 60%+ from the field and record 60+ steals.

G - RJ BARRETT #9 MIN: 31.4 REB: 7.0 AST: 3.5 STL: 2.00 TO: 3.0 BLK: 1.00 PTS: 22.5

- Has 30 games as a Raptor with at least 20 pts, 5 reb, and 5 ast, ranked ninth overall in franchise history.
- Averaged career-high 5.4 assists last year; Has averaged 6+ rebounds and 20+ points in consecutive seasons.
- Became the second-youngest Canadian to reach the 7,000 career point milestone.

G - IMMANUEL QUICKLEY #5 MIN: 32.6 REB: 5.5 AST: 8.0 STL: 1.50 TO: 2.5 BLK: --- PTS: 16.0

- Averaging a team-high eight assists through the first two games of the 2025-26 NBA regular season.
- Recorded 191 assists last season, marking the most through first 33 games of a season in career.
- Missed 39 games last year including 22 contests due to a partial UCL tear in the left elbow.

Antetokounmpo, who scored 37 points in Milwaukee's opener at home, gave the Raptors fits, using his combination of strength and speed to bully the defense in the paint ... He was 11 of 14 from the field, and only attempted two shots outside the paint ... Gary Trent Jr added 20 points for Milwaukee ... Brandon Ingram scored 29 points in his home debut for Toronto ... RJ Barrett added 20 points ... Bucks forward Kyle Kuzma left early in the fourth because of a sprained left ankle ... He didn't return.

ATLANTA — RJ Barrett scored 25 points and Brandon Ingram added 16 points and nine rebounds in his Toronto debut as the Raptors ran away from the Atlanta Hawks for a 138-118 victory Wednesday night in the season opener for both teams ... Scottie Barnes had 22 points and nine assists and Grady Dick scored 21 off the bench for the Raptors, who set a franchise record for points on opening night and surpassed last season's high ... Toronto shot 57% from the field, including 69% on 2-pointers ... Ingram shot 7 of 16 from the floor Wednesday and had three assists and two steals ... Hawks forward Jalen Johnson, who missed the final 38 games last season with a shoulder injury, had 22 points, eight assists and seven rebounds ... Trae Young finished with 22 points, but he was 1 for 7 from 3-point range ... The Raptors used a 14-0 run at the end of the third quarter to stretch a nine-point lead to 23 and effectively put the game out of reach ... Five players scored during the spurt, led by five points from Dick ... Kristaps Porzingas, acquired in a trade with Boston during the offseason, had 20 points, seven rebounds and two blocks in his Hawks debut.

DALLAS — Anthony Davis had 23 points, 13 rebounds and 10 assists for his fourth career triple-double, and the Dallas Mavericks beat the Toronto Raptors 124-102 on Friday night to snap a three-game losing streak ... Davis also had a season-high seven blocks ... Reserves Max Christie and Brandon Williams scored 17 points each as the Mavericks pulled away in the second quarter, outscoring the Raptors 31-13. Dallas led by as many as 38 points ... Scottie Barnes scored 26 points and Ochai Agbaji added 24, matching a career high with six 3-pointers, for the Raptors (30-51) ... The Mavericks enjoyed a 16-0 run in the second quarter and led 66-38 at halftime. Dallas shot 65% in the quarter while Toronto shot 19.4%, missing all nine 3-point attempts and going five minutes without a field goal ... Agbaji scored 17 points in the first period to match a team high for a quarter this season ... They dressed a season-low eight players and played seven with starters RJ Barrett and Immanuel Quickley added to the injury report for "rest" with one game remaining ... While Barnes and Agbaji combined to shoot 12 of 20 during the first half, the other five Raptors who played shot 3 of 31.

Scottie Barnes had 35 points for Toronto ... Jamison Battle had 25 points and Jonathan Mogbo added nine points, 14 rebounds and 10 assists ... San Antonio's Harrison Barnes had 18 points and Chris Paul 15 ... Barnes and Paul along with Julian Champagnie played every game this season ... Castle, a leading contender for rookie of the year, added eight rebounds and six assists ... Toronto missed the postseason for the third straight season and fourth in five ... San Antonio has not made the postseason since 2019, when they tied an NBA record with 22 straight appearances ... San Antonio trailed 76-54 early in the third quarter ... ADDITIONAL TEAM NOTES ...

- Maple Leafs Sports and Entertainment further extended the contract of Raptors General Bobby Webster on Aug. 18.
- The Raptors signed centre Jakob Poeltl to a multi-year contract extension on Jul. 8. Poeltl averaged career highs of 14.5 points, 9.6 rebounds and 29.6 minutes in 57 games (56 starts) last season. He ranked fifth in the NBA with a .627 (363-579) field goal percentage, his eighth consecutive season shooting better than 60 percent from the floor.
- Toronto selected forward Collin Murray-Boyles with the ninth overall pick in the first round of the 2025 NBA Draft. Murray-Boyles, 6-foot-7, 239 pounds, was an All-SEC Second Team selection after averaging 16.8 points, 8.3 rebounds, 2.4 assists and 30.6 minutes in 32 games (all starts) as a sophomore at South Carolina last season.
- The Raptors also selected guard Alijah Martin with the 39th overall pick (second round) in the 2025 NBA Draft. Martin, 6-foot-2, 208 pounds, was drafted following one season at the University of Florida, where he helped the Gators capture the 2025 national championship. He averaged 14.4 points, 4.5 rebounds, 2.2 assists, 1.5 steals and 30.4 minutes in 38 games (36 starts). Martin shot .452 (189-418) from the field, including 35 percent (79-226) from three-point range.
- Last season, the Raptors set franchise records including a single-game record for total rebounds with 73 boards on Mar. 10 vs. Washington. Toronto finished with 3,700 total rebounds on the season which is third-most in franchise history. Toronto finished 10th in the league in total rebounds and in rebounds per game (45.1).
- The Raptors also broke the single-season franchise record in total assists on the last game of the season finishing with 2,340 assists and surpassing the previous franchise record of 2,335 that was set following the 2023-24.

DARKO RAJAKOVIĆ

HEAD COACH

The passion Darko Rajaković (rye-AHK-oe-vich) has for the game of basketball has led him around the world. From Madrid, Spain to Tulsa, Oklahoma, each of these experiences have added to Rajaković's beliefs and philosophies, shaping him into the coach, father, and leader he is today.

Raised in Serbia during a civil war, Rajaković fell in love with basketball during a time of unrest in his homeland. The basketball court became his safe haven, a place where he and his friends could gather and play until the wee hours of the morning.

It was fitting Rajaković started his coaching career in his hometown of Cacak, Serbia. At just 16 years of age, he embarked on a life-long journey of teaching others a game that brought him such joy. This started with the local Borac Cacak Youth Team in 1996. After three seasons with the club, he was named the head coach of the U20 and U18 teams of Red Star Belgrade, leading Red Star to two Serbian Youth championships during his eight-year tenure (1999-2007)

Rajaković then ventured to Spain where he coached Espacio Torrelodones for three successful seasons (2009-12). In his first year with the franchise, he led the team to the championship of the Primera Division de Baloncesto in Madrid

From 2004-11, Rajaković held his first formal job with an NBA team, serving as a European scouting consultant and NBA Summer League assistant coach for the San Antonio Spurs.

His time in Serbia, Spain and San Antonio ultimately led Rajaković to the Oklahoma City Thunder, where he spent seven seasons (2012-19). Rajaković joined the organization in 2012 as the head coach of the Tulsa 66ers – the franchise's then NBA G League affiliate and became the first head coach born outside of North America in league history. Under his guidance, the team went 51-49 (.510) over two seasons and reached the 2013 G League semifinals. In 2014, Rajaković was honoured as one of Oklahoma City's assistant coaches at the NBA All-Star game in New Orleans.

Rajaković transitioned from the G League to the NBA at the start of the 2014-15 campaign, in what would be his first of five seasons as an assistant coach with the Thunder (2014-19). Oklahoma City averaged 49 wins during his time on the coaching staff and earned four playoff appearances - including a trip to the 2016 Western Conference Finals.

Rajaković also spent time in the NBA as an assistant coach with the Phoenix Suns (2019-20) and Memphis Grizzlies (2020-23), before being named the 10th head coach in Toronto Raptors history in June of 2023.

On the international stage, Rajaković was as an assistant coach for Serbia at the 2019 FIBA World Cup in China, helping his country to a fifth place finish at the tournament, which included a win over the United States in the classification round.

Rajaković prides himself on being a life-long learner. He earned a basketball coaching degree from the Belgrade Basketball Academy in 2004 and a degree in sports management from Alfa BK University in Belgrade in 2006.

He and his wife, Gaga, reside in Toronto with their son, Luka.
