TEAM NOTES

- The **Toronto Raptors** are in San Antonio to take on the Spurs at Frost Bank Arena for the second game of a back-to-back set in Texas. The Raptors are looking to snap a two-game (Oct. 24-26) losing streak after falling to the Dallas Mavericks 139-129 last night. Toronto will play its third straight Texas team on Wednesday when they host the Houston Rockets.
- Toronto is looking for their first win in San Antonio since Nov. 5, 2023, which capped a six-game winning streak against the Spurs. The Raptors have since lost three straight.
- Last season, Raptors forward **Scottie Barnes** averaged 28.5 points, 8.5 rebounds, 7.0 assists, 1.0 steal and 33.1 minutes in both games against San Antonio. He shot 67.6% (23-34) from the field, including 62.5% (5-8) from beyond the arc.
- Barnes recorded 33 points, 11 rebounds, six assists and one steal in 34 minutes against the Mavericks on Sunday. He tied Vince Carter for the second-most 30/10/5 games in franchise history behind Pascal Siakam (16). Barnes also passed Kyle Lowry for fourth-most 30-point double-doubles in Raptors history with 11 such games.
- Sandro Mamukelashvili makes his return to San Antonio where he averaged 6.2 points, 3.8 rebounds, 1.1 assists and 12.5 minutes in 126 games over three seasons. He led all reserves with 16 points (6-8 FG, 3-3 FT) on Sunday leading the team in bench points for the first time this season something he did six times with the Spurs last season.
- Toronto, who has recorded 25+ assists in the first three games of the season and 30+ assists twice, leads the league in total assists (94) and are third in assists per game (31.3).

- Scored game-high 33 points and added 11 rebounds at Dallas for first double-double of the season.
- Recorded 80th career double-double; Becomes fourth Raptor 24-or-younger to reach 80+ double-doubles.
- Only player in the NBA to finish with 500+ rebounds, 300+ assists, 90+ steals and 60+ blocks in 2024-25.

C - JAKOB POELTL #19 MIN: 22.6 REB: 6.3 AST: 2.7 STL: 0.33 TO: 1.3 BLK: 0.33 PTS: 8.0

- Finished with four points, eight rebounds, four assists and one steal in 19 minutes of action against Mavericks.
- Averaged career highs of 14.5 points, 9.6 rebounds, 1.2 steals and 29.6 minutes during the 2024-25 season.
- Finished last season as one of two players in the league to shoot 60%+ from the field and record 60+ steals.

G - RJ BARRETT #9 MIN: 30.3 REB: 6.0 AST: 3.3 STL: 1.33 TO: 2.3 BLK: 0.67 PTS: 20.3

- Recorded 16 points, four rebounds and three assists in 28 minutes on Sunday evening.
- Needs 20 points to reach 2,000 career points as a Raptor, Would be first to do so in first 94 games with Toronto.
- Averaged career-high 5.4 assists last year; Has averaged 6+ rebounds and 20+ points in consecutive seasons.

G - IMMANUEL QUICKLEY #5 MIN: 32.3 REB: 5.3 AST: 7.0 STL: 1.67 TO: 2.0 BLK: 0.00 PTS: 15.3

- Had 14 points, five rebounds, five assists and two steals in 32 minutes of play in Dallas.
- Averaging a team-high 7.0 assists through the first three games of the 2025-26 season.
- Missed 39 games last year including 22 contests due to a partial UCL tear in the left elbow.

San Antonio's Harrison Barnes had 18 points and Chris Paul 15 ... Barnes and Paul along with Julian Champagnie played every game this season ... Castle, a leading contender for rookie of the year, added eight rebounds and six assists ... Toronto missed the postseason for the third straight season and fourth in five ... San Antonio has not made the postseason since 2019, when they tied an NBA record with 22 straight appearances ... San Antonio trailed 76-54 early in the third quarter ... It won for just the second time this season when trailing by 20 points ... The Spurs trailed by 20 points in 34% of their games this season, finishing 2-26 when facing that deficit.

The Rockets were without Fred VanVleet for a fifth straight game because of an ankle injury and Steven Adams was out because they played Saturday ... All-Star Alperen Sengun left in the first quarter with back spasms ... Jeff Green and Jock Landale filled in for Sengun and Green had a season-high 14 points while Landale added 11 with a season-best 10 rebounds ... Immanuel Quickley had 20 points for the Raptors, who lost a fourth straight ... Toronto missed Gradey Dick in the second half after he left the game with a neck bruise following a collision with Amen Thompson near the end of the second quarter ... Dick, who averages 15.6 points, didn't score before exiting the game ... The Rockets trailed by four early in the fourth quarter when Jamison Battle was called for a foul on Jeff Green ... The play was reviewed and upgraded to a flagrant 1 foul after officials ruled Battle hit Green in the groin area ... Green made both free throws to start the big run that gave Houston the lead for good ... The Raptors made just 8 of 42 3-pointers.

ADDITIONAL TEAM NOTES ...

- Maple Leafs Sports and Entertainment further extended the contract of Raptors General Bobby Webster on Aug. 18.
- The Raptors signed centre Jakob Poeltl to a multi-year contract extension on Jul. 8. Poeltl averaged career highs of 14.5 points, 9.6 rebounds and 29.6 minutes in 57 games (56 starts) last season. He ranked fifth in the NBA with a .627 (363-579) field goal percentage, his eighth consecutive season shooting better than 60 percent from the floor.
- Toronto selected forward Collin Murray-Boyles with the ninth overall pick in the first round of the 2025 NBA Draft. Murray-Boyles, 6-foot-7, 239 pounds, was an All-SEC Second Team selection after averaging 16.8 points, 8.3 rebounds, 2.4 assists and 30.6 minutes in 32 games (all starts) as a sophomore at South Carolina last season.
- The Raptors also selected guard Alijah Martin with the 39th overall pick (second round) in the 2025 NBA Draft. Martin, 6-foot-2, 208 pounds, was drafted following one season at the University of Florida, where he helped the Gators capture the 2025 national championship. He averaged 14.4 points, 4.5 rebounds, 2.2 assists, 1.5 steals and 30.4 minutes in 38 games (36 starts). Martin shot .452 (189-418) from the field, including 35 percent (79-226) from three-point range.
- Last season, the Raptors set franchise records including a single-game record for total rebounds with 73 boards on Mar. 10 vs. Washington.
 Toronto finished with 3,700 total rebounds on the season which is thirdmost in franchise history. Toronto finished 10th in the league in total rebounds and in rebounds per game (45.1).
- The Raptors also broke the single-season franchise record in total assists on the last game of the season finishing with 2,340 assists and surpassing the previous franchise record of 2,335 that was set following the 2023-24.

DARKO RAJAKOVIĆ

HEAD COACH

The passion Darko Rajaković (rye-AHK-oe-vich) has for the game of basketball has led him around the world. From Madrid, Spain to Tulsa, Oklahoma, each of these experiences have added to Rajaković's beliefs and philosophies, shaping him into the coach, father, and leader he is today.

Raised in Serbia during a civil war, Rajaković fell in love with basketball during a time of unrest in his homeland. The basketball court became his safe haven, a place where he and his friends could gather and play until the wee hours of the morning.

It was fitting Rajaković started his coaching career in his hometown of Cacak, Serbia. At just 16 years of age, he embarked on a lifelong journey of teaching others a game that brought him such joy. This started with the local Borac Cacak Youth Team in 1996. After three seasons with the club, he was named the head coach of the U20 and U18 teams of Red Star Belgrade, leading Red Star to two Serbian Youth championships during his eight-year tenure (1999-2007)

Rajaković then ventured to Spain where he coached Espacio Torrelodones for three successful seasons (2009-12). In his first year with the franchise, he led the team to the championship of the Primera Division de Baloncesto in Madrid

From 2004-11, Rajaković held his first formal job with an NBA team, serving as a European scouting consultant and NBA Summer League assistant coach for the San Antonio Spurs.

His time in Serbia, Spain and San Antonio ultimately led Rajaković to the Oklahoma City Thunder, where he spent seven seasons (2012-19). Rajaković joined the organization in 2012 as the head coach of the Tulsa 66ers – the franchise's then NBA G League affiliate and became the first head coach born outside of North America in league history. Under his guidance, the team went 51-49 (.510) over two seasons and reached the 2013 G League semifinals. In 2014, Rajaković was honoured as one of Oklahoma City's assistant coaches at the NBA All-Star game in New Orleans.

Rajaković transitioned from the G League to the NBA at the start of the 2014-15 campaign, in what would be his first of five seasons as an assistant coach with the Thunder (2014-19). Oklahoma City averaged 49 wins during his time on the coaching staff and earned four playoff appearances - including a trip to the 2016 Western Conference Finals.

Rajaković also spent time in the NBA as an assistant coach with the Phoenix Suns (2019-20) and Memphis Grizzlies (2020-23), before being named the 10th head coach in Toronto Raptors history in June of 2023.

On the international stage, Rajaković was as an assistant coach for Serbia at the 2019 FIBA World Cup in China, helping his country to a fifth place finish at the tournament, which included a win over the United States in the classification round.

Rajaković prides himself on being a life-long learner. He earned a basketball coaching degree from the Belgrade Basketball Academy in 2004 and a degree in sports management from Alfa BK University in Belgrade in 2006.

He and his wife, Gaga, reside in Toronto with their son, Luka.
