TEAM NOTES

- The **Toronto Raptors** are set to play just their second home game of the 2025-26 campaign by hosting the Houston Rockets at Scotiabank Arena. Wednesday's contest marks the first of two games against the Rockets this season. Toronto fell in the most recent game at Scotiabank Arena against Houston but had won four straight at home prior to last year.
- The Raptors are looking to snap their three-game losing streak (Oct. 24-27) after falling to the San Antonio Spurs on Monday night in the second game of a back-to-back. Toronto will end the month of October on the road by taking on the Cleveland Cavaliers on Halloween.
- RJ Barrett** scored a team-high 25 points on 9-for-18 (.500) shooting Monday against the Spurs. He has now scored 20+ points in three of the first four games of the season averaging a team-high 21.5 points while shooting 61.8% (34-55) from the field, including 35.3% (6-17) from beyond the arc. Barrett joins teammates Brandon Ingram (20.3) and Scottie Barnes (20.0) as Raptors to average 20+ points to start the 2025-26 season.
- Raptors rookie **Collin Murray-Boyles** played in his second career NBA game on Monday and led all reserves with 19 points while adding three steals and one block in 24 minutes. He is the fifth rookie in Raptors history to record 15+ points, three steals and one block off the bench. Murray-Boyles was selected ninth overall by the Raptors in the 2025 NBA Draft following his sophomore season at South Carolina, where he averaged 16.8 points, 8.3 rebounds, 2.4 assists and 30.6 minutes in 32 games (all starts).
- Toronto has now recorded 25+ assists in four straight games (Oct. 22-27) totalling 123 in that span, which ranks second across the league behind the Golden State Warriors (146).

- Recorded 14 points, five assists and three rebounds in 32 minutes of play on Monday night.
- One of three Raptors to average 20+ points to start the season (RJ Barrett and Scottie Barnes).
- Acquired from New Orleans in exchange for Bruce Brown, Kelly Olynyk, first and second round draft picks.

F - SCOTTIE BARNES #4 MIN: 32.8 REB: 6.3 AST: 5.0 STL: 1.25 TO: 2.8 BLK: 0.75 PTS: 20.0

- Posted eight points, three rebounds and two assists in 30 minutes against the San Antonio Spurs.
- Became the fourth Raptor 24 years of age or younger to reach 80+ double-doubles.
- Only player in the NBA to finish with 500+ rebounds, 300+ assists, 90+ steals and 60+ blocks in 2024-25.

C - JAKOB POELTL #19 MIN: 23.0 REB: 5.3 AST: 2.3 STL: 0.25 TO: 2.0 BLK: 0.50 PTS: 6.5

- Finished with two points, two rebounds, one assist and one block in 24 minutes vs. Spurs.
- Averaged career highs of 14.5 points, 9.6 rebounds, 1.2 steals and 29.6 minutes during the 2024-25 season.
- Finished last season as one of two players in the league to shoot 60%+ from the field and record 60+ steals.

G - RJ BARRETT #9 MIN: 30.7 REB: 5.0 AST: 3.0 STL: 1.25 TO: 2.3 BLK: 0.50 PTS: 21.5

- Scored a game-high 24 points and added a pair of rebounds and assists in 32 minutes on Monday.
- Joins Vince Carter as the only two players to score 2,000 career points as a Raptor in under 100 games.
- Averaged career-high 5.4 assists last year; Has averaged 6+ rebounds and 20+ points in consecutive seasons.

G - IMMANUEL QUICKLEY #5 MIN: 32.1 REB: 4.8 AST: 7.0 STL: 2.00 TO: 1.5 BLK: 0.00 PTS: 15.3

- Recorded 15 points, seven assists and three rebounds in 32 minutes against San Antonio.
- Averaging a team-high 7.0 assists through the first four games of the 2025-26 season.
- Missed 39 games last year including 22 contests due to a partial UCL tear in the left elbow.

Russell had 24 points and a team-high six assists to lead three double-figure scorers off the Dallas bench ... The Rockets were without Fred VanVleet for a fifth straight game because of an ankle injury and Steven Adams was out because they played Saturday ... All-Star Alperen Sengun left in the first quarter with back spasms ... Jeff Green and Jock Landale filled in for Sengun and Green had a season-high 14 points while Landale added 11 with a season-best 10 rebounds ... Immanuel Quickley had 20 points for the Raptors, who lost a fourth straight ... Toronto missed Gradey Dick in the second half after he left the game with a neck bruise following a collision with Amen Thompson near the end of the second quarter ... Dick, who averages 15.6 points, didn't score before exiting the game ... The Rockets trailed by four early in the fourth quarter when Jamison Battle was called for a foul on Jeff Green ... The play was reviewed and upgraded to a flagrant 1 foul after officials ruled Battle hit Green in the groin area ... Tempers flared at the final buzzer after Cleveland's Tristan Thompson dunked with four seconds left ... Toronto's Scottie Barnes and Jamal Shaeed confronted Thompson near center court for an exchange of words ... De'Andre Hunter scored 18 points, Sam Merrill had 16 and Darius Garland 15 for the Cavaliers in the final game for both teams before the All-Star break ... Jarrett Allen added 13 points and 10 rebounds and Evan Mobley had 12 points and 15 rebounds ... Hunter's 3-pointer with 5:19 left in the third put the Cavs up 95-56 ... The 39-point edge was Cleveland's biggest of the game ... RJ Barrett scored 27 points for Toronto after missing four games while he was in the concussion protocol ... Barnes had 16 points and 11 rebounds ... The Raptors have lost five of six ... Toronto trailed 68-43 at the intermission, its biggest halftime deficit of the season ... Max Strus scored nine of his 14 points as Cleveland took control of the game with a 23-4 run midway through the first quarter ... The Cavs led 41-17 after one ... Cleveland completed a four-game season sweep of Toronto.

ADDITIONAL TEAM NOTES ...

- Maple Leafs Sports and Entertainment further extended the contract of Raptors General Bobby Webster on Aug. 18.
- The Raptors signed centre Jakob Poeltl to a multi-year contract extension on Jul. 8. Poeltl averaged career highs of 14.5 points, 9.6 rebounds and 29.6 minutes in 57 games (56 starts) last season. He ranked fifth in the NBA with a .627 (363-579) field goal percentage, his eighth consecutive season shooting better than 60 percent from the floor.
- Toronto selected forward Collin Murray-Boyles with the ninth overall pick in the first round of the 2025 NBA Draft. Murray-Boyles, 6-foot-7, 239 pounds, was an All-SEC Second Team selection after averaging 16.8 points, 8.3 rebounds, 2.4 assists and 30.6 minutes in 32 games (all starts) as a sophomore at South Carolina last season.
- The Raptors also selected guard Alijah Martin with the 39th overall pick (second round) in the 2025 NBA Draft. Martin, 6-foot-2, 208 pounds, was drafted following one season at the University of Florida, where he helped the Gators capture the 2025 national championship. He averaged 14.4 points, 4.5 rebounds, 2.2 assists, 1.5 steals and 30.4 minutes in 38 games (36 starts). Martin shot .452 (189-418) from the field, including 35 percent (79-226) from three-point range.
- Last season, the Raptors set franchise records including a single-game record for total rebounds with 73 boards on Mar. 10 vs. Washington. Toronto finished with 3,700 total rebounds on the season which is third-most in franchise history. Toronto finished 10th in the league in total rebounds and in rebounds per game (45.1).
- The Raptors also broke the single-season franchise record in total assists on the last game of the season finishing with 2,340 assists and surpassing the previous franchise record of 2,335 that was set following the 2023-24.

DARKO RAJAKOVIĆ

HEAD COACH

The passion Darko Rajaković (rye-AHK-oe-vich) has for the game of basketball has led him around the world. From Madrid, Spain to Tulsa, Oklahoma, each of these experiences have added to Rajaković's beliefs and philosophies, shaping him into the coach, father, and leader he is today.

Raised in Serbia during a civil war, Rajaković fell in love with basketball during a time of unrest in his homeland. The basketball court became his safe haven, a place where he and his friends could gather and play until the wee hours of the morning.

It was fitting Rajaković started his coaching career in his hometown of Cacak, Serbia. At just 16 years of age, he embarked on a life-long journey of teaching others a game that brought him such joy. This started with the local Borac Cacak Youth Team in 1996. After three seasons with the club, he was named the head coach of the U20 and U18 teams of Red Star Belgrade, leading Red Star to two Serbian Youth championships during his eight-year tenure (1999-2007)

Rajaković then ventured to Spain where he coached Espacio Torrelodones for three successful seasons (2009-12). In his first year with the franchise, he led the team to the championship of the Primera Division de Baloncesto in Madrid

From 2004-11, Rajaković held his first formal job with an NBA team, serving as a European scouting consultant and NBA Summer League assistant coach for the San Antonio Spurs.

His time in Serbia, Spain and San Antonio ultimately led Rajaković to the Oklahoma City Thunder, where he spent seven seasons (2012-19). Rajaković joined the organization in 2012 as the head coach of the Tulsa 66ers – the franchise's then NBA G League affiliate and became the first head coach born outside of North America in league history. Under his guidance, the team went 51-49 (.510) over two seasons and reached the 2013 G League semifinals. In 2014, Rajaković was honoured as one of Oklahoma City's assistant coaches at the NBA All-Star game in New Orleans.

Rajaković transitioned from the G League to the NBA at the start of the 2014-15 campaign, in what would be his first of five seasons as an assistant coach with the Thunder (2014-19). Oklahoma City averaged 49 wins during his time on the coaching staff and earned four playoff appearances - including a trip to the 2016 Western Conference Finals.

Rajaković also spent time in the NBA as an assistant coach with the Phoenix Suns (2019-20) and Memphis Grizzlies (2020-23), before being named the 10th head coach in Toronto Raptors history in June of 2023.

On the international stage, Rajaković was as an assistant coach for Serbia at the 2019 FIBA World Cup in China, helping his country to a fifth place finish at the tournament, which included a win over the United States in the classification round.

Rajaković prides himself on being a life-long learner. He earned a basketball coaching degree from the Belgrade Basketball Academy in 2004 and a degree in sports management from Alfa BK University in Belgrade in 2006.

He and his wife, Gaga, reside in Toronto with their son, Luka.
