TEAM NOTES

- The **Toronto Raptors** return home for a two-game homestand (Nov. 2-4), begining with a matchup against the Memphis Grizzlies Sunday evening and a rematch against the Milwaukee Bucks on Tuesday night at Scotiabank Arena. Afterwards, they will embark on a five-game road trip (Nov. 7-15), where they will face several Eastern Conference rivals.
- The Raptors secured a victory against the Cleveland Cavaliers Friday night after dropping four consecutive games (Oct. 26-29). Friday night's win starts Toronto off with a 1-0 record in 2025 Emirites NBA Cup Group Play. Toronto finishes the month of October with a 2-4 (.333) overall record, including a 2-1 record against Eastern Conference teams. Last season, Toronto had started off the month of October with a 1-4 (.200) overall record.
- Three players finished with 20 points apiece against the Cavaliers, including Jamison Battle, who went perfect from the field (7-7 FG, 6-6 3PT), knocking down three of his six made three-point field goals in two minutes down the stretch to help secure the win. His six three-point field goals are tied for the most shots beyond the arc without a miss by a Raptor since Kyle Lowry went six-of-six from the three-point line against the Philadelphia 76ers in 2016.
- **Brandon Ingram** scored a team-high tying 20 points and grabbed eight rebounds, five assists and two steals in 35 minutes of action for his fourth 20+ point game in a Raptors jersey through the first six games of the season.
- RJ Barrett recorded his fourth 20-point game of the season, 11 of which came in the first
 quarter, his third double-digit scoring quarter of the season. Scottie Barnes added his
 second double-double of the season with 14 points and ten rebounds in 35 minutes of play.

- Became the fourth Raptor 24 years of age or younger to reach 80+ double-doubles.
- Only player in the NBA to finish with 500+ rebounds, 300+ assists, 90+ steals and 60+ blocks in 2024-25.

C - COLLIN MURRAY-BOYLES #12 MIN: 20.6 REB: 2.5 AST: 0.8 STL: 0.75 TO: 0.8 BLK: 025 PTS: 9.5

- Made his first NBA career start Oct. 29 and recorded 13 points, going three-of-four from three.
- Scored in double-digit points & recorded 3+ 3PT field goals in consecutive games for the first time (Oct. 27-29).
- Picked ninth overall by Toronto in the 2025 NBA Draft out of South Carolina.

G - RJ BARRETT #9 MIN: 32.0 REB: 4.2 AST: 3.0 STL: 1.50 TO: 2.2 BLK: 0.33 PTS: 19.3

- Recorded a team-high tying 20 points and added three rebounds, two assists, and two steals Oct 31 at CLE.
- Joins Vince Carter as the only two players to score 2,000 career points as a Raptor in under 100 games.
- Averaged career-high 5.4 assists last year; Has averaged 6+ rebounds and 20+ points in consecutive seasons.

CLEVELAND - Jamison Battle scored 20 points, including a pair of 3-pointers that helped the Toronto Raptors pull away in the final two minutes of a 112-101 victory over the Cleveland Cavaliers in the NBA Cup opener for both teams Friday night ... The Cavaliers, who were without All-Star quard Donovan Mitchell and center Jarrett Allen because of injuries, were within four when Battle made a 3 with 1:07 remaining and hit another half a minute later for a 108-98 lead ... Battle made all seven of his shots, six from long range ... RJ Barrett and Brandon Ingram also scored 20 points apiece for the Raptors, who stopped a four-game losing streak that followed a season-opening win ... Evan Mobley scored 29 points and D'Andre Hunter added 26 for the Cavaliers ... The Raptors trailed by 10 points midway through the third quarter but went back in front in the final minute of the guarter on a bucket by Scottie Barnes, who had 14 points and 10 rebounds ... The Cavaliers were back in front in the middle of the fourth quarter when Battle gave the Raptors the lead for good with a 3-pointer ... Jaylon Tyson scored 18 points for Cleveland.

Antetokounmpo, who scored 37 points in Milwaukee's opener at home, gave the Raptors fits, using his combination of strength and speed to bully the defense in the paint ... He was 11 of 14 from the field, and only attempted two shots outside the paint ... Gary Trent Jr added 20 points for Milwaukee ... Brandon Ingram scored 29 points in his home debut for Toronto ... RJ Barrett added 20 points ... Bucks forward Kyle Kuzma left early in the fourth because of a sprained left ankle ... He didn't return.

ADDITIONAL TEAM NOTES ...

- Maple Leafs Sports and Entertainment further extended the contract of Raptors General Bobby Webster on Aug. 18.
- The Raptors signed centre Jakob Poeltl to a multi-year contract extension on Jul. 8. Poeltl averaged career highs of 14.5 points, 9.6 rebounds and 29.6 minutes in 57 games (56 starts) last season. He ranked fifth in the NBA with a .627 (363-579) field goal percentage, his eighth consecutive season shooting better than 60 percent from the floor.
- Toronto selected forward Collin Murray-Boyles with the ninth overall pick in the first round of the 2025 NBA Draft. Murray-Boyles, 6-foot-7, 239 pounds, was an All-SEC Second Team selection after averaging 16.8 points, 8.3 rebounds, 2.4 assists and 30.6 minutes in 32 games (all starts) as a sophomore at South Carolina last season.
- The Raptors also selected guard Alijah Martin with the 39th overall pick (second round) in the 2025 NBA Draft. Martin, 6-foot-2, 208 pounds, was drafted following one season at the University of Florida, where he helped the Gators capture the 2025 national championship. He averaged 14.4 points, 4.5 rebounds, 2.2 assists, 1.5 steals and 30.4 minutes in 38 games (36 starts). Martin shot .452 (189-418) from the field, including 35 percent (79-226) from three-point range.
- Last season, the Raptors set franchise records including a single-game record for total rebounds with 73 boards on Mar. 10 vs. Washington.
 Toronto finished with 3,700 total rebounds on the season which is third-most in franchise history. Toronto finished 10th in the league in total rebounds and in rebounds per game (45.1).
- The Raptors also broke the single-season franchise record in total assists on the last game of the season finishing with 2,340 assists and surpassing the previous franchise record of 2,335 that was set following the 2023-24.

DARKO RAJAKOVIĆ

HEAD COACH

The passion Darko Rajaković (rye-AHK-oe-vich) has for the game of basketball has led him around the world. From Madrid, Spain to Tulsa, Oklahoma, each of these experiences have added to Rajaković's beliefs and philosophies, shaping him into the coach, father, and leader he is today.

Raised in Serbia during a civil war, Rajaković fell in love with basketball during a time of unrest in his homeland. The basketball court became his safe haven, a place where he and his friends could gather and play until the wee hours of the morning.

It was fitting Rajaković started his coaching career in his hometown of Cacak, Serbia. At just 16 years of age, he embarked on a lifelong journey of teaching others a game that brought him such joy. This started with the local Borac Cacak Youth Team in 1996. After three seasons with the club, he was named the head coach of the U20 and U18 teams of Red Star Belgrade, leading Red Star to two Serbian Youth championships during his eight-year tenure (1999-2007)

Rajaković then ventured to Spain where he coached Espacio Torrelodones for three successful seasons (2009-12). In his first year with the franchise, he led the team to the championship of the Primera Division de Baloncesto in Madrid

From 2004-11, Rajaković held his first formal job with an NBA team, serving as a European scouting consultant and NBA Summer League assistant coach for the San Antonio Spurs.

His time in Serbia, Spain and San Antonio ultimately led Rajaković to the Oklahoma City Thunder, where he spent seven seasons (2012-19). Rajaković joined the organization in 2012 as the head coach of the Tulsa 66ers – the franchise's then NBA G League affiliate and became the first head coach born outside of North America in league history. Under his guidance, the team went 51-49 (.510) over two seasons and reached the 2013 G League semifinals. In 2014, Rajaković was honoured as one of Oklahoma City's assistant coaches at the NBA All-Star game in New Orleans.

Rajaković transitioned from the G League to the NBA at the start of the 2014-15 campaign, in what would be his first of five seasons as an assistant coach with the Thunder (2014-19). Oklahoma City averaged 49 wins during his time on the coaching staff and earned four playoff appearances - including a trip to the 2016 Western Conference Finals.

Rajaković also spent time in the NBA as an assistant coach with the Phoenix Suns (2019-20) and Memphis Grizzlies (2020-23), before being named the 10th head coach in Toronto Raptors history in June of 2023.

On the international stage, Rajaković was as an assistant coach for Serbia at the 2019 FIBA World Cup in China, helping his country to a fifth place finish at the tournament, which included a win over the United States in the classification round.

Rajaković prides himself on being a life-long learner. He earned a basketball coaching degree from the Belgrade Basketball Academy in 2004 and a degree in sports management from Alfa BK University in Belgrade in 2006.

He and his wife, Gaga, reside in Toronto with their son, Luka.
