TEAM NOTES

- The Toronto Raptors are set to begin their season-high tying five-game road trip (Nov. 7-15) with another visit to State Farm Arena to take on the Atlanta Hawks on Friday night. The Raptors defeated the Hawks 138-118 during their season opener on Oct. 22. Friday's contest marks the second NBA Cup game for the Raptors who are 1-0 in the tournament.
- · Toronto will look to extend their winning streak to a season-high four straight games. The team is coming off a 2-0 homestand which most recently included defeating the Milwaukee Bucks 128-100 on Tuesday, marking the largest margin of victory this season. The previous high was by 20 points against the Atlanta Hawks.
- The Raptors improved to 4-0 when keeping opponents to under 44% shooting and when outrebounding their opponents. Toronto posted a +20 (54-to-34) rebound differential against Atlanta on Oct. 22, the team's largest differential over the four wins.
- RJ Barrett and Scottie Barnes have now scored 20+ points six and four times respectively which ranks first and third on the team. Brandon Ingram is second with five such games. Toronto and Denver are the only teams to have three players average 20+ points.
- · In addition to his 23 points, Barnes finished with six assists, four steals and two blocks on Tueday marking his first career 20/6/4/2 statline. He joins Nikola Jokić and Luka Dončić as the only three players to post that line this season and is the sixth-ever Raptor to do so.
- · Barnes has recorded a combined 12 stocks (steal and block) in his last two games (Nov. 2-4). He leads the team in both total steals (13) and total blocks (12) this season.

- Shooting 48.6% (18-for-37) from beyond the arc; Has made multiple 3PT field goals in six games this season.

TORONTO - RJ Barrett and Scottie Barnes each scored 23 points to rally the Toronto Raptors to a 128-100 win against the Milwaukee Bucks on Tuesday ... Six Toronto players hit double figures as the victory extended the Raptors' (4-4) win streak to a season-high three games, and avenged a six-point loss to the Bucks (5-3) in Toronto's home opener Oct. 24 at Scotiabank Arena ... Sandro Mamukelashvili came off the bench to score 15 and contribute seven rebounds ... Point guard Immanuel Quickley chipped in 15, followed by Gradey Dick's 14 and 13 from Brandon Ingram ... After scoring 31 points with 20 rebounds in the Raptors' home opener, Giannis Antetokounmpo was good for 22 points and eight rebounds to lead the Bucks (5-3) in just 24 minutes ... The two-time NBA MVP has been troubled with a left knee ailment and did not play the final quarter ... Barnes left late in the first half after suffering a left thumb strain, but returned in the third quarter ... Jakob Poeltl scored eight points after missing three games with a lower back injury ... The Raptors led for good after a Barrett field goal with 4:32 remaining in the opening guarter gave the home team a two-point lead.

ATLANTA — RJ Barrett scored 25 points and Brandon Ingram added 16 points and nine rebounds in his Toronto debut as the Raptors ran away from the Atlanta Hawks for a 138-118 victory Wednesday night in the season opener for both teams ... Scottie Barnes had 22 points and nine assists and Gradey Dick scored 21 off the bench for the Raptors, who set a franchise record for points on opening night and surpassed last season's high ... Toronto shot 57% from the field, including 69% on 2-pointers ... Ingram shot 7 of 16 from the floor Wednesday and had three assists and two steals ... Hawks forward Jalen Johnson, who missed the final 38 games last season with a shoulder injury, had 22 points, eight assists and seven rebounds ... Trae Young finished with 22 points, but he was 1 for 7 from 3-point range ... Kristaps Porzingas, acquired in a trade with Boston during the offseason, had 20 points, seven rebounds and two blocks in his Hawks debut.

Spain's Santi Aldama came off the bench with 15 points ... Toronto enjoyed a 53-47 advantage at the half and increased the lead to 84-71 after three quarters, but the visitors closed the gap to six points in the fourth ... Four of the five Raptor starters notched double figures ... Besides Barrett and Ingram's offence, Scottie Barnes scored 19 points with 12 rebounds, eight assists and five blocks ... Forward Collin Murray-Boyles chipped in 15.

Toronto led 63-49 at halftime, with Barrett leading the way with 19 points ... The Raptors outscored the 76ers by four points over the final two quarters, while Jamison Battle had a teamhigh 13 second-half points.

ADDITIONAL TEAM NOTES ...

- Maple Leafs Sports and Entertainment further extended the contract of Raptors General Bobby Webster on Aug. 18.
- The Raptors signed centre Jakob Poeltl to a multi-year contract extension on Jul. 8. Poeltl averaged career highs of 14.5 points, 9.6 rebounds and 29.6 minutes in 57 games (56 starts) last season. He ranked fifth in the NBA with a .627 (363-579) field goal percentage, his eighth consecutive season shooting better than 60 percent from the floor.
- Toronto selected forward Collin Murray-Boyles with the ninth overall pick in the first round of the 2025 NBA Draft. Murray-Boyles, 6-foot-7, 239 pounds, was an All-SEC Second Team selection after averaging 16.8 points, 8.3 rebounds, 2.4 assists and 30.6 minutes in 32 games (all starts) as a sophomore at South Carolina last season.
- The Raptors also selected guard Alijah Martin with the 39th overall pick (second round) in the 2025 NBA Draft. Martin, 6-foot-2, 208 pounds, was drafted following one season at the University of Florida, where he helped the Gators capture the 2025 national championship. He averaged 14.4 points, 4.5 rebounds, 2.2 assists, 1.5 steals and 30.4 minutes in 38 games (36 starts). Martin shot .452 (189-418) from the field, including 35 percent (79-226) from three-point range.
- Last season, the Raptors set franchise records including a single-game record for total rebounds with 73 boards on Mar. 10 vs. Washington.
 Toronto finished with 3,700 total rebounds on the season which is third-most in franchise history. Toronto finished 10th in the league in total rebounds and in rebounds per game (45.1).
- The Raptors also broke the single-season franchise record in total assists on the last game of the season finishing with 2,340 assists and surpassing the previous franchise record of 2,335 that was set following the 2023-24.

DARKO RAJAKOVIĆ

HEAD COACH

The passion Darko Rajaković (rye-AHK-oe-vich) has for the game of basketball has led him around the world. From Madrid, Spain to Tulsa, Oklahoma, each of these experiences have added to Rajaković's beliefs and philosophies, shaping him into the coach, father, and leader he is today.

Raised in Serbia during a civil war, Rajaković fell in love with basketball during a time of unrest in his homeland. The basketball court became his safe haven, a place where he and his friends could gather and play until the wee hours of the morning.

It was fitting Rajaković started his coaching career in his hometown of Cacak, Serbia. At just 16 years of age, he embarked on a lifelong journey of teaching others a game that brought him such joy. This started with the local Borac Cacak Youth Team in 1996. After three seasons with the club, he was named the head coach of the U20 and U18 teams of Red Star Belgrade, leading Red Star to two Serbian Youth championships during his eight-year tenure (1999-2007)

Rajaković then ventured to Spain where he coached Espacio Torrelodones for three successful seasons (2009-12). In his first year with the franchise, he led the team to the championship of the Primera Division de Baloncesto in Madrid

From 2004-11, Rajaković held his first formal job with an NBA team, serving as a European scouting consultant and NBA Summer League assistant coach for the San Antonio Spurs.

His time in Serbia, Spain and San Antonio ultimately led Rajaković to the Oklahoma City Thunder, where he spent seven seasons (2012-19). Rajaković joined the organization in 2012 as the head coach of the Tulsa 66ers – the franchise's then NBA G League affiliate and became the first head coach born outside of North America in league history. Under his guidance, the team went 51-49 (.510) over two seasons and reached the 2013 G League semifinals. In 2014, Rajaković was honoured as one of Oklahoma City's assistant coaches at the NBA All-Star game in New Orleans.

Rajaković transitioned from the G League to the NBA at the start of the 2014-15 campaign, in what would be his first of five seasons as an assistant coach with the Thunder (2014-19). Oklahoma City averaged 49 wins during his time on the coaching staff and earned four playoff appearances - including a trip to the 2016 Western Conference Finals.

Rajaković also spent time in the NBA as an assistant coach with the Phoenix Suns (2019-20) and Memphis Grizzlies (2020-23), before being named the 10th head coach in Toronto Raptors history in June of 2023.

On the international stage, Rajaković was as an assistant coach for Serbia at the 2019 FIBA World Cup in China, helping his country to a fifth place finish at the tournament, which included a win over the United States in the classification round.

Rajaković prides himself on being a life-long learner. He earned a basketball coaching degree from the Belgrade Basketball Academy in 2004 and a degree in sports management from Alfa BK University in Belgrade in 2006.

He and his wife, Gaga, reside in Toronto with their son, Luka.
