TEAM NOTES

- The **Toronto Raptors** look to remain undefeated in the month of November as they travel to Philadelphia for their second game of a back-to-back set on the road. Saturday night's matchup marks the second of a season-high tying five-game road trip (Nov. 7-15). Toronto holds a 4-1 record against Eastern Conference teams to start the season, including a 3-0 record against their Eastern Conference rivals on the road. Last season, the Raptors swept the season series against the 76ers 4-0 and look to continue that winning streak tonight.
- Toronto** has won a season-high four consecutive games and are the only team in their group to begin NBA Cup play 2-0 following a 13-point comeback win against the Atlanta Hawks Friday night. They will look to clinch the top spot following their remaining two group play games at the end of the month on Nov. 21 vs. Washington and Nov. 26 vs. Indiana.
- Brandon Ingram** secured his sixth game with 20+ points as a Raptor and led the team in scoring for the third time, adding six rebounds and four assists in 34 minutes of action.
- RJ Barrett** scored 10 of his 19 points in the fourth quarter to help secure the 109-97 comeback victory for the Raptors and extend the team's winning streak. Barrett is one of three Raptors to average 20+ points this season. Toronto and Denver remain the only two teams in the NBA to have three players averaging 20-or-more points per game this season.
- Scottie Barnes** and **Jakob Poeltl** each recorded a double-double on Friday night, combining for 26 points and 20 rebounds. Poeltl's double-double marked his first of the season.
- Immanuel Quickley** was just one point shy of his season-high, scoring 18 points (5-11 FG, 3-7 3PT), dishing out a team-high six assists and grabbing five rebounds in 34 minutes.

- Averaging 20.2 points, 5.9 rebounds, and 35.1 minutes through 11 career matchups against Philadelphia.

F - SCOTTIE BARNES #4 MIN: 32.6 REB: 7.2 AST: 5.0 STL: 1.56 TO: 1.9 BLK: 1.56 PTS: 20.1

- Has recorded a combined 15 steals (steal and block) in his last three games (Nov. 2-7); leads Raptors this year.
- Joins Giannis Antetokounmpo as one of two players in the NBA to average 20/6/5 and one block this season.
- Has recorded a team-high four double-doubles through his first nine games of the 2025-26 regular season.

C - JAKOB POELTL #19 MIN: 22.9 REB: 6.7 AST: 1.7 STL: 0.33 TO: 1.7 BLK: 0.50 PTS: 7.7

- Surpassed Amir Johnson (55) for ninth overall with double-doubles as a Raptor in franchise history (56).
- Returned to action on Nov. 4 after missing three games (Oct. 29 - Nov. 2) due to low back tightness.
- Shooting .613 from the field in 23 career games against the 76ers; Ranked fifth in NBA in FG% last season.

G - RJ BARRETT #9 MIN: 32.4 REB: 4.9 AST: 3.6 STL: 1.11 TO: 1.9 BLK: 0.44 PTS: 20.6

- Leads Raptors starters with a .543 field goal percentage (69 - 127) to start the season.
- Has scored double-digits in a single quarter for a team-best four times this season.
- Scored 20-or-more points in three of his previous four games, shooting above .500 FG% in each of those three.

G - IMMANUEL QUICKLEY #5 MIN: 30.9 REB: 4.2 AST: 6.3 STL: 1.56 TO: 1.8 BLK: 0.00 PTS: 13.6

- Averaging a team and career-high 6.3 assists through first nine games of the 2025-26 regular season.
- Surpassed 500 career assists as a Raptor; becoming fifth to do so in under 80 games in franchise history.
- Recorded 23 points and dished out five assists in most recent matchup against Philadelphia (Feb. 11).

Immanuel Quickley hit a 3-pointer to make it 85-81 and the Raptors pulled away in the opener of a five-game trip ... RJ Barrett added 19 points for Toronto ... Quickley had 18, and Barnes finished with 14 points and 10 rebounds ... Jalen Johnson scored 21 points for Atlanta, with the Hawks missing All-Star guard Trae Young because of a sprained right MCL ... Nickeil Alexander-Walker added 20 points, and Kristaps Porzingis had 17 ... Toronto opened the season with a victory in Atlanta, then lost four straight before the current run.

TORONTO — RJ Barrett and Scottie Barnes each scored 23 points to rally the Toronto Raptors to a 128-100 win against the Milwaukee Bucks on Tuesday ... Six Toronto players hit double figures as the victory extended the Raptors' (4-4) win streak to a season-high three games, and avenged a six-point loss to the Bucks (5-3) in Toronto's home opener Oct. 24 at Scotiabank Arena ... Sandro Mamukelashvili came off the bench to score 15 and contribute seven rebounds ... Point guard Immanuel Quickley chipped in 15, followed by Grady Dick's 14 and 13 from Brandon Ingram ... After scoring 31 points with 20 rebounds in the Raptors' home opener, Giannis Antetokounmpo was good for 22 points and eight rebounds to lead the Bucks (5-3) in just 24 minutes ... The two-time NBA MVP has been troubled with a left knee ailment and did not play the final quarter ... Barnes left late in the first half after suffering a left thumb strain, but returned in the third quarter ... Jakob Poeltl scored eight points after missing three games with a lower back injury ... The Raptors led for good after a Barrett field goal with 4:32 remaining in the opening quarter gave the home team a two-point lead.

ADDITIONAL TEAM NOTES ...

- Maple Leafs Sports and Entertainment further extended the contract of Raptors General Bobby Webster on Aug. 18.
- The Raptors signed centre Jakob Poeltl to a multi-year contract extension on Jul. 8. Poeltl averaged career highs of 14.5 points, 9.6 rebounds and 29.6 minutes in 57 games (56 starts) last season. He ranked fifth in the NBA with a .627 (363-579) field goal percentage, his eighth consecutive season shooting better than 60 percent from the floor.
- Toronto selected forward Collin Murray-Boyles with the ninth overall pick in the first round of the 2025 NBA Draft. Murray-Boyles, 6-foot-7, 239 pounds, was an All-SEC Second Team selection after averaging 16.8 points, 8.3 rebounds, 2.4 assists and 30.6 minutes in 32 games (all starts) as a sophomore at South Carolina last season.
- The Raptors also selected guard Alijah Martin with the 39th overall pick (second round) in the 2025 NBA Draft. Martin, 6-foot-2, 208 pounds, was drafted following one season at the University of Florida, where he helped the Gators capture the 2025 national championship. He averaged 14.4 points, 4.5 rebounds, 2.2 assists, 1.5 steals and 30.4 minutes in 38 games (36 starts). Martin shot .452 (189-418) from the field, including 35 percent (79-226) from three-point range.
- Last season, the Raptors set franchise records including a single-game record for total rebounds with 73 boards on Mar. 10 vs. Washington. Toronto finished with 3,700 total rebounds on the season which is third-most in franchise history. Toronto finished 10th in the league in total rebounds and in rebounds per game (45.1).
- The Raptors also broke the single-season franchise record in total assists on the last game of the season finishing with 2,340 assists and surpassing the previous franchise record of 2,335 that was set following the 2023-24.

DARKO RAJAKOVIĆ

HEAD COACH

The passion Darko Rajaković (rye-AHK-oe-vich) has for the game of basketball has led him around the world. From Madrid, Spain to Tulsa, Oklahoma, each of these experiences have added to Rajaković's beliefs and philosophies, shaping him into the coach, father, and leader he is today.

Raised in Serbia during a civil war, Rajaković fell in love with basketball during a time of unrest in his homeland. The basketball court became his safe haven, a place where he and his friends could gather and play until the wee hours of the morning.

It was fitting Rajaković started his coaching career in his hometown of Cacak, Serbia. At just 16 years of age, he embarked on a life-long journey of teaching others a game that brought him such joy. This started with the local Borac Cacak Youth Team in 1996. After three seasons with the club, he was named the head coach of the U20 and U18 teams of Red Star Belgrade, leading Red Star to two Serbian Youth championships during his eight-year tenure (1999-2007)

Rajaković then ventured to Spain where he coached Espacio Torrelodones for three successful seasons (2009-12). In his first year with the franchise, he led the team to the championship of the Primera Division de Baloncesto in Madrid

From 2004-11, Rajaković held his first formal job with an NBA team, serving as a European scouting consultant and NBA Summer League assistant coach for the San Antonio Spurs.

His time in Serbia, Spain and San Antonio ultimately led Rajaković to the Oklahoma City Thunder, where he spent seven seasons (2012-19). Rajaković joined the organization in 2012 as the head coach of the Tulsa 66ers – the franchise's then NBA G League affiliate and became the first head coach born outside of North America in league history. Under his guidance, the team went 51-49 (.510) over two seasons and reached the 2013 G League semifinals. In 2014, Rajaković was honoured as one of Oklahoma City's assistant coaches at the NBA All-Star game in New Orleans.

Rajaković transitioned from the G League to the NBA at the start of the 2014-15 campaign, in what would be his first of five seasons as an assistant coach with the Thunder (2014-19). Oklahoma City averaged 49 wins during his time on the coaching staff and earned four playoff appearances - including a trip to the 2016 Western Conference Finals.

Rajaković also spent time in the NBA as an assistant coach with the Phoenix Suns (2019-20) and Memphis Grizzlies (2020-23), before being named the 10th head coach in Toronto Raptors history in June of 2023.

On the international stage, Rajaković was as an assistant coach for Serbia at the 2019 FIBA World Cup in China, helping his country to a fifth place finish at the tournament, which included a win over the United States in the classification round.

Rajaković prides himself on being a life-long learner. He earned a basketball coaching degree from the Belgrade Basketball Academy in 2004 and a degree in sports management from Alfa BK University in Belgrade in 2006.

He and his wife, Gaga, reside in Toronto with their son, Luka.
