TEAM NOTES

- The **Toronto Raptors** will face the Cleveland Cavaliers in the third matchup of a four-game homestand (Nov. 21-26) and the second night of their third back-to-back set of the season. Toronto defeated the Brooklyn Nets Sunday night to extend their win streak to a season-high seven straight games (Nov. 11-23).
- The Raptors have now won 11 of their last 12 contests for the first time since February 2020, when they went on a franchise-record 15 game win streak. It is the team's first seven-game win streak since they won eight straight between Jan. 29 – Feb. 10, 2022.
- Tonight's contest against Cleveland marks the final marchup of the three-game season series. Toronto lead the 2025-26 campaign with a 2-0 record against Cleveland and look to sweep the season series for the first time since the 2019-20 NBA season.
- Scottie Barnes** led Raptors scorers with 17 points, seven rebounds, four assists, four blocks, and two steals in 34 minutes of action. Barnes has recorded multiple blocks in eight games this season and for the 74th time in his career; which ranks 12th in franchise history.
- Brandon Ingram** added 14 points (6-18 FG, 2-5 3PT), six rebounds, four assists, and two steals in 36 minutes of play. Ingram has achieved 10,000 career points and is the fifth player from the 2016 NBA Draft class to achieve this milestone. He is also the quickest out of this group to do so in 512 career games.
- Ja'Kobe Walter** led Raptors reserves for the second time this season with a season-high 16 points, including a season-high four three-point goals and **Jamal Sheard** dished out a team and game-high nine assists; he leads Raptors reserves with 95 total assists.

- Joins Scottie Barnes as the only team with a duo that have 300+ pts, 95+ reb, 65+ ast while shooting 48.5%+.
- Surpassed 10,000 career points milestone; fastest player to achieve this milestone from 2016 NBA Draft class.

F - SCOTTIE BARNES #4 MIN: 32.6 REB: 7.6 AST: 5.0 STL: 1.53 TO: 2.0 BLK: 1.76 PTS: 19.3

- Led Raptors players with 17 points, seven rebounds, four assists, four blocks, and two steals Sunday night.
- Leads team with 30 total blocks this season; ranks sixth in the NBA in blocks per game this season (1.76).
- Shooting career highs of 50.8% (130 - 256) from the field including 41.4% (24-58) from three-point range.

C - JAKOB POELTL #19 MIN: 25.5 REB: 7.7 AST: 1.8 STL: 0.58 TO: 1.2 BLK: 0.58 PTS: 11.3

- Missed Sunday night's matchup against Brooklyn due to lower back injury management.
- Averaging a team-high .737 (56 - 76) from the field to start the season, ranked fifth in the NBA last season.
- Has shot above .800 in four of his previous five games; has only shot below .600 in one game this season.

G - JA'KOB WALTER #14 MIN: 12.8 REB: 1.4 AST: 0.6 STL: 1.00 TO: 0.8 BLK: 0.07 PTS: 4.4

- Led Raptors reserves with season-high 16 points (6-7 FG, 4-5 3PT) against the Brooklyn Nets on Sunday.
- Has shot above .500 from the field in three consecutive games; tied for the longest streak of his career.
- Exercised the third-year team option on his rookie scale contract on Oct. 21.

G - IMMANUEL QUICKLEY #5 MIN: 31.6 REB: 4.7 AST: 6.0 STL: 1.35 TO: 1.6 BLK: 0.06 PTS: 15.8

- Recorded 13 points (4-11 FG, 3-6 3PT), seven rebounds, four assists, and a steal Sunday night.
- Joins Davion Mitchell as one of just two players in the NBA with 100+ assists and less than 30 turnovers.
- Has recorded multiple three-point field goals in 11 consecutive games; his second-longest career streak.

Michael Porter Jr. had 25 and Noah Clowney added 22 ... Nic Claxton had 10 points and 11 rebounds ... Toronto's Sandro Mamukelashvili scored 12 points in his first start of the season, Grady Dick also scored 12 points and Jamal Shead had 11 ... Ingram reached 10,000 career points with a 3 in the second, his only basket of the period. Toronto led 65-58 at the intermission ... Mamukelashvili started for center Jakob Poeltl, who sat because of a sore lower back. Rookie Collin Murray-Boyles returned after missing two games because of a sore right knee.

CLEVELAND — Scottie Barnes had 28 points in a near triple-double, Immanuel Quickley added 25 points and the Toronto Raptors beat the Cleveland Cavaliers 126-113 on Thursday night ... Barnes finished with 10 rebounds, eight assists and five blocked shots ... The Raptors shot 56 per cent from the floor and made 12 three-pointers to win for the sixth time in seven games ... Quickley shot five of seven from three-point range and had six assists ... Jakob Poeltl added 20 points on seven-of-10 shooting and had seven rebounds ... Donovan Mitchell had 31 points after getting a night off Wednesday in Miami ... Mitchell had six rebounds, six assists, two steals and hit 15 of 17 free throws after getting a rest day against the Heat ... Toronto led 67-54 at half-time, but Cleveland whittled the lead down to 90-85 by the end of the third quarter ... The Cavaliers kept the Raptors in reach until Quickley hit a pair of three-pointers sandwiched around RJ Barrett's floater to push the lead to 118-105.

TORONTO — Brandon Ingram had 24 points, eight rebounds and six assists as the Toronto Raptors routed the Washington Wizards 140-110 on Friday to advance in the Emirates NBA Cup ... The Raptors win over Washington coupled with the Indiana Pacers' 120-109 loss to the Cleveland Cavaliers earlier in the night clinched Toronto's spot in the knockout rounds of the in-season tournament ... It's the first time the Raptors have advanced beyond the NBA Cup's group stage ... They are the first team to clinch a spot this season ... RJ Barrett of Mississauga, Ont., scored 24 points and pulled down eight rebounds as Toronto (11-5) won its sixth straight game ... Scottie Barnes added 23 points, including 14 in the third quarter. Reserve centre Sandro Mamukelashvili had 23 points and pulled down seven boards for the Raptors ... CJ McCollum's 20-point performance led the Wizards (1-14), who dropped their 13th consecutive decision ... Tre Johnson came off the bench with 14 points and Swiss-Canadian forward Kyshawn George had five points, four assists and three rebounds ... Both teams rested their starters with over four minutes left to play.

INDIANA — RJ Barrett and Jakob Poeltl each scored 22 points and the Toronto Raptors wrapped up a successful five-game road trip with a 129-111 victory over the Indiana Pacers on Saturday night ... Barrett made 9 of 17 shots with three 3-pointers for the Raptors, who won four games on the trip and improved to 6-3 on the road, 8-5 overall ... Poeltl made eight of nine shots and had nine rebounds, but was just 6 of 14 at the line ... Toronto had seven double-digit scorers. Brandon Ingram added 19 ... Scottie Barnes had 14 points, 11 rebounds and six assists ... The Raptors built a nine-point halftime lead and gradually pulled away, the margin reaching 26 ... Pascal Siakam scored 30 points with five 3-pointers for the Pacers, who had just two regular starters in the lineup due to injuries ... The other healthy regular, point guard Andrew Nembhard, had 22 points and five assists ... The NBA finalists from a year ago are 1-12 and missing seven players ... The latest loss is guard Aaron Nesmith, who will miss at least one month with a left knee injury, coach Rick Carlisle said before the game.

ADDITIONAL TEAM NOTES ...

- Set a franchise record in points scored in a third quarter with 48 points on Nov. 21 vs. Washington.
- Set a franchise record by shooting 50%+ from the field in five consecutive games (Nov. 13-21).
- Maple Leafs Sports and Entertainment further extended the contract of Raptors General Bobby Webster on Aug. 18.
- The Raptors signed centre Jakob Poeltl to a multi-year contract extension on Jul. 8. Poeltl averaged career highs of 14.5 points, 9.6 rebounds and 29.6 minutes in 57 games (56 starts) last season. He ranked fifth in the NBA with a .627 (363-579) field goal percentage, his eighth consecutive season shooting better than 60 percent from the floor.
- Toronto selected forward Collin Murray-Boyles with the ninth overall pick in the first round of the 2025 NBA Draft. Murray-Boyles, 6-foot-7, 239 pounds, was an All-SEC Second Team selection after averaging 16.8 points, 8.3 rebounds, 2.4 assists and 30.6 minutes in 32 games (all starts) as a sophomore at South Carolina last season.
- The Raptors also selected guard Alijah Martin with the 39th overall pick (second round) in the 2025 NBA Draft. Martin, 6-foot-2, 208 pounds, was drafted following one season at the University of Florida, where he helped the Gators capture the 2025 national championship. He averaged 14.4 points, 4.5 rebounds, 2.2 assists, 1.5 steals and 30.4 minutes in 38 games (36 starts). Martin shot .452 (189-418) from the field, including 35 percent (79-226) from three-point range.

DARKO RAJAKOVIĆ

HEAD COACH

The passion Darko Rajaković (rye-AHK-oe-vich) has for the game of basketball has led him around the world. From Madrid, Spain to Tulsa, Oklahoma, each of these experiences have added to Rajaković's beliefs and philosophies, shaping him into the coach, father, and leader he is today.

Raised in Serbia during a civil war, Rajaković fell in love with basketball during a time of unrest in his homeland. The basketball court became his safe haven, a place where he and his friends could gather and play until the wee hours of the morning.

It was fitting Rajaković started his coaching career in his hometown of Cacak, Serbia. At just 16 years of age, he embarked on a life-long journey of teaching others a game that brought him such joy. This started with the local Borac Cacak Youth Team in 1996. After three seasons with the club, he was named the head coach of the U20 and U18 teams of Red Star Belgrade, leading Red Star to two Serbian Youth championships during his eight-year tenure (1999-2007)

Rajaković then ventured to Spain where he coached Espacio Torrelodones for three successful seasons (2009-12). In his first year with the franchise, he led the team to the championship of the Primera Division de Baloncesto in Madrid

From 2004-11, Rajaković held his first formal job with an NBA team, serving as a European scouting consultant and NBA Summer League assistant coach for the San Antonio Spurs.

His time in Serbia, Spain and San Antonio ultimately led Rajaković to the Oklahoma City Thunder, where he spent seven seasons (2012-19). Rajaković joined the organization in 2012 as the head coach of the Tulsa 66ers – the franchise's then NBA G League affiliate and became the first head coach born outside of North America in league history. Under his guidance, the team went 51-49 (.510) over two seasons and reached the 2013 G League semifinals. In 2014, Rajaković was honoured as one of Oklahoma City's assistant coaches at the NBA All-Star game in New Orleans.

Rajaković transitioned from the G League to the NBA at the start of the 2014-15 campaign, in what would be his first of five seasons as an assistant coach with the Thunder (2014-19). Oklahoma City averaged 49 wins during his time on the coaching staff and earned four playoff appearances - including a trip to the 2016 Western Conference Finals.

Rajaković also spent time in the NBA as an assistant coach with the Phoenix Suns (2019-20) and Memphis Grizzlies (2020-23), before being named the 10th head coach in Toronto Raptors history in June of 2023.

On the international stage, Rajaković was as an assistant coach for Serbia at the 2019 FIBA World Cup in China, helping his country to a fifth place finish at the tournament, which included a win over the United States in the classification round.

Rajaković prides himself on being a life-long learner. He earned a basketball coaching degree from the Belgrade Basketball Academy in 2004 and a degree in sports management from Alfa BK University in Belgrade in 2006.

He and his wife, Gaga, reside in Toronto with their son, Luka.
