### TEAM NOTES

- The **Toronto Raptors** welcome the Indiana Pacers for the second game of a four-game season series and for a chance to extend their home winning streak against the Pacers to three straight games. Wednesday's contest is the fourth and final round robin game of the Emirates NBA Cup 2025. The Raptors clinched East Group A and advanced to the quarter-finals after winning out against Cleveland, Atlanta and Washington to remain undefeated.
- The Raptors have tied the third-longest winning streak in the NBA this season with eight consecutive victories (Nov. 11-24) -- which included a 129-111 win against Indiana on Nov. 15 -- and ties the fifth-longest streak in franchise history. Toronto, who is one of five teams with 13+ wins this year, have won 12 of their last 13 contests (Oct. 31 - Nov. 24).
- Toronto shot 48.9% (44-90) from the field on Monday, improving to 11-3 when shooting 48%+ this season. The Raptors currently rank third in the league in field goal percentage (.502). Toronto is also undefeated (13-0) when keeping opponents to under 50% shooting.
- Five players recorded five-or-more rebounds on Monday including Scottie Barnes (11) and Jakob Poeltl who grabbed a season-high 13 boards. The Raptors finished with 51 rebounds, the second-highest total this season, and improve to 4-0 when recording 50-or-more rebounds and are a perfect 9-0 when outrebounding their opponents.
- Toronto has won by a double digit margin in 11 of 13 games this season. Their 2,167 points scored are third-most among teams who have played 18 games-or-less. The Raptors also lead the league in points scored (581) in third quarters among teams who have played 18 games and are 13-0 when leading after three frames.

**F - BRANDON INGRAM #3** MIN: 33.5 REB: 5.8 AST: 3.9 STL: 1.06 TO: 2.9 BLK: 0.67 PTS: 21.6

- Scored season-high 37 points on Monday and added seven rebounds, two assists and one steal in 37 minutes.
- 12 games of 20+ points are the most through first 18 games by a Raptor since Pascal Siakam (2019-20).
- Leads team in points scored (389), second in rebounds (105) and blocks (12) and third in steals (19).

**F - SCOTTIE BARNES #4** MIN: 33.0 REB: 7.8 AST: 5.1 STL: 1.50 TO: 2.1 BLK: 1.67 PTS: 19.2

- Finished with 18 points, 11 rebounds, six assists and one steal against the Cleveland Cavaliers.
- 87th career double-double passes Damon Stoudamire for seventh-most in Raptors franchise history.
- Only player in the league this season with 25+ blocks and 25+ steals.

**C - JAKOB POELTL #19** MIN: 25.6 REB: 8.1 AST: 1.8 STL: 0.69 TO: 1.2 BLK: 0.54 PTS: 10.9

- Returned to action and finished with a season-high 13 rebounds, seven points, and two steals on Monday.
- Shooting career-high .738 (59 - 80) to start the season, Ranked first in the NBA among players with 80+ FGA.
- Scored season-high 22 points (8-9 FG) and added nine rebounds on Nov. 15 at Indiana.

**G - JA'KOB WALTER #14** MIN: 13.6 REB: 1.5 AST: 0.7 STL: 1.07 TO: 0.7 BLK: 0.07 PTS: 4.5

- Made first start of the season and recorded five points, three rebounds, two steals and one assists vs. Cavs.
- Has recorded multiple steals in three of last four games (Nov. 19-24) leading team with nine in that span.
- Averaged 12.4 points, 3.8 rebounds, 2.2 assists and shot 41.5% from the field in 18 starts last season.

**G - IMMANUEL QUICKLEY #5** MIN: 31.7 REB: 4.8 AST: 6.1 STL: 1.34 TO: 1.6 BLK: 0.06 PTS: 15.5

- Tallied 11 points, seven assists, six rebounds and one steal in 33 minutes against Cleveland.
- Shooting career-best 46.1% from the field this season; Best shooting percentage since 22-23 (.448).
- Joins Jamal Shaeed as only backcourt duo with 100+ assists and less than 30 turnovers in the NBA.

**TORONTO** — Brandon Ingram scored 15 of his season-high 37 points in the third quarter, Scottie Barnes had 18 points and 11 rebounds, and the Toronto Raptors beat the Cleveland Cavaliers 110-99 on Monday night for their eighth straight win ... Sandro Mamukelashvili scored 12 points and Immanuel Quickley had 11 for Toronto, which has won 12 of 13 ... Two of the Raptors' victories in their streak have come against the Cavaliers ... Toronto swept the season series for the first time since the 2019-20 season ... Cleveland's Donovan Mitchell had 17 points but shot 6 of 20, going 3 of 12 from 3-point range ... Jaylon Tyson scored 15 points, and Evan Mobley and Nae'Qwan each had 14 for Cleveland ... Lonzo Ball shot 3 for 15, missing 10 of 12 attempts from long range to finish with eight points ... Toronto closed the first half with a 13-2 run to lead 57-54 at the break ... The Raptors played without RJ Barrett, who has a sprained right knee ... Cleveland's Darius Garland (sore left big toe) and De'Andre Hunter (rest) sat on the second night of a back-to-back ... Poeltl had 13 rebounds. Jarrett Allen, who missed his third straight game because of a sprained finger on his right hand, was among seven Cavs players out with injuries.

**INDIANA** — RJ Barrett and Jakob Poeltl each scored 22 points and the Toronto Raptors wrapped up a successful five-game road trip with a 129-111 victory over the Indiana Pacers on Saturday night ... Barrett made 9 of 17 shots with three 3-pointers for the Raptors, who won four games on the trip and improved to 6-3 on the road, 8-5 overall ... Poeltl made eight of nine shots and had nine rebounds, but was just 6 of 14 at the line ... Toronto had seven double-digit scorers. Brandon Ingram added 19 ... Scottie Barnes had 14 points, 11 rebounds and six assists ... The Raptors built a nine-point halftime lead and gradually pulled away, the margin reaching 26 ... Pascal Siakam scored 30 points with five 3-pointers for the Pacers, who had just two regular starters in the lineup due to injuries ... The other healthy regular, point guard Andrew Nembhard, had 22 points and five assists ... The NBA finalists from a year ago are 1-12 and missing seven players ... The latest loss is guard Aaron Nesmith, who will miss at least one month with a left knee injury, coach Rick Carlisle said before the game.

Brandon Ingram had 14 points and Immanuel Quickley scored eight of his 13 in the fourth quarter to help Toronto extend its winning streak to seven ... Toronto's RJ Barrett scored 16 points before leaving midway through the third because of a sprained right knee ... Brooklyn's Tyrese Martin scored a season-high 26 points ... Michael Porter Jr. had 25 and Noah Clowney added 22 ... Nic Claxton had 10 points and 11 rebounds ... Toronto's Sandro Mamukelashvili scored 12 points in his first start of the season, Grady Dick also scored 12 points and Jamal Sheard had 11 ... Ingram reached 10,000 career points with a 3 in the second, his only basket of the period. Toronto led 65-58 at the intermission ... Mamukelashvili started for center Jakob Poeltl, who sat because of a sore lower back. Rookie Collin Murray-Boyles returned after missing two games because of a sore right knee.

**TORONTO** — RJ Barrett scored the tiebreaking basket with 18 seconds left in the fourth quarter, Brandon Ingram and Scottie Barnes both had pivotal blocked shots in the final moments and the Toronto Raptors won for the eighth time in nine games by beating the Charlotte Hornets 110-108 on Monday night ... Ingram scored 27 points, Barnes and Barrett each had 16 and Immanuel Quickley added 15 points and 10 rebounds as Toronto won its fourth straight ... Ingram got the crowd on its feet with an eye-popping fourth quarter dunk over Hornets rookie center Ryan Kalkbrenner ... After Barrett's go-ahead basket, Ingram maintained the lead by blocking Kalkbrenner from behind ... Jakob Poeltl scored 13 points and Grady Dick had 10 for Toronto ... Kon Knueppel scored 24 points, Miles Bridges added 22 and LaMelo Ball had 20 ... Kalkbrenner led Charlotte with 10 rebounds ... Barnes set a Raptors franchise record by recording at least one block and one steal in his 10th consecutive game, a career-best. Vince Carter did it in nine straight games for Toronto from April 1 to 16, 1999.

ADDITIONAL TEAM NOTES ...

- Set a franchise record in points scored in a third quarter with 48 points on Nov. 21 vs. Washington.
- Set a franchise record by shooting 50%+ from the field in five consecutive games (Nov. 13-21).
- Maple Leafs Sports and Entertainment further extended the contract of Raptors General Bobby Webster on Aug. 18.
- The Raptors signed centre Jakob Poeltl to a multi-year contract extension on Jul. 8. Poeltl averaged career highs of 14.5 points, 9.6 rebounds and 29.6 minutes in 57 games (56 starts) last season. He ranked fifth in the NBA with a .627 (363-579) field goal percentage, his eighth consecutive season shooting better than 60 percent from the floor.
- Toronto selected forward Collin Murray-Boyles with the ninth overall pick in the first round of the 2025 NBA Draft. Murray-Boyles, 6-foot-7, 239 pounds, was an All-SEC Second Team selection after averaging 16.8 points, 8.3 rebounds, 2.4 assists and 30.6 minutes in 32 games (all starts) as a sophomore at South Carolina last season.
- The Raptors also selected guard Alijah Martin with the 39th overall pick (second round) in the 2025 NBA Draft. Martin, 6-foot-2, 208 pounds, was drafted following one season at the University of Florida, where he helped the Gators capture the 2025 national championship. He averaged 14.4 points, 4.5 rebounds, 2.2 assists, 1.5 steals and 30.4 minutes in 38 games (36 starts). ## DARKO RAJAKOVIĆ

### HEAD COACH

The passion Darko Rajaković (rye-AHK-oe-vich) has for the game of basketball has led him around the world. From Madrid, Spain to Tulsa, Oklahoma, each of these experiences have added to Rajaković's beliefs and philosophies, shaping him into the coach, father, and leader he is today.

Raised in Serbia during a civil war, Rajaković fell in love with basketball during a time of unrest in his homeland. The basketball court became his safe haven, a place where he and his friends could gather and play until the wee hours of the morning.

It was fitting Rajaković started his coaching career in his hometown of Cacak, Serbia. At just 16 years of age, he embarked on a life-long journey of teaching others a game that brought him such joy. This started with the local Borac Cacak Youth Team in 1996. After three seasons with the club, he was named the head coach of the U20 and U18 teams of Red Star Belgrade, leading Red Star to two Serbian Youth championships during his eight-year tenure (1999-2007)

Rajaković then ventured to Spain where he coached Espacio Torrelodones for three successful seasons (2009-12). In his first year with the franchise, he led the team to the championship of the Primera Division de Baloncesto in Madrid

From 2004-11, Rajaković held his first formal job with an NBA team, serving as a European scouting consultant and NBA Summer League assistant coach for the San Antonio Spurs.

His time in Serbia, Spain and San Antonio ultimately led Rajaković to the Oklahoma City Thunder, where he spent seven seasons (2012-19). Rajaković joined the organization in 2012 as the head coach of the Tulsa 66ers – the franchise's then NBA G League affiliate and became the first head coach born outside of North America in league history. Under his guidance, the team went 51-49 (.510) over two seasons and reached the 2013 G League semifinals. In 2014, Rajaković was honoured as one of Oklahoma City's assistant coaches at the NBA All-Star game in New Orleans.

Rajaković transitioned from the G League to the NBA at the start of the 2014-15 campaign, in what would be his first of five seasons as an assistant coach with the Thunder (2014-19). Oklahoma City averaged 49 wins during his time on the coaching staff and earned four playoff appearances - including a trip to the 2016 Western Conference Finals.

Rajaković also spent time in the NBA as an assistant coach with the Phoenix Suns (2019-20) and Memphis Grizzlies (2020-23), before being named the 10th head coach in Toronto Raptors history in June of 2023.

On the international stage, Rajaković was as an assistant coach for Serbia at the 2019 FIBA World Cup in China, helping his country to a fifth place finish at the tournament, which included a win over the United States in the classification round.

Rajaković prides himself on being a life-long learner. He earned a basketball coaching degree from the Belgrade Basketball Academy in 2004 and a degree in sports management from Alfa BK University in Belgrade in 2006.

He and his wife, Gaga, reside in Toronto with their son, Luka.
