TEAM NOTES

- The **Toronto Raptors** play hosts to the visiting Boston Celtics on Sunday afternoon for the first game of a four-game season series. The Raptors and Celtics own a 29-29 all-time record when Toronto is the home team. Sunday's contest marks the fourth game of a five-game homestand (Dec. 2-9) which will be capped by a date with New York on Tuesday. The Raptors will be playing their sixth game in nine days (Nov. 29 - Dec. 7).
- The Raptors fell to the Charlotte Hornets on Friday in the second game of a back-to-back set and have now lost two consecutive home games for the first time this season falling to 8-4 overall and 6-2 against Eastern Conference opponents at Scotiabank Arena.
- Immanuel Quickley** led all players with a season-high 31 points going 11-for-22 (.500) from the field and has now shot 50% or better in four consecutive games (Nov. 30 - Dec. 5) finishing 32-for-56 (.571) in that span. His longest streak as a Raptor is five straight.
- Scottie Barnes** passed José Calderón for tenth on Toronto's all-time points list and now sits at 5,238 points. Jonas Valančiūnas sits ninth all-time with 5,524 points scored. Earlier this season, Barnes became the third-quickest Raptor to reach 5,000 career points.
- Former Raptor **Chris Boucher** will make his first return to Toronto for a regular season game — he returned for a pre-season matchup on Oct. 20 — since signing with the Boston Celtics on Aug. 10, 2025. Boucher averaged 8.9 points, 5.1 rebounds and 17.8 minutes in 406 games (23 starts) over seven seasons with the Raptors. The Montreal, Que., native won the NBA Finals with the Raptors in 2019. He left the Raptors as the all-time franchise leader in points, rebounds, blocks, minutes, and games played off the bench.

- Finished with seven points, nine rebounds and two assists in 29 minutes against the Hornets.
- Has recorded five-or-more rebounds in 20 of 24 games played; Ranks second on team in total rebounds (142).
- Has scored 499 points through first 24 games as a Raptor which is second-most in franchise history.

F - SCOTTIE BARNES #4 MIN: 33.6 REB: 7.8 AST: 5.2 STL: 1.38 TO: 2.5 BLK: 1.67 PTS: 20.1

- Recorded 13 points, three rebounds, five assists, one steal and one block in 31 minutes on Friday.
- Joins Sengun and Wembanyama as only three players to average 20 points and one block this season.
- Joins Carter, Lowry, DeRozan and Siakam as only Raps to rank top-10 in all-time points, rebounds and assists.

C - JAKOB POELTL #19 MIN: 26.2 REB: 8.2 AST: 2.4 STL: 0.82 TO: 1.5 BLK: 0.59 PTS: 10.2

- Tallied five points, seven rebounds, two steals, one block and one assist vs. Charlotte.
- Shooting career-high .712 (74 - 104) to start the season, One of three in NBA to shoot 70%+ (Min. 100 FGA).
- Scored career-high 35 points (16-19 FG) last season on Nov. 16 in Boston.

G - JA'KOBE WALTER #14 MIN: 16.8 REB: 2.2 AST: 0.8 STL: 1.10 TO: 0.7 BLK: 0.14 PTS: 5.4

- Recorded two points, four rebounds, two assists and three steals in 25 minutes of action on Friday.
- Has recorded multiple steals in six games this season including career-high tying three steals four times.
- Has made five consecutive starts for the first time since Mar 26 - Apr. 6, 2025 (seven starts).

G - IMMANUEL QUICKLEY #5 MIN: 32.3 REB: 4.4 AST: 6.3 STL: 1.21 TO: 1.8 BLK: 0.04 PTS: 16.8

- Scored a season-high 31 points and added four assists, three rebounds and one steal against Charlotte.
- Has made multiple three-point field goals in 18 of 24 games; Leads team with 63 total 3PT field goals.
- Has shot 50%+ in 11 times this season; Shooting career-high 47.1% from the field through 24 games.

TORONTO — Rui Hachimura made a 3-pointer off a pass from LeBron James as time expired to give the Los Angeles Lakers a 123-120 victory over the Toronto Raptors on Thursday night ... The assist to Hachimura ensured that James' NBA-record streak of 1,297 consecutive double-digit scoring games in the regular season ended ... He finished with eight points, shooting just 4 for 17 ... He went 0 for 5 from 3-point range and did not attempt a free throw ... His assist to Hachimura was his 11th. Austin Reaves scored 44 points, 22 in the third quarter, as the Lakers overcame Luka Doncic's absence ... Deandre Ayton scored 17 points, Jake LaRavia had 14, and Hachimura and Nate Smith Jr. each had 12 as the Lakers bounced back from Monday's home loss to Phoenix to win for the eighth time in nine. Reaves had 10 assists ... He shot 13 for 15 at the free throw line and went 5 for 11 from long range ... Los Angeles is 9-2 on the road ... Scottie Barnes scored 23 points and Ingram had 20 for the Raptors ... Kobe Walter scored 17 points, and Sandro Mamukelashvili and Immanuel Quickley each had 13 ... Raptors rookie Collin Murray-Boyles scored 12 points and Jamison Battle had 10.

Payton Pritchard scored 20 points and Jayson Tatum had 19 points and 11 assists as the Celtics improved to 24-6 on the road ... RJ Barrett scored 22 points and Scottie Barnes had 21 but the Raptors lost for the seventh time in their past nine. Gradey Dick scored 12 points and Immanuel Quickley added 10 ... Toronto finished 5 for 32 from 3-point range, its fewest made 3s of the season ... Kristaps Porzingis was scratched shortly before tip-off because of a non-COVID illness ... Torrey Craig replaced Porzingis in the starting lineup, his first start with Boston ... The Celtics were also without Jrue Holiday (rest), Al Horford (left big toe) and Luke Kornet (personal) ... Toronto snapped a 10-game losing streak against Boston when they last met on Jan. 15 but couldn't build on that victory in their latest encounter with the Atlantic leaders ... Toronto trailed by 17 early in the fourth but cut the deficit to seven, 102-95, on Jamal Shead's basket with 4:18 remaining. Tatum scored with 2:42 left, then stole the ball from Dick. White's sixth 3-pointer restored Boston's double-digit edge.

Jalen Brunson had 18 points, seven assists and six rebounds, and Mikal Bridges and Miles McBride each scored 14 points ... Immanuel Quickley had 19 points and eight assists for Toronto against his former team, and Scottie Barnes added 18 points ... The Raptors dropped to 14-7, a night after their nine-game winning streak ended at Charlotte ... The Knicks and Raptors will meet in the NBA Cup Eastern Conference semifinals in Toronto on Dec. 9 ... The Knicks nearly blew a 24-point first-half lead to the resilient Raptors, who cut New York's lead to three at 70-67 midway through the third ... But Hart and Bridges keyed a 16-1 run over a 4:20 span to help the Knicks pull away again. Hart had eight points, with two made 3-pointers, and Bridges scored six points on the run and assisted on each of Hart's 3s.

- Set a franchise record in points scored in a third quarter with 48 points on Nov. 21 vs. Washington.
- Set a franchise record by shooting 50%+ from the field in five consecutive games (Nov. 13-21).
- Maple Leafs Sports and Entertainment further extended the contract of Raptors General Bobby Webster on Aug. 18.
- The Raptors signed centre Jakob Poeltl to a multi-year contract extension on Jul. 8. Poeltl averaged career highs of 14.5 points, 9.6 rebounds and 29.6 minutes in 57 games (56 starts) last season. He ranked fifth in the NBA with a .627 (363-579) field goal percentage, his eighth consecutive season shooting better than 60 percent from the floor.
- Toronto selected forward Collin Murray-Boyles with the ninth overall pick in the first round of the 2025 NBA Draft. Murray-Boyles, 6-foot-7, 239 pounds, was an All-SEC Second Team selection after averaging 16.8 points, 8.3 rebounds, 2.4 assists and 30.6 minutes in 32 games (all starts) as a sophomore at South Carolina last season.
- The Raptors also selected guard Alijah Martin with the 39th overall pick (second round) in the 2025 NBA Draft. Martin, 6-foot-2, 208 pounds, was drafted following one season at the University of Florida, where he helped the Gators capture the 2025 national championship. He averaged 14.4 points, 4.5 rebounds, 2.2 assists, 1.5 steals and 30.4 minutes in 38 games (36 starts). Martin shot .452 (189-418) from the field, including 35 percent (79-226) from three-point range.

DARKO RAJAKOVIĆ **HEAD COACH**

The passion Darko Rajaković (rye-AHK-oe-vich) has for the game of basketball has led him around the world. From Madrid, Spain to Tulsa, Oklahoma, each of these experiences have added to Rajaković's beliefs and philosophies, shaping him into the coach, father, and leader he is today.

Raised in Serbia during a civil war, Rajaković fell in love with basketball during a time of unrest in his homeland. The basketball court became his safe haven, a place where he and his friends could gather and play until the wee hours of the morning.

It was fitting Rajaković started his coaching career in his hometown of Cacak, Serbia. At just 16 years of age, he embarked on a life-long journey of teaching others a game that brought him such joy. This started with the local Borac Cacak Youth Team in 1996. After three seasons with the club, he was named the head coach of the U20 and U18 teams of Red Star Belgrade, leading Red Star to two Serbian Youth championships during his eight-year tenure (1999-2007)

Rajaković then ventured to Spain where he coached Espacio Torrelodones for three successful seasons (2009-12). In his first year with the franchise, he led the team to the championship of the Primera Division de Baloncesto in Madrid

From 2004-11, Rajaković held his first formal job with an NBA team, serving as a European scouting consultant and NBA Summer League assistant coach for the San Antonio Spurs.

His time in Serbia, Spain and San Antonio ultimately led Rajaković to the Oklahoma City Thunder, where he spent seven seasons (2012-19). Rajaković joined the organization in 2012 as the head coach of the Tulsa 66ers – the franchise's then NBA G League affiliate and became the first head coach born outside of North America in league history. Under his guidance, the team went 51-49 (.510) over two seasons and reached the 2013 G League semifinals. In 2014, Rajaković was honoured as one of Oklahoma City's assistant coaches at the NBA All-Star game in New Orleans.

Rajaković transitioned from the G League to the NBA at the start of the 2014-15 campaign, in what would be his first of five seasons as an assistant coach with the Thunder (2014-19). Oklahoma City averaged 49 wins during his time on the coaching staff and earned four playoff appearances - including a trip to the 2016 Western Conference Finals.

Rajaković also spent time in the NBA as an assistant coach with the Phoenix Suns (2019-20) and Memphis Grizzlies (2020-23), before being named the 10th head coach in Toronto Raptors history in June of 2023.

On the international stage, Rajaković was as an assistant coach for Serbia at the 2019 FIBA World Cup in China, helping his country to a fifth place finish at the tournament, which included a win over the United States in the classification round.

Rajaković prides himself on being a life-long learner. He earned a basketball coaching degree from the Belgrade Basketball Academy in 2004 and a degree in sports management from Alfa BK University in Belgrade in 2006.

He and his wife, Gaga, reside in Toronto with their son, Luka.
