TEAM NOTES

- The **Toronto Raptors** are set to appear in their first-ever NBA Cup quarterfinals appearance on Tuesday night when they take on the New York Knicks at home. Toronto faced New York on the road on Nov. 30, losing 116-94. The Raptors went undefeated in group play, clinching home court advantage after finishing top of East Group A. A victory against New York would send the team to Las Vegas for the semifinals on Dec. 13.
- Despite overcoming a 23-point deficit, the Toronto fell to the Boston Celtics in a Sunday matinee matchup at Scotiabank Arena and have now lost three consecutive games, all of which have come within their current five-game homestand (Dec. 2-9). Toronto allowed 77 points in the first half of the game, the most they have allowed in a first half since Dec. 26, 2024 – when the Memphis Grizzlies scored 78.
- Brandon Ingram** led Raptors scorers with 30 points (11-20 FG, 4-7 3PT), adding four rebounds and three assists in 35 minutes of action. **Scottie Barnes** finished with 18 points and 11 rebounds for his 12th double-double of the season. He also dished out a team-high eight assists for his fourth consecutive game with five-or-more assists.
- Ochai Agbaji** recorded a season-high 11 points for his first double-digit scoring performance of the season after missing the last two games due to personal reasons.
- Raptors two-way player **AJ Lawson** hit the floor for the first time this season, scoring ten points and adding five rebounds off the bench. Lawson is averaging 25.0 points, 4.3 rebounds, 2.3 assists, 2.1 steals and 31.8 minutes with the Raptors 905 in the NBA G League, including a season-high 36-point performance on Dec. 5 vs. Capital City Go-Go.

- Has now recorded 20+ points 17 times in 25 games played this season, including 30+ points twice.
- Has scored 529 points through first 25 games as a Raptor which is second-most in franchise history.

F - SCOTTIE BARNES #4 MIN: 33.8 REB: 8.0 AST: 5.3 STL: 1.36 TO: 2.4 BLK: 1.64 PTS: 20.0

- Recorded 18 points, 11 rebounds, eight assists, one steal, and one block in 37 minutes of action on Sunday.
- Joins Sengun and Wembanyama as only three players to average 20 points and one block this season.
- Joins Carter, Lowry, DeRozan and Siakam as only Raps to rank top-10 in all-time points, rebounds and assists.

C - JAKOB POELTL #19 MIN: 26.1 REB: 7.9 AST: 2.2 STL: 0.78 TO: 1.4 BLK: 0.56 PTS: 10.2

- Tallied ten points and four rebounds in 25 minutes against the Boston Celtics on Sunday night.
- Shooting a career-high .690 (78 - 113) to start the season, ranked third overall in NBA (Min. 100 FGA).
- Averaging 8.3 points, 6.9 rebounds, and 21.5 minutes in 22 career games against the New York Knicks.

G - JA'KOB WALTER #14 MIN: 16.5 REB: 2.1 AST: 0.8 STL: 1.05 TO: 0.7 BLK: 0.14 PTS: 5.2

- Recorded one assist in 12 minutes of play on Sunday night against the Boston Celtics.
- Averaging 5.6 points, 3.3 rebounds, 1.1 assists, and 1.0 steals in seven starts with Toronto this season.
- Has made six consecutive starts for the first time since Mar 26 - Apr. 6, 2025 (seven starts).

G - IMMANUEL QUICKLEY #5 MIN: 32.2 REB: 4.2 AST: 6.2 STL: 1.20 TO: 1.8 BLK: 0.04 PTS: 16.5

- Scored 11 points (4-9 FG) and dished out five assists; has 5+ assists in seven of last eight games.
- Has made multiple three-point field goals in 18 of 25 games; Leads team with 63 total 3PT field goals.
- Has shot 50%+ in 11 times this season; Shooting career-high 47.0% from the field through 25 games.

Payton Pritchard scored 15 points and Anfernee Simons had 12 ... Neemias Queta added 11 points and 11 rebounds ... Brandon Ingram scored 30 points and Scottie Barnes had 18 points and 11 rebounds but Toronto lost its third straight, all at home ... Against Toronto, back-to-back 3s by White and Pritchard turned a three-point deficit into a three-point Boston lead with 7:15 left, and the Celtics didn't trail again ... After making a season-high 24 3-pointers in Friday's home win over the Lakers, Boston connected on 20 of 47 shots from long range against the Raptors ... The Raptors shot 9 for 22 from deep ... Toronto has lost five of six heading into Tuesday's NBA Cup quarterfinal matchup against New York ... Sandro Mamukelashvili scored 14 points for the Raptors ... Ochai Agbaji and Immanuel Quickley each had 11 points, while Jakob Poeltl and AJ Lawson both had 10 ... Boston outscored Toronto 17-4 in second-chance points.

NEW YORK — Josh Hart had 20 points, 12 rebounds and seven assists, Karl-Anthony Towns added 22 points and eight rebounds and the New York Knicks beat the Toronto Raptors 116-94 on Sunday for their fourth straight victory ... Jalen Brunson had 18 points, seven assists and six rebounds, and Mikal Bridges and Miles McBride each scored 14 points ... Immanuel Quickley had 19 points and eight assists for Toronto against his former team, and Scottie Barnes added 18 points ... The Raptors dropped to 14-7, a night after their nine-game winning streak ended at Charlotte ... The Knicks and Raptors will meet in the NBA Cup Eastern Conference semifinals in Toronto on Dec. 9 ... The Knicks nearly blew a 24-point first-half lead to the resilient Raptors, who cut New York's lead to three at 70-67 midway through the third ... But Hart and Bridges keyed a 16-1 run over a 4:20 span to help the Knicks pull away again. Hart had eight points, with two made 3-pointers, and Bridges scored six points on the run and assisted on each of Hart's 3s.

ADDITIONAL TEAM NOTES ...

- Won nine straight games (Nov. 11-26) which tied the fourth-longest winning streak in Raptors franchise history.
- Set a franchise record in points scored in a third quarter with 48 points on Nov. 21 vs. Washington.
- Set a franchise record by shooting 50%+ from the field in five consecutive games (Nov. 13-21).
- Maple Leafs Sports and Entertainment further extended the contract of Raptors General Bobby Webster on Aug. 18.
- The Raptors signed centre Jakob Poeltl to a multi-year contract extension on Jul. 8. Poeltl averaged career highs of 14.5 points, 9.6 rebounds and 29.6 minutes in 57 games (56 starts) last season. He ranked fifth in the NBA with a .627 (363-579) field goal percentage, his eighth consecutive season shooting better than 60 percent from the floor.
- Toronto selected forward Collin Murray-Boyles with the ninth overall pick in the first round of the 2025 NBA Draft. Murray-Boyles, 6-foot-7, 239 pounds, was an All-SEC Second Team selection after averaging 16.8 points, 8.3 rebounds, 2.4 assists and 30.6 minutes in 32 games (all starts) as a sophomore at South Carolina last season.
- The Raptors also selected guard Alijah Martin with the 39th overall pick (second round) in the 2025 NBA Draft. Martin, 6-foot-2, 208 pounds, was drafted following one season at the University of Florida, where he helped the Gators capture the 2025 national championship. He averaged 14.4 points, 4.5 rebounds, 2.2 assists, 1.5 steals and 30.4 minutes in 38 games (36 starts). Martin shot .452 (189-418) from the field, including 35 percent (79-226) from three-point range.

DARKO RAJAKOVIĆ **HEAD COACH**

The passion Darko Rajaković (rye-AHK-oe-vich) has for the game of basketball has led him around the world. From Madrid, Spain to Tulsa, Oklahoma, each of these experiences have added to Rajaković's beliefs and philosophies, shaping him into the coach, father, and leader he is today.

Raised in Serbia during a civil war, Rajaković fell in love with basketball during a time of unrest in his homeland. The basketball court became his safe haven, a place where he and his friends could gather and play until the wee hours of the morning.

It was fitting Rajaković started his coaching career in his hometown of Cacak, Serbia. At just 16 years of age, he embarked on a life-long journey of teaching others a game that brought him such joy. This started with the local Borac Cacak Youth Team in 1996. After three seasons with the club, he was named the head coach of the U20 and U18 teams of Red Star Belgrade, leading Red Star to two Serbian Youth championships during his eight-year tenure (1999-2007)

Rajaković then ventured to Spain where he coached Espacio Torrelodones for three successful seasons (2009-12). In his first year with the franchise, he led the team to the championship of the Primera Division de Baloncesto in Madrid

From 2004-11, Rajaković held his first formal job with an NBA team, serving as a European scouting consultant and NBA Summer League assistant coach for the San Antonio Spurs.

His time in Serbia, Spain and San Antonio ultimately led Rajaković to the Oklahoma City Thunder, where he spent seven seasons (2012-19). Rajaković joined the organization in 2012 as the head coach of the Tulsa 66ers – the franchise's then NBA G League affiliate and became the first head coach born outside of North America in league history. Under his guidance, the team went 51-49 (.510) over two seasons and reached the 2013 G League semifinals. In 2014, Rajaković was honoured as one of Oklahoma City's assistant coaches at the NBA All-Star game in New Orleans.

Rajaković transitioned from the G League to the NBA at the start of the 2014-15 campaign, in what would be his first of five seasons as an assistant coach with the Thunder (2014-19). Oklahoma City averaged 49 wins during his time on the coaching staff and earned four playoff appearances - including a trip to the 2016 Western Conference Finals.

Rajaković also spent time in the NBA as an assistant coach with the Phoenix Suns (2019-20) and Memphis Grizzlies (2020-23), before being named the 10th head coach in Toronto Raptors history in June of 2023.

On the international stage, Rajaković was as an assistant coach for Serbia at the 2019 FIBA World Cup in China, helping his country to a fifth place finish at the tournament, which included a win over the United States in the classification round.

Rajaković prides himself on being a life-long learner. He earned a basketball coaching degree from the Belgrade Basketball Academy in 2004 and a degree in sports management from Alfa BK University in Belgrade in 2006.

He and his wife, Gaga, reside in Toronto with their son, Luka.
