TEAM NOTES

- The **Toronto Raptors** will take on the Miami Heat on Monday evening at the Kaseya Center for the first game of a four-game season series. The two teams will meet again in Miami in eight days on Dec. 23. Toronto, who will play five of their next six games on the road, will complete their two-game road trip (Dec. 15-18) in Milwaukee on Thursday.
- The Raptors, who last played on Tuesday, Dec. 9 at Scotiabank Arena, fell to the New York Knicks in their first quarter-finals appearance of the Emirates NBA Cup.
- Toronto continues to be among the league leaders in total assists this season recording 28 against New York and finishing with a +9 (28-to19) advantage in that category. They have recorded 22 games of 25-or-more assists this year, which is tied with the Miami Heat for second-most such games this year. The Raptors' 765 total assists through 26 games is second-most in the NBA behind the Hawks (831). Heat have fourth-most with 736 assists.
- Brandon Ingram** finished with a team-high 31 points on 11-for-18 shooting against the Knicks marking this third 30+ point game of the season and the first time he has recorded 30+ points in consecutive games since Feb. 28 - Mar. 1, 2024. Ingram is one of 14 players in the NBA to record 18 games or more of 20-or-more points this season.
- Jamal Shead** made his first start of the season last Tuesday and scored a career-high 18 points along with a game-high eight assists. Shead enters play ranked first in assists among all sophomores. He is fourth in the NBA in assists-to-turnover ratio (4.50).
- Raptors forward **RJ Barrett** has missed nine consecutive games (Nov. 24 - Dec. 9) due to a right knee sprain. He is averaging 19.4 points and shooting 50.6% from the field.

- Scored team-high 31 points and added six rebounds, six assists and two steals on Tuesday against New York.
- Has scored 30+ points for first time since Feb. 28 - Mar. 1, 2024; Has done so in three straight once in career.
- Has not played against Miami since Feb. 10, 2022; Tuesday's game will mark 10th career game vs. Heat.

F - SCOTTIE BARNES #4 MIN: 33.9 REB: 7.8 AST: 5.3 STL: 1.38 TO: 2.4 BLK: 1.58 PTS: 19.7

- Tallied 13 points, five rebounds, four assists and two steals in 37 minutes of action against the Knicks.
- Only player in the NBA this season with 100+ rebounds, 30+ steals and 30+ blocks.
- Named Eastern Conference Defensive Player of the Month for October and November.

C - JAKOB POELTL #19 MIN: 26.1 REB: 8.0 AST: 2.3 STL: 0.84 TO: 1.5 BLK: 0.53 PTS: 10.2

- Finished with 10 points, team-high nine rebounds, three assists and two steals on Tuesday evening.
- Leads team in rebounds per game (8.0) and tied with Brandon Ingram for second-most total rebounds (152).
- Has recorded a double-double in two of last three games against the Miami Heat.

G - JA'KOB WALTER #14 MIN: 16.6 REB: 2.0 AST: 0.8 STL: 1.00 TO: 0.7 BLK: 0.13 PTS: 5.5

- Led all reserves with 13 points on Tuesday night and shot 5-for-8 from the field including 3-for-6 from three.
- Shooting career bests of 41.9% from the field and 39.7% from three-point range.
- Averaging 5.6 points, 3.3 rebounds, 1.1 assists, and 21.7 minutes in seven starts this season.

G - IMMANUEL QUICKLEY #5 MIN: 32.2 REB: 4.2 AST: 6.2 STL: 1.20 TO: 1.8 BLK: 0.04 PTS: 16.5

- Missed game on Dec. 9 vs. New York due to an illness; First missed game of the season.
- Has made multiple three-point field goals in 18 of 25 games; Leads team with 63 total 3PT field goals.
- Has shot 50%+ 11 times this season; Shooting career-high 47.0% from the field through 25 games.

Towns returned after sitting out Sunday's home win over Orlando because of tightness in his left calf ... Mikal Bridges scored 15 points for New York and OG Anunoby had 13 against his former team ... Brandon Ingram scored 31 points and Jamal Shead had a career-high 18 but the short-handed Raptors lost their fourth straight, all at home ... Scottie Barnes and Ja'Kobe Walter each scored 13 points for the Raptors, and Jakob Poeltl added 10 ... Toronto went unbeaten in group stage play with all four wins coming during a stretch that saw the Raptors go 13-1 ... They're 1-6 since ... Six Toronto players hit double figures as the victory extended the Raptors' (4-4) win streak to a season-high three games, and avenged a six-point loss to the Bucks (5-3) in Toronto's home opener Oct. 24 at Scotiabank Arena ... Sandro Mamukelashvili came off the bench to score 15 and contribute seven rebounds ... Point guard Immanuel Quickley chipped in 15, followed by Grady Dick's 14 and 13 from Brandon Ingram ... After scoring 31 points with 20 rebounds in the Raptors' home opener, Giannis Antetokounmpo was good for 22 points and eight rebounds to lead the Bucks (5-3) in just 24 minutes ... Jakob Poeltl scored eight points after missing three games with a lower back injury ... The Raptors led for good after a Barrett field goal with 4:32 remaining in the opening quarter gave the home team a two-point lead.

ADDITIONAL TEAM NOTES ...

- Won nine straight games (Nov. 11-26) which tied the fourth-longest winning streak in Raptors franchise history.
- Set a franchise record in points scored in a third quarter with 48 points on Nov. 21 vs. Washington.
- Set a franchise record by shooting 50%+ from the field in five consecutive games (Nov. 13-21).
- Maple Leafs Sports and Entertainment further extended the contract of Raptors General Bobby Webster on Aug. 18.
- The Raptors signed centre Jakob Poeltl to a multi-year contract extension on Jul. 8. Poeltl averaged career highs of 14.5 points, 9.6 rebounds and 29.6 minutes in 57 games (56 starts) last season. He ranked fifth in the NBA with a .627 (363-579) field goal percentage, his eighth consecutive season shooting better than 60 percent from the floor.
- Toronto selected forward Collin Murray-Boyles with the ninth overall pick in the first round of the 2025 NBA Draft. Murray-Boyles, 6-foot-7, 239 pounds, was an All-SEC Second Team selection after averaging 16.8 points, 8.3 rebounds, 2.4 assists and 30.6 minutes in 32 games (all starts) as a sophomore at South Carolina last season.
- The Raptors also selected guard Alijah Martin with the 39th overall pick (second round) in the 2025 NBA Draft. Martin, 6-foot-2, 208 pounds, was drafted following one season at the University of Florida, where he helped the Gators capture the 2025 national championship. He averaged 14.4 points, 4.5 rebounds, 2.2 assists, 1.5 steals and 30.4 minutes in 38 games (36 starts). DARKO RAJAKOVIĆ

HEAD COACH

The passion Darko Rajaković (rye-AHK-oe-vich) has for the game of basketball has led him around the world. From Madrid, Spain to Tulsa, Oklahoma, each of these experiences have added to Rajaković's beliefs and philosophies, shaping him into the coach, father, and leader he is today.

Raised in Serbia during a civil war, Rajaković fell in love with basketball during a time of unrest in his homeland. The basketball court became his safe haven, a place where he and his friends could gather and play until the wee hours of the morning.

It was fitting Rajaković started his coaching career in his hometown of Cacak, Serbia. At just 16 years of age, he embarked on a life-long journey of teaching others a game that brought him such joy. This started with the local Borac Cacak Youth Team in 1996. After three seasons with the club, he was named the head coach of the U20 and U18 teams of Red Star Belgrade, leading Red Star to two Serbian Youth championships during his eight-year tenure (1999-2007)

Rajaković then ventured to Spain where he coached Espacio Torrelodones for three successful seasons (2009-12). In his first year with the franchise, he led the team to the championship of the Primera Division de Baloncesto in Madrid

From 2004-11, Rajaković held his first formal job with an NBA team, serving as a European scouting consultant and NBA Summer League assistant coach for the San Antonio Spurs.

His time in Serbia, Spain and San Antonio ultimately led Rajaković to the Oklahoma City Thunder, where he spent seven seasons (2012-19). Rajaković joined the organization in 2012 as the head coach of the Tulsa 66ers – the franchise's then NBA G League affiliate and became the first head coach born outside of North America in league history. Under his guidance, the team went 51-49 (.510) over two seasons and reached the 2013 G League semifinals. In 2014, Rajaković was honoured as one of Oklahoma City's assistant coaches at the NBA All-Star game in New Orleans.

Rajaković transitioned from the G League to the NBA at the start of the 2014-15 campaign, in what would be his first of five seasons as an assistant coach with the Thunder (2014-19). Oklahoma City averaged 49 wins during his time on the coaching staff and earned four playoff appearances - including a trip to the 2016 Western Conference Finals.

Rajaković also spent time in the NBA as an assistant coach with the Phoenix Suns (2019-20) and Memphis Grizzlies (2020-23), before being named the 10th head coach in Toronto Raptors history in June of 2023.

On the international stage, Rajaković was as an assistant coach for Serbia at the 2019 FIBA World Cup in China, helping his country to a fifth place finish at the tournament, which included a win over the United States in the classification round.

Rajaković prides himself on being a life-long learner. He earned a basketball coaching degree from the Belgrade Basketball Academy in 2004 and a degree in sports management from Alfa BK University in Belgrade in 2006.

He and his wife, Gaga, reside in Toronto with their son, Luka.
