### TEAM NOTES

- The **Toronto Raptors** will travel to Milwaukee to take on the Bucks at Fiserv Forum on Dec. 18 after winning the first game of their brief road trip (Dec. 15-18) against the Miami Heat Monday night. The four-game season series against Milwaukee is currently level at 1-1 apiece, with the Raptors taking their most recent matchup 128-100 on Nov. 4. Following Thursday night's matchup, Toronto will face the Bucks once more on the road Feb. 22.
- Toronto got back in the win column Monday night with a 106-96 win over the Miami Heat, snapping a four-game losing streak - matching their longest of the season. They dished out 33 assists to the Heat's 20 assists, moving to a 14-7 record when recording more assists than their opponent. Toronto has totaled 798 assists through their first 27 games of the season, ranked second in the NBA, just behind the Atlanta Hawks (831).
- Brandon Ingram** led Raptors scorers with 28 points and a season-high tying five three-point field goals Monday night. Ingram has made three-or-more three-point field goals in a season-high three consecutive games.
- Scottie Barnes** recorded his 13th double-double of the season with 17 points, ten rebounds, six assists, three blocks, and two steals in 32 minutes of action. Barnes currently leads the NBA in stocks (steals + blocks) this season with 82 and is the only player in the NBA with 200+ rebounds, 30+ steals, and 30+ blocks this season.
- Jamal Shead** dished out a season-high tying 10 assists and leads sophomores with 145.
- RJ Barrett** who has missed ten games (right knee; sprain) continues to progress after receiving a platelet-rich plasma injection and is scheduled to begin return to play activities this week.

- Scored game-high 28 points and added five rebounds, five assists and a block on Monday night against Miami.
- Has averaged over 20 points per game in seven consecutive seasons; scoring a team-high 21.8 ppg this year.
- Averaging 21.0 points and 7.0 rebounds through first two games against the Milwaukee Bucks this season.

**F - SCOTTIE BARNES #4** MIN: 33.8 REB: 7.9 AST: 5.3 STL: 1.41 TO: 2.5 BLK: 1.63 PTS: 19.6

- Recorded 17 points, ten rebounds, six assists, three blocks, and two steals in 32 minutes against the Heat.
- Has recorded 82 stocks (steals and blocks) this season which leads the entire league.
- Named Eastern Conference Defensive Player of the Month for October and November.

**C - JAKOB POELTL #19** MIN: 26.2 REB: 8.0 AST: 2.3 STL: 0.80 TO: 1.6 BLK: 0.55 PTS: 10.1

- Finished with eight points, eight rebounds, two assists and a block on Monday against the Miami Heat.
- Leads team in rebounds per game (8.0) and tied with Brandon Ingram for second-most total rebounds (160).
- Averaging above 6.0 rebounds in six straight seasons against the Milwaukee Bucks, including 7.0 this year.

**G - OCHAI AGBAJI #30** MIN: 15.0 REB: 2.2 AST: 0.8 STL: 0.47 TO: 0.3 BLK: 0.26 PTS: 3.5

- Added five points, four rebounds, and two assists in his second consecutive start this season (three total starts).
- Started in 45 games for the Toronto last season and averaged 11.4 points, 4.0 rebounds, and 30.2 mins.
- Missed two games (Dec. 4-5) due to personal reasons and had his first double-digit game in his return.

**G - IMMANUEL QUICKLEY #5** MIN: 32.3 REB: 4.2 AST: 6.1 STL: 1.19 TO: 1.8 BLK: 0.04 PTS: 16.5

- Tallied 15 points, four rebounds, four assists, and a steal after missing one game (Dec. 9) due to illness.
- Has made multiple three-point field goals in 19 of 26 games; Leads team with 66 total 3PT field goals.
- Has shot 50%+ 12 times this season; Shooting career-high 47.1% from the field through 26 games.

**MIAMI** — Brandon Ingram scored 28 points and the Toronto Raptors snapped a four-game skid with a 106-96 victory Monday night over Miami, extending the Heat's losing streak to five ... Miami lost forward Nikola Jovic to an elbow injury in the first quarter ... Scottie Barnes added 17 points and 10 rebounds and Immanuel Quickley finished with 15 points for the Raptors, who made 16 3-pointers ... Sandro Mamukelashvili scored 11 points and Gradey Dick added 10 for Toronto ... Norman Powell and Bam Adebayo scored 20 points each and Davion Mitchell added 12 points for the Heat, who played without Tyler Herro ... Down by five early in the fourth quarter, Toronto took the lead for good with a 17-2 run ... The Raptors are 4-6 since RJ Barrett, the team's third-leading scorer, sprained his right knee against Brooklyn on Nov. 23. Barrett, who averages 19.4 points per game, began on-court workouts Monday, coach Darko Rajakovic said.

Towns returned after sitting out Sunday's home win over Orlando because of tightness in his left calf ... Mikal Bridges scored 15 points for New York and OG Anunoby had 13 against his former team ... Brandon Ingram scored 31 points and Jamal Shead had a career-high 18 but the short-handed Raptors lost their fourth straight, all at home ... Scottie Barnes and Ja'Kobe Walter each scored 13 points for the Raptors, and Jakob Poeltl added 10 ... Toronto went unbeaten in group stage play with all four wins coming during a stretch that saw the Raptors go 13-1 ... They're 1-6 since ... Neither of Toronto's former Knicks was available Tuesday ... Immanuel Quickley sat because of an illness while RJ Barrett missed his ninth straight game because of a sprained right knee.

## ADDITIONAL TEAM NOTES ...

- Won nine straight games (Nov. 11-26) which tied the fourth-longest winning streak in Raptors franchise history.
- Set a franchise record in points scored in a third quarter with 48 points on Nov. 21 vs. Washington.
- Set a franchise record by shooting 50%+ from the field in five consecutive games (Nov. 13-21).
- Maple Leafs Sports and Entertainment further extended the contract of Raptors General Bobby Webster on Aug. 18.
- The Raptors signed centre Jakob Poeltl to a multi-year contract extension on Jul. 8. Poeltl averaged career highs of 14.5 points, 9.6 rebounds and 29.6 minutes in 57 games (56 starts) last season. He ranked fifth in the NBA with a .627 (363-579) field goal percentage, his eighth consecutive season shooting better than 60 percent from the floor.
- Toronto selected forward Collin Murray-Boyles with the ninth overall pick in the first round of the 2025 NBA Draft. Murray-Boyles, 6-foot-7, 239 pounds, was an All-SEC Second Team selection after averaging 16.8 points, 8.3 rebounds, 2.4 assists and 30.6 minutes in 32 games (all starts) as a sophomore at South Carolina last season.
- The Raptors also selected guard Alijah Martin with the 39th overall pick (second round) in the 2025 NBA Draft. Martin, 6-foot-2, 208 pounds, was drafted following one season at the University of Florida, where he helped the Gators capture the 2025 national championship. He averaged 14.4 points, 4.5 rebounds, 2.2 assists, 1.5 steals and 30.4 minutes in 38 games (36 starts). Martin shot .452 (189-418) from the field, including 35 percent (79-226) from three-point range.

## **DARKO RAJAKOVIĆ** **HEAD COACH**

The passion Darko Rajaković (rye-AHK-oe-vich) has for the game of basketball has led him around the world. From Madrid, Spain to Tulsa, Oklahoma, each of these experiences have added to Rajaković's beliefs and philosophies, shaping him into the coach, father, and leader he is today.

Raised in Serbia during a civil war, Rajaković fell in love with basketball during a time of unrest in his homeland. The basketball court became his safe haven, a place where he and his friends could gather and play until the wee hours of the morning.

It was fitting Rajaković started his coaching career in his hometown of Cacak, Serbia. At just 16 years of age, he embarked on a life-long journey of teaching others a game that brought him such joy. This started with the local Borac Cacak Youth Team in 1996. After three seasons with the club, he was named the head coach of the U20 and U18 teams of Red Star Belgrade, leading Red Star to two Serbian Youth championships during his eight-year tenure (1999-2007)

Rajaković then ventured to Spain where he coached Espacio Torrelodones for three successful seasons (2009-12). In his first year with the franchise, he led the team to the championship of the Primera Division de Baloncesto in Madrid

From 2004-11, Rajaković held his first formal job with an NBA team, serving as a European scouting consultant and NBA Summer League assistant coach for the San Antonio Spurs.

His time in Serbia, Spain and San Antonio ultimately led Rajaković to the Oklahoma City Thunder, where he spent seven seasons (2012-19). Rajaković joined the organization in 2012 as the head coach of the Tulsa 66ers – the franchise's then NBA G League affiliate and became the first head coach born outside of North America in league history. Under his guidance, the team went 51-49 (.510) over two seasons and reached the 2013 G League semifinals. In 2014, Rajaković was honoured as one of Oklahoma City's assistant coaches at the NBA All-Star game in New Orleans.

Rajaković transitioned from the G League to the NBA at the start of the 2014-15 campaign, in what would be his first of five seasons as an assistant coach with the Thunder (2014-19). Oklahoma City averaged 49 wins during his time on the coaching staff and earned four playoff appearances - including a trip to the 2016 Western Conference Finals.

Rajaković also spent time in the NBA as an assistant coach with the Phoenix Suns (2019-20) and Memphis Grizzlies (2020-23), before being named the 10th head coach in Toronto Raptors history in June of 2023.

On the international stage, Rajaković was as an assistant coach for Serbia at the 2019 FIBA World Cup in China, helping his country to a fifth place finish at the tournament, which included a win over the United States in the classification round.

Rajaković prides himself on being a life-long learner. He earned a basketball coaching degree from the Belgrade Basketball Academy in 2004 and a degree in sports management from Alfa BK University in Belgrade in 2006.

He and his wife, Gaga, reside in Toronto with their son, Luka.
