The Boston Celtics reserves outscored the Toronto Raptors bench 44-to-27 - with two of their reserves finishing above +30.

RAPTORS NOTES

- The Toronto Raptors fell to the Boston Celtics on Saturday night and have now lost a season-high five consecutive games at home and dropped their second game to the Celtics this season.
- The Raptors will face the Nets in Brooklyn tomorrow for the second game of a back-to-back set. Their three-game road swing (Dec. 21-26) will conclude with another visit to Miami on Tuesday, followed by a date against the Washington Wizards on Boxing Day (Dec. 26).
- The Raptors finished with a 30-to-22 (+8) differential in assists tonight. Toronto has recorded their 15th game of 30+ assists this season which is tied with the Utah Jazz for second-most in the league.
- Brandon Ingram finished with a team-high tying 24 points and has now scored 20+ points in a season-high five consecutive games (Dec. 7-20) and for the first time since November 2023. Ingram has scored 20-or-more points in 21 of 29 games this season. He is one of just 10 players in the league to have scored 20+ points 20 times. He added seven assists, four rebounds and one block in a team-high 35 minutes.
- Sandro Mamukelashvili scored a season-high 24 points on 9-for-13 (.692) shooting and made a season-high six three-point field goals. Tonight marks his second 20+ point game of the season. Mamukelashvili has made consecutive starts (Dec. 18-20) for the third time in his career and first time since he made four straight starts Apr. 9-14, 2024, as a member of the San Antonio Spurs. Entering tonight, Mamukelashvili averaged 14.6 points, 8.1 rebounds, 2.8 assists and 30.1 minutes in 18 career starts.
- Raptors rookie Collin Murray-Boyles led the bench with nine points on 4-for-8 (.500) shooting tonight and has now led Raptors reserves in scoring for the seventh time this season. He finished with six rebounds, four assists and one block in 23 minutes.

CELTICS NOTES

- The Boston Celtics contained a 13-point Raptors comeback in the first half to take the victory 112-96 at Scotiabank Arena on Saturday night in the second game of a back-to-back set. The Celtics have now won two consecutive games after defeating the Miami Heat on Friday night. Entering play, Boston lead the NBA with the fewest turnovers per game (12.0), committing only 11 as a team tonight. They also move to 15-2 when leading after the third quarter. Boston will now return home to face the Indiana Pacers on Monday before embarking on a five-game road trip (Dec. 26 – Jan. 3), which will be their longest stretch on the road this season.
- Payton Pritchard recorded 19 of his game-high 33 points in the third quarter, tied for his career-high for points in a quarter to help lead Boston to the victory. The Celtics are now 8-0 during Pritchard's career when he scores 30+. Pritchard also dished out 10 assists for the second time this season for his fourth double-double of the season.
- Anfernee Simons, Luka Garza, and Hugo Gonzalez combined for 37 of the Celtics' 44 bench points. Gonzalez finished a game-high +37 on court and the Celtics are +44 with him playing over their last two games.
- Derrick White scored nine of his 15 points in the fourth quarter as the Celtics outscored the Raptors 29-to-16 in the final quarter. White is coming off two straight season-high scoring games (33 PTS on Dec. 19, 31 PTS on Dec. 15).
