KEY STAT

The Toronto Raptors held the Atlanta Hawks to a season-low 11 points in the fourth quarter after starting the last 12 minutes of play with a 16-0 run, their second-longest scoring run of the season.

RAPTORS NOTES

- The Toronto Raptors win their first game of the 2026 calendar year with a 134-117 win over the Atlanta Hawks at Scotiabank Arena on Saturday night. Toronto is now 11-8 at home this season and (insert extra record stat). This marked the third game of a four-game season series against the Hawks and the Raptors have won all three meetings. They will meet one last time in two days – facing off once more on Monday night in Toronto. Monday night's matchup also marks the fifth and final game of a season-high tying five-game homestand (Dec. 28 – Jan. 5). The Raptors will now hit the road for a brief two-game trip against Charlotte (Jan. 7) and Boston (Jan. 9).
- Brandon Ingram and RJ Barrett each led Raptors scorers with 29 points apiece. Ingram scored 18 of his 29 in the first half of play and added nine rebounds, two steals, two blocks, and an assist in 34 minutes tonight. This marked RJ Barrett's season-high in points and was also first 20+ point game since Nov. 21. Barrett previously missed 15 games (Nov. 24 - Dec. 26) due to a right knee sprain.
- Scottie Barnes scored 20 points and added seven rebounds, four assists, three steals, and two blocks in 32 minutes tonight. Entering play, Barnes was the only player in the NBA with 500+ points, 300+ rebounds and 50+ blocks this year.
- Sandro Mamukelashvili broke several records tonight – he dished out a career-high eight assists and grabbed season-highs of 12 rebounds and three blocks - adding 13 points off the bench for his second double-double of the year. Mamukelashvili finished with a game-high +27 and has led the team in rebounding for the third time this season.

HAWKS NOTES

- The Atlanta Hawks fell to the Raptors in the second game of a back-to-back set and are now 0-3 against Toronto this season. Atlanta entered tonight having won three of their last four games in Toronto, including two consecutive victories. The Hawks will complete their three-game road trip (Jan. 2-5) in Toronto on Monday.
- Nickeil Alexander-Walker led all players with 31 points (10-19 FG, 6-11 3PT) which he has now done twice in the last five games (Dec. 27 – Jan. 3) including 20+ points four times. His 20th game of 20+ points is the most such games in a single-season in his career. His 31 points is the most he has scored against the Raptors in his career.
- Jalen Johnson scored 30 points (10-21 FG, 4-9 3PT) and has now scored 20+ points in six of seven contests (Dec. 21 – Jan. 2) including 30+ points three times. He made four three-point field goals, surpassing the 200 career three-point field goals milestone.
- Dyson Daniels recorded 20 points and 12 assists for his fifth double-double of the season and 15th of his career. Dyson has dished out 5+ assists in his fifth straight game which is tied for the longest such streak of his career.
- Vit Krejci led all Hawks reserves with 13 points going a perfect 4-for-4 from three-point range. Krejci has 83 triples off the bench this season, the second-most makes from deep by a reserve this year behind the Timberwolves' Naz Reid. He made his 90th three-pointer of the season with his fourth make from deep tonight, tying the most triples in a single season in his career (90, 2024-25).
- Keaton Wallace scored 11 points in 19 minutes off the bench and netted his 300th career point.
