KEY STAT

The Toronto Raptors recorded a season-high 14 steals and outscored the Philadelphia 76ers 68-to-54 in points in the paint and 29-to-16 in second chance points.

RAPTORS NOTES

- The Toronto Raptors defeated the Philadelphia 76ers 116-115 in an overtime thriller Sunday night at Scotiabank Arena in the first game in a back-to-back set against the 76ers – with the second matchup taking place tomorrow night in Toronto. The Raptors take a 2-1 lead in the four-game season series and will look to clinch the series. Toronto has now won six out of their last seven matchups against Philadelphia. Following Monday night's game, Toronto will travel to Indiana for a brief road trip (Jan. 14) before returning home to face the LA Clippers on Friday night.
- Scottie Barnes scored 20 of his 31 points in the first half – which is the most he's scored in any half this season – after missing the previous game due to a right knee sprain. This marks his 17th career 30-point game, tying Damon Stoudamire for 10th in Raptors franchise history. Barnes also added a team-high eight assists and seven rebounds in a season-high 43 minutes.
- Rookie Collin Murray-Boyles tied his career-high of 15 rebounds and added 17 points for his second double-double of the season. Seven of those rebounds came on the offensive side of the glass – marking his seventh game with 5+ offensive rebounds, which is the most of any rookie this season. He now has 42 offensive rebounds in his last ten games, the most in any ten-game span by a rookie in Raptors franchise history.
- Jamal Shead got his 13th start of the season alongside Immanuel Quickley and poured in a career-high 22 points (7-15 FG). Shead has recorded double-digit points in consecutive games for the first time this season. Quickley added 20 points, a career-high tying four steals, as well as seven assists and five rebounds in 40 minutes of play.
- Rookie Alijah Martin added career-highs of nine points and eight rebounds in 30 minutes off the bench, just shy of a double-double in a bench-leading performance.

76ERS NOTES

- The Philadelphia 76ers overcome a 14-point deficit in regulation but fell to the Raptors 116–115 in overtime. The 76ers fall to 3-3 in overtime games this season. The Sixers will continue their three-game road trip (Jan. 9-12) tomorrow evening in tomorrow. Entering today, Sixers had won five of their last six (Dec. 30 – Jan. 9).
- Tyrese Maxey led all players with a game-high 38 points (13-27 FG) and has now scored 25+ points in eight of his last nine games (Dec. 26 – Jan. 11) including 30+ four times. He is now scored 30+ points 18 times which is fifth most in the league. Entering tonight, Maxey ranked third in scoring average (30.7) in the NBA. He recorded 40+ points for the 18th time this season. He ranked first in minutes in league per game (39.6) entering tonight. Maxey's seventh career 30-point game against the Raptors is the most by any player since 2021-22.
- Sixers rookie VJ Edgecombe finished with 17 minutes, four rebounds, four assists and two steals in a career-high 45 minutes. He entered play ranked third in scoring average and assists and first in steals and minutes among all rookies this season.
- Kelly Oubre Jr. who played in his 15th game of the season, made his first start since Nov. 14, replacing Paul George who was a late scratch due to left knee soreness. Oubre Jr. finished with 13 points, five rebounds and season highs of four steals and three blocks. Tonight marks the fourth time he has recorded 3+ steals and 3+ blocks in a game.
- Quentin Grimes has scored 10+ points as a reserve in seven of his last eight games (Dec. 28 – Jan. 11). Entering tonight, Grimes was top-10 in the league in most games of 10+ points off the bench.
