**KEY STAT**

The Toronto Raptors dished out 30+ assists for the 26<sup>th</sup> time this season, which is ranked for third-most in the NBA. They also outscored the Bulls in points in the paint (60-44), 2<sup>nd</sup> chance points (20-11), and fastbreak points (17-7).

**RAPTORS NOTES**

- The Toronto Raptors defeated the Chicago Bulls on Thursday night to win the first game of a three-game season series. Toronto will continue their five-game homestand on Sunday against the Indiana Pacers.
- The Raptors shot 56.3% (49-87) from the field tonight – marking the fourth-best shooting performance this season. Toronto improves to 15-3 when shooting 50%+ this season.
- Brandon Ingram scored 22 of his game-high 33 points in the first half and has now scored 20+ points in a half for the third time this season. Ingram has scored 20+ points in four of his last five games (Jan. 28 – Feb. 5) including 30+ points two times. He leads the team with seven 30+ point games this season.
- Colling Murray-Boyles finished with 17 points, five rebounds, four assists, three blocks and one steal in 37 minutes tonight. His 17 points are the most he has scored since scoring 17 points Jan. 11 vs. Philadelphia. Murray-Boyles has scored 10+ points in eight of his last 10 games (Jan. 11 – Feb. 5).
- Sandro Mamukelashvili led all Raptors reserves with 17 points in 23 minutes off the bench. He has led Raptors bench scoring in three straight games and 19 contests this season.
- The Raptors announced Thursday they have acquired guard Chris Paul from the Los Angeles Clippers in a three-team trade with the Brooklyn Nets. Brooklyn will receive guard Ochai Agbaji and a 2032 second round pick from the Raptors and cash considerations from the Clippers, while Los Angeles will receive the draft rights to guard Vanja Marinković from Brooklyn. Toronto also announced the acquisition of centre-forward Trayce Jackson-Davis from the Golden State Warriors in exchange for a 2026 second round draft pick (via the Los Angeles Lakers). Jackson-Davis, 6-foot-9, 248 pounds, is averaging 6.6 points, 4.6 rebounds, 1.3 assists and 15.1 minutes in 166 career games (54 starts) with Golden State.

**BULLS NOTES**

- On NBA Trade Deadline Day, the Chicago Bulls saw a new starting lineup and ten players suit up. The Bulls dropped their third straight and are complete their four-game road trip with a 1-3 record. This breaks a four-game win streak against the Raptors after sweeping Toronto last season. They will return home for a brief contest against the Denver Nuggets on Saturday.
- The Bulls have 6 players with double-digit points – including Anfernee Simons (22) who led Chicago scorers.
- Yuki Kawamura dished out a career-high tying seven assists all in the first half – the most of his career.
- NBA Trade Deadline moves: Acquired guard Rob Dillingham and forward Leonard Miller from the Minnesota Timberwolves along with four second-round picks. In exchange, Chicago dealt guard Ayo Dosunmu and forward Julian Phillips to Minnesota ... Acquired center-forward Guerschon Yabusele and cash considerations from the New York Knicks in exchange for guard Dalen Terry ... Acquired guard Anfernee Simons from the Boston Celtics along with a 2026 second-round pick in exchange for center Nikola Vučević and a 2027 second-round pick ... Acquired guard Collin Sexton, center-forward Ousmane Dieng and three second-round picks from the Charlotte Hornets in exchange for guards Coby White and Mike Conley Jr ... Acquired guard Jaden Ivey along with guard Mike Conley Jr. in a three-team deal involving the Detroit Pistons and Minnesota Timberwolves. Chicago dealt forward Kevin Huerter and center Dario Šarić to the Pistons as part of the trade ... Acquired center Dario Šarić from the Sacramento Kings along with 2027 and 2029 second-round picks in a three-team deal also involving the Cleveland Cavaliers. Chicago dealt forward Emanuel Miller to the Cavaliers as part of the trade.
