**KEY STAT**

The Toronto Raptors outscored the Dallas Mavericks 21-to-4 in fastbreak points and 64-to-52 in points in the paint.

The Raptors lead the league in fastbreak points this season with 18.8 per game, while the Mavericks were ranked fourth in the league heading into tonight's contest in points in the paint with 53.1 per game this season.

**RAPTORS NOTES**

- The Toronto Raptors defeated the Dallas Mavericks snapping a four-game home losing streak and improve to 17-16 at Scotiabank Arena this season. With the win, Toronto has tied the season series at one game apiece and also snapped a four-game losing streak against Dallas. The Raptors will hit the road for a two-game road trip (Mar. 10-11) for back-to-back games against Houston and New Orleans.
- The Raptors shot 50.5% (48-95 FG) from the field and have now shot 50%+ in 20 games this season, improving to 17-3 in those contests. Toronto also kept Dallas to 92 points which is the second-lowest points total by an opponent this season. The Raptors are 8-1 when keeping opponents to under 100 points.
- Toronto recorded a +17 (39-to-22) advantage in assists tonight. The 39 assists given up by the Mavericks matches an opponent high this season. The Raptors improve to 20-10 when recording 30+ assists.
- RJ Barrett finished with a game and season-high 31 points (13-19 FG) tonight. He has now scored 20+ points in a season-high four consecutive games (Feb. 28 – Mar. 8) becoming the third Raptor to do so this season joining Scottie Barnes and Brandon Ingram who did so five games. Barrett also the 8,000 NBA career points milestone, becoming the eighth Canadian to reach this mark and the 54th player aged 25 years or younger in NBA history.
- Jakob Poeltl finished with 16 points and a team-high 10 rebounds for his fourth double-double of the season and his second in four games. He also finished with two blocks and one steal and has now recorded at least two stocks in five of his last six games (Feb. 22 – Mar. 8) totaling nine steals and eight blocks in that span.

**MAVERICKS NOTES**

- The Dallas Mavericks took a 30-point loss to the Toronto Raptors Sunday evening at Scotiabank Arena, their largest margin of defeat against the Raptors in franchise history and have split the season series for the third time in the last four seasons. Prior to tonight, the Mavericks had won four consecutive games against Toronto. Despite the loss, Dallas held Toronto to 10-of-36 (.278) from the three-point field goal line and are now 9-9 (.500) when holding a team to .300 or below from beyond the arc this season.
- Daniel Gafford recorded a season-high 21 points and a game-high 11 rebounds for his eighth double-double of the season. He is now 108 points away from achieving 4,000 NBA career points. His 11 rebounds also surpassed 300 rebounds on the season, marking the fifth consecutive season he has reached 300+ boards.
- 2025 NBA Draft first overall pick Cooper Flagg played his first game in front of the Toronto crowd and added 17 points, eight rebounds, six assists, three blocks, and two steals in 30 minutes on the floor tonight. Flagg recently became the third player since the merger (1976-77) to amass 1,000 points, 300 rebounds and 200 assists through his first 50 career games.
- Brandon Williams led bench scorers with 16 points, two blocks, and an assist in 19 minutes. Williams has scored 15+ points in 25 games played this season, with 15 of those performances coming as a reserve.
