KEY STAT

The Toronto Raptors recorded a season-high 30 second chance points for just the tenth time in the last 30 NBA season - their franchise record is 36 in 2002.

RAPTORS NOTES

- The Toronto Raptors extended their winning streak at Scotiabank Arena to three consecutive wins with a Sunday evening victory over the top-ranked Eastern Conference team in the Detroit Pistons. After holding Detroit to just 17 points in the third quarter and outscoring them 34-to-17, the Raptors evened their three-game season series and will look to secure the series win at the end of the month with a contest in Detroit. Toronto came into tonight averaging 30.3 points in the third quarter, ranked sixth in the NBA. The Raptors will now embark on a season-high tying five-game road trip (Mar. 18-25).
- Brandon Ingram led Raptors scorers for the 30th time this season with a game-high 34 points in 39 minutes of play. He has now scored 20+ points in three consecutive games for the seventh time this season and for the first time since Feb. 25 - Mar. 3. Ingram is now up to 119 three-point field goals this season, the third-most of his career and the third time he has recorded 100+ three-point field goals in a single season.
- Jakob Poeltl grabbed a season and game-high 18 rebounds along with 21 points for his fifth double-double of the season. His previous high was 13 rebounds Nov. 24 vs. Cleveland. This marks his 60th double-double as a Raptor, ninth-most in franchise history. Poeltl hasn't recorded 15+ rebounds since his career-high of 19 boards Nov. 24, 2024 at Cleveland. His 21 points are also one point shy of a season-high. This marked his second career 20/15/5 game and his first in a Raptor jersey. He is the seventh player in franchise history to record this statline.
- RJ Barrett poured in 27 points and six assists in 39 minutes and has now recorded 20+ points in seven of his last eight games.
- Scottie Barnes added 14 points, ten rebounds, eight assists, three blocks, and a steal for his 25th double-double of the season. His three blocks has resulted in totaling 100 blocks in a single-season for the first time in his career. He is the fifth player to reach 100 blocks this season and the 16th Raptor to do so in franchise history (the first since Chris Boucher in 2020-21).

PISTONS NOTES

- The Detroit Pistons fell to the Raptors snapping a seven-game winning streak against Toronto in what was Detroit's longest active winning streak against any team and longest against any team as a franchise since taking six in a row also from the Raptors from 2021-22. The Pistons also snapped a three-game winning streak overall (Mar. 10-13).
- The Eastern Conference leaders will continue their three-game road trip on Tuesday which will see the Pistons play the Wizards in consecutive games (Mar. 17-19) in Washington.
- Cade Cunningham scored a team-high 33 points and added a team-high nine assists along with three rebounds and two steals in 37 minutes. Cunningham averaged 20.2 points, 8.0 assists and 6.2 rebounds in nine career games against Toronto with 10+ points in each of them and four double-doubles coming into today. Cunningham is ranked top-15 in scoring average and ranked second in the NBA in assists per game.
- Jalen Duren — who missed the first game against Toronto on Feb. 11 due to a suspension — finished with 20 points and a team-high 11 rebounds in 37 minutes of his 34th double-double of the season which is second-most on the team behind Cunningham (37) and fifth-most in the league.
- Caris LeVert led all Pistons reserves with nine points as Detroit's bench outscored Toronto's by +12 (29-to-17).
