ALL-TIME RECORDS

KEY STAT

The Raptors' 31-0 run marks the largest run in league history since play-by-play tracking began during the 1996-97 season. The previous record was 30-0 by Dallas Dec. 2, 2023.

RAPTORS NOTES

- The Toronto Raptors defeated the Orlando Magic 139-87 taking the season series 2-1. The +52-point margin of victory is the second-highest in Raptors franchise history (+53 – Apr. 2, 2021 vs. Golden State) and just the second time Toronto has defeated an opponent by 50 points. It is also the largest margin of victory against the Magic all-time and against any opponent this season. 87 points is the lowest points total by a Raptors' opponent this season.
- Sandro Mamukelashvili finished with a game-high +47 from the field which is the third-highest plus-minus by a Raptor behind Gary Trent Jr. (+54) and Pascal Siakam (+49) which was also recorded Apr. 2, 2021 vs. Golden State.
- In the first quarter, the Raptors went on a 31-0 which is the largest run in league history since play-by-play tracking began during the 1996-97 season. The previous record was 30-0 by Dallas Dec. 2, 2023.
- Through the first three quarter, the Raptors scored 113 points which is their second-most through the first three frames in franchise history and the most since they had 117 on Mar. 23, 2026 vs. Utah.
- The Raptors also recorded 20 steals tonight marking a franchise record. The previous best was 19 steals Dec. 7, 2024 vs. Dallas. It is also the first time Toronto had five players record three steals in a single-game.
- The Raptors, who entered play leading the league in fast break points, finished with 39 such points marking a season-high and owning a +32 (39-to-7) differential in that category tonight.
- Toronto recorded 41 assists improving to 4-0 when recording 40+ assists this season.
- Scottie Barnes finished with 23 points and a career-high 15 assists. He has now recorded 10+ assists in a career-high four straight games becoming the sixth player in franchise history to do so joining Kyle Lowry, Jose Calderon, Mark Jackson, Mike James and Damon Stoudamire. Barnes is the second Raptor this season to record 20+ points and 15+ assists joining Immanuel Quickley who had 21-15 Jan. 1 vs. Brooklyn.
- With three steals tonight, Barnes is the first player in the NBA this season to reach 100+ steals and 100+ blocks and is just the second player to do so in franchise history joining Oliver Miller (1995-96).

MAGIC NOTES

- The Orlando Magic fell to the Toronto Raptors at Scotiabank Arena Sunday night, dropping the season series 1-2. The 52-point loss marks their largest margin of defeat against the Raptors in franchise history. They have lost four consecutive games on the road and will return home for a brief two-game homestand. Orlando is 24-24 (.500) against Eastern Conference opponents this season and four of their remaining eight matchups of the regular season are against Eastern Conference teams. The Magic are 15-18 in games decided by ten-or-more points this season.
- Desmond Bane led Magic scorers with 17 points and two three-point field goals. Bane surpasses 1,500 season points for the first time in his NBA career.
- Among the starters, Jalen Suggs added 13 points and Tristan da Silva scored 12 points, his three rebounds surpassing 500 career boards.
- The Magic gave up 28 turnovers leading to 37 points for the Raptors, the most they have committed since they had 28 turnovers on Apr. 13, 2011 against the Indiana Pacers.
