Goals and actions will be added with staff during the LCAP


LCAP must be approved before the budget,

Mr. Aguilar described the 10 year revitalization plan for language,

Partner with statewide advocates in education and add more to our robust program, Form part of a state wide campaign to advance the resources needed for our students in community, and looking to consider

Emersion school program, this is not an easy decision for the parents to make, both in terms of the strength and direction, this provides a really good road map, for the strategic planning

securing funding as a pilot project now is because we are talking about the legislative cycle, we don't have enough time to add time to the legal bills and state budget, this will lay the seeds out for a strategy of next year,

Casas says yes to the plan and so does Rojas,

Macias, - PowerPoints and documentation should be shared with him and show him what was done on that day, public use of the languages, its important to focus on the acquisition of the languages both in writing and reading and in print, Latin American studies, had Nahuatl about here and there is not enough speech community in the LA area the way there is in other indigenous language groups, newspaper or news room, and add this to the social and community,

- Aguilar states that there should be a newspaper even on Mexico, and we need to connect more with the nawatl community
- Next week there is a gathering in Las Vegas, with Nick and meeting with them to see what the next steps are
- NIEA director contacted him and asked him is Melinda's money, he will be getting us in touch with this, a couple of things in the works and is very meaningful
