Anahuacalmecac International University Preparatory of North America is dedicated to student academic excellence, Native wisdom, and appreciation of the cultural and intellectual heritage of Indigenous Peoples and the promotion of positive social awareness.

SPECIAL EDUCATIONAL NEEDS POLICY

All special education needs of students at Anawakalmekak are met through a full-inclusion model. Therefore, all special education students participate in the full regular curriculum including the MYP, with adequate support and services as specified by their IEP. Full inclusion of students with special needs advances the school-wide culture of collaboration (*Paleuilistle*) that encourages and supports inquiry and problem-solving.

All special education needs of students at AIUP are met through an inclusion model with push in services delivered by a qualified provider (i.e. education specialist, speech pathologist, psychologist, etc.) Teachers are offered professional development in collaboration with the special education team. In addition planning time is allocated to develop curriculum that is inclusive to all learners. Therefore, all special education students meaningfully participate in the regular curriculum with supports and services as specified by their IEP and updated annually or as needed.
