EVENT GROUND ACCESS

This is a closed-door event strictly for paid participants; please note that spectators, friends, and family are not permitted. If you intend to bring a track car or your own mechanic/pit crew, you must notify MSS in advance for organiser approval. For your convenience, Lim Tan Motor will be on-site providing pit crew support to all participants."

Access to the paddock is through the **Main Gate** (marked in red), with participants' cars required to cross the competition ground to enter. Competitors with support vehicles may bring them in temporarily to unload tools and spares. Due to limited parking, support or personal vehicles must exit the paddock after the designated loading/unloading period. Non-compliance with this policy, including unauthorized vehicle entry, may lead to the participant's disqualification or removal from the event.

The designated access window for personal and support vehicles to unload tools and spare parts is 8:00 AM to 8:30 AM on Saturday, 6 June, and Sunday, 7 June. All support vehicles, including personal vehicles, must leave the paddock area by 8:30 AM sharp.

EARLY SETUP AND TOWING OF TRACK CARS

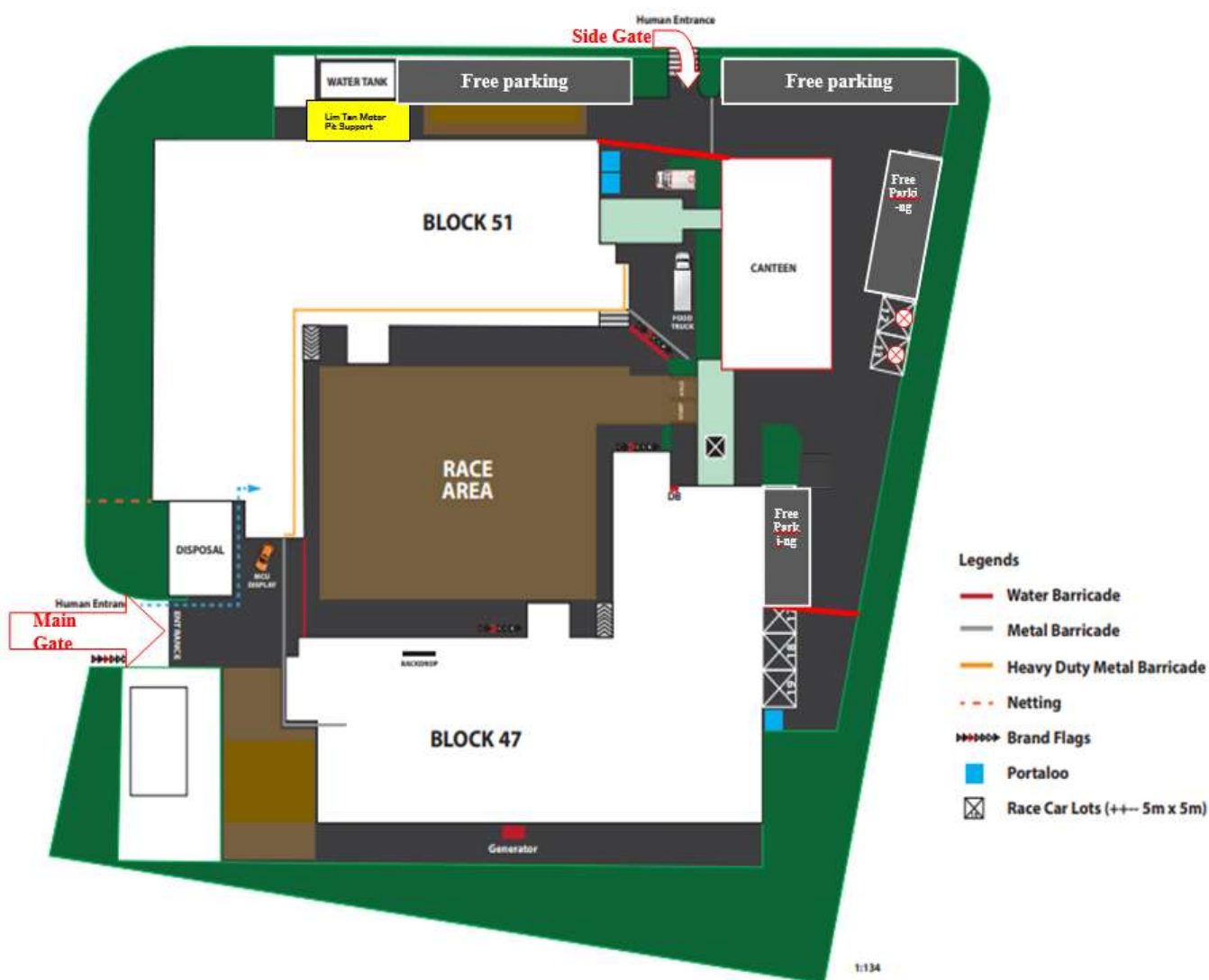
On Friday, 5 June 2026, the paddock will be open strictly between 5:00 PM and 6:00 PM for early tow-in of track cars, tent setup, and unloading of spares. The paddock will be locked and secured at 6:00 PM sharp. No one is permitted to remain on-site after this time. Any equipment or vehicles left behind are entirely at your own risk.

PARKING AND SECURITY

Please note that the **"Free Parking"** indicated in the diagram is available for use by all participants on a shared & first come first served basis, with no designated allocations.

As the number of entries is high and parking availability is limited, we kindly seek your cooperation in parking closely together to make the most efficient use of the allocated area. Any requests to adjust or exchange parking arrangements should be coordinated directly between participants.

Overnight security will not be provided. MSS, JTC, and the event organizers accept no responsibility for any personal property. All vehicles and belongings are left and parked entirely at the owner's risk.



IMPORTANT NOTES:

Driver Sign-In Requirements: All drivers must present valid driver's license, either in physical or digital format, at sign-in.

Track Familiarization Restrictions: Drivers are strictly prohibited from using bicycles, rollerblades, skateboards, or any power-assisted wheels to familiarize themselves with the track. Playing music inside the car is not permitted, and no passengers are allowed during practice/demo runs unless they have signed an indemnity form or are MSS appointed instructors.

Speed and Conduct Outside the Circuit: A speed limit of 10 km/h applies outside the circuit. Any participant found speeding, testing handbrakes, drifting, or performing tire burnouts will be removed from the event. All participants must follow instructions from the marshals at all times.

SCRUTINEERING

Vehicle Inspection: Drivers must open their car's bonnet and trunk for a mechanical inspection. All loose items, such as phone holders, sunglasses, air fresheners, water bottles, window blinds/curtains, clip-on rearview mirrors, and driver-side floor mats, must be removed from the car's cabin before scrutineering.

Eligibility and Compliance: The MSS Scrutineers will assess the eligibility of all cars in the event. Their decisions are final and at their discretion. Non-compliance will be referred to the MSS, and drivers may be excluded from the event without a refund.

All participants are encouraged to attend the Meet and Greet Session at Lim Tan Motor on Friday 5th June 7pm to 10pm. A vehicle pre-inspection (optional) will be conducted by Lim Tan Motor for all participants' vehicles.

ATTIRE

Dress Code: Helmets with any visible damage are not allowed. Participants must wear covered shoes—no flip-flops, slippers, sandals, or open-toe footwear. Long pants or jeans are required; skirts, dresses, and 3/4-length pants are not permitted. T-shirts are required—no sleeveless tops, spaghetti straps, or singlets. Racing gloves and racing shoes are optional.

CREW CONDUCT

Behavior in the Paddock: Any drivers found smoking, vaping, or behaving disruptively in the paddock, thereby causing a nuisance to others, will be excluded from the event. Drivers found consuming alcoholic beverages will be removed and excluded. Smoking is strictly prohibited within the event grounds (JTC compound) and is only allowed outside the Main and Side Gates.

BANNERS AND ADVERTISING

No Display of Banners or Promotional Materials: Pull-up banners, posters, or any form of product/service displays are not allowed in the paddock. Commercial activities, such as videography, distributing brochures or handouts, are strictly prohibited throughout the event, except for sponsors.

POST-EVENT

Clean-Up: All participants are requested to clear any trash they leave behind in the paddock area after the event and to depart in an orderly manner. Please refrain from loud departures, such as "pops and bangs."
