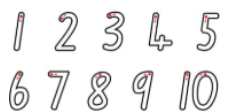

Art Draw a picture of your family. Can you add colour and label who is who? 	PE Set yourself a challenge - how many star jumps can you do in a minute? Can you beat your record? 
Science Can you explore your senses? Go outside and tell an adult what you can see, hear, smell, feel and taste? 	PSHE In PSHE, we will be looking at our emotions and what keeps us healthy. Create a poster about why it is important to wash our hands. 	Geography Go for a walk around your local area. Point out key features e.g. road, shop, school, houses etc. Challenge - can you draw a map of your walk?
