




# Who is eligible? How to sign up?

## JGAH Membership Eligibility

- Must be between the ages of 7-18.
  - Click the signup link on the JGAH website ([jgah.org](http://jgah.org)).
- Player Ability Test (PAT)
  - New members require a PAT.
  - Schedule PAT by using the email link on JGAH website.
  - We will notify the participants of the date of the PAT.
  - Etiquette, Pace of Play, Dress Code, Long and Short Game proficiency, and some rules.

# 2026 Player of The Year Qualifications

- **Point Schedule for Regular / Major Tournaments (next slide)**
- **Must participate in 50% of all tournaments in their respective division.**
- **Must participate in community service before the day of the final Championship Tournament.** (Donation to JGAH or your organization of choice. )

# Important Items from the JGAH Handbook

- **JGAH Membership Fees**

- The membership fee for this golf season is \$150.00 per individual. Fee includes a JGAH logoed golf shirt. ***The current season JGAH shirt is to be WORN AT ALL tournaments. Multiple infractions may exempt player from POY.***

- **Responsibilities of Parents/Guardians**

- All parents/guardians/guests/volunteers shall comply with the code of conduct and dress code. Covered toe footwear must be worn while on the golf course. Parents/guardians/guests/volunteers shall conduct themselves in a manner that is not detrimental to JGAH, its members, and the host facilities.

- **Responsibilities of Players**

- JGAH encourages all junior golfers to participate in JGAH coordinated community service events to develop an appreciation and concern for others and their community.
  - JGAH coordinated community service events will be advised to the membership as they occur.

# More Important Items from the JGAH Handbook

## Types of Offenses: Category 3:

Description: All age divisions must check-in 30 minutes prior to your tee time.

Consequence: 2 Stroke penalty.

Description: No-show for a tee-time or JGAH event without cancellation.

Consequence: Suspension from next tournament entered or entitled to enter.

# 2026 Notah Begay III Qualifier

- **Background Information**

- Founded in 2020
- Played on the Koasati Pines GC @ Coushatta, Kinder, Louisiana
- Each year more than 3,000 players have participated in their local and regional qualifiers with 300 making it to the National Championship.
- The final round is televised on the “Golf Channel”.
- Player NB3 Championship and Regional age divisions are determined by their age as of May 1, 2025.

  - Handicap index must be 9.9 or less

- Prior knowledge to certain positions is not necessary, we will pair all volunteers with an experienced volunteer in the beginning to train.

# Tournament Rules

- 2026 JGAH Shirt to be worn at every tournament (after distribution).
- The Notice to Player (NTP) provides specific rules relating to the golf course of the current event. The NTP is provided via player email prior to tournament day and a paper copy is posted at the check-in table.
- Parents and guardians are encouraged to read and understand the NTP together with their player.
- Pace of Play (POP) - keeping up with pace of play is not an option. In order for all of our players to finish in a timely daylight manner, pace of play must be adhered to.
- 10 and under division – maximum score per hole is double par plus two (2). If you have not holed out with your double par stroke, pick up your ball and add 2 strokes for your final score. ex: Par 4 = (8 + 2 = 10). Parents of 10 and under division are expected to volunteer as a score keeper (parents will not score their own child, there will be 2 score keepers per group, a cart will be provided)

# Tournament Rules (continued)

- Check Points – are positioned to monitor Pace of Play, score accuracy and assist with player request.
- JGAH requires that player's score be posted after each hole is completed.
- Electronic Devices – allowed for distance measuring only. Other uses such as determining wind speed, elevation changes, temperature etc. will result in disqualification.
- Cell phone may be used for: (1) electronic scoring, (2) determining distance, (3) requesting assistance, (4) emergency.
- Audio and Video devices are prohibited. During a round, a player must not listen to or watch content of any nature on a personal audio or video device.
- All decisions by the Tournament Committee are final.

# Tournament Refund Policy

- No refunds of tournament fees except for the following:
  - Prior notice of **one week** must be provided via email.
  - Decisions on refunds will be made on a case-by-case basis after review of requests by the Board of Directors.
  - This policy is to ensure limited changes need to be made to player pairings and tee times.
- No Show Policy
  - Previously discussed




# Golf Genius™/ Scoring System



- GG Live Scoring for all players will be on a delayed basis.
  - Scores will be reviewed prior to posting.
- Standard paper scorecard and electronic scoring will utilized pending players development.
- Cell phones on course has been addressed on previous slide
- When electronic scoring is utilized, paper scorecards will be available for those without cell phones.
- At the Scoring Table:
  - Players are given the opportunity to discuss and correct any scoring discrepancies prior to submitting their final scorecard.

# What is the JGAH Cup?

## Overview

- Season-long team competition similar to the LIV's team golf element
- Teams are initially inspired by the BOD, but each team will have the opportunity to name their team
- Team w/ highest cumulative point total wins the JGAH Cup Trophy
- Promotes team play, creating new bonds throughout divisions, pride

## How it works

- Players earn points for their team based on performance and participation
- Bonus points awarded through mulligans for special achievements
- Teams will reshuffle at the end of season

## Awards

- Trophy is a perpetual award, like the Ryder Cup
- Winning team's name engraved each season
- Trophy displayed at every tournament
- Updated leaderboard will be available on the website
- Prizes for winning teams

- Points awarded for:
- Scores will be added to the team score, and a cumulative scoring average will be based on participating team members only
- Points will be given for all team places
- Opportunities for bonus points through Mulligans
- Clear scoring rubric shared before each event
- Points tallied and added to team totals after each tournament
- Point standings will be displayed on the JGAH website and updates on Instagram
