

CCW BOARD MEETING MINUTES OCTOBER 30 2025

The October Board meeting began with the Mother of Good Counsel prayer, followed by the Pledge of Allegiance.

Parishioner Brigitta Kaiser met with the Board to explain her presentation that she will be presenting at our CCW Open Meeting on Thursday, Nov. 6. Her testimony will include how she felt called to pursue religious life with the Salesian Sisters of Saint John Bosco. She will touch on the need for fundraising for the Laboure Society. This meeting will start at 5:30 p.m. with a social hour, followed by the meeting at 6:00 p.m. Simple treats and apple cider will be served.

The previous Open Meeting minutes from Oct. 2 were approved, with a motion from Jan Ross and seconded by Nancy Sarno.

Treasurer Nancy S. gave a checkbook balance of \$10,808.71. Volunteer forms are being returned with dues of \$2,385 being received.

Plans were discussed regarding a Bethany Brunch to be held at St. Pat's Church Saturday, Nov. 8. Our CCW group will host the food, with representatives from the Diocese planning and heading up this event. Young women from the area will attend to gather information regarding entering religious life. A Mass will be held at 9:00 a.m.

Spirituality Commissioner Jan R. gave an update on the upcoming Advent wreath sale that will happen the weekends of Nov. 22/23 and 29/30. She will handle taking an inventory of the current supply and order the items needed to supplement the wreaths and replacement candles.

The annual Kris Kringle Giving event will be held the weekend of Dec. 13/14. Information will be posted in the upcoming weeks in the bulletin, church website and sent out to the ladies of the Parish. Instructions on what to donate, helping to assemble the baskets/boxes and how the children can shop for family members will be given. Jenny Cernohous will be chairing this event.

Leadership Commissioner/Superior Diocesan President Bridgette Adler announced that the Diocesan Convention will be held at Immaculate Conception in New Richmond June 18 – 19, 2026.

New business included Secretary Leigh Weiss stating that she is continuing to shop for supplies for the church kitchen with monies raised from the Kitchen Shower that was held in the Spring of 2025.
