

CCW BOARD MEETING DECEMBER 4 2025

The CCW Board meeting began with a prayer, led by Spirituality Commissioner Jan Ross, followed by the Pledge of Allegiance.

To approve the previous meeting minutes of Oct. 30, a motion was made by Nancy S. and seconded by Bridgette A. Motion passed.

The Becoming Catholic group asked for their Advent replacement candles to be donated by the CCW. A motion was made by Anne K. and seconded by Nancy A. Motion passed.

Treasurer Nancy S. reported a checkbook balance of \$10,524.55. She added that the sales of Advent products that took place the weekends of Nov. 22/23 and Nov. 29/30., produced a total of \$506 with a profit of \$176, that was headed up by Spirituality Commissioner Jan R. Jan added that she had already started purchasing the items for next year, in order to get a discount. She is researching children's books to add to the group of Advent products.

Leadership Commissioner Bridgette A., who is also President of the Superior Diocese CCW, stated that a Retreat is being held at Immaculate Conception Church in New Richmond on Dec. 13. She also added that the Board will begin collecting possible names for 2025-26 Pax Christi nomination.

Plans are continuing for the upcoming CCW weekend on Dec. 13/14. It will include a Bake Sale, Sunday Social and the annual Kris Kringle Corner, that is chaired by Jenny C. Ladies are asked to help assemble the baskets and boxes for the Corner on Dec. 10 at 10 a.m. A request has been sent out to the CCW email list, asking for volunteers to help the children with shopping and wrapping the gifts on that weekend after all the Masses. An additional request will be sent out asking for more help from the ladies of the Parish for the various time slots.

Jenny C. has come forward to fill the vacancy of the Board position of Service Commissioner. A motion was made by Nancy S. to nominate Jenny for this position and seconded by Leigh W. Motion Passed.

An additional date for a Board meeting was set for April 9, 2026.
