Bob Egan is best-known for his decades spent as a musician for the acclaimed bands Blue Rodeo and Wilco. As an in-demand session player, he has recorded on over 120 records including the Tragically Hip's 2000 Juno-award winning Single of the Year, Bobcaygeon. As a member of Blue Rodeo, Bob has received 6 Juno Awards and 13 Gold and Platinum records. He is a member of 3 Canadian Halls of Fame and was awarded the Governor General's Performing Arts Award in 2014.

Prior to his music career, Bob earned a Masters degree in Industrial/Organization Psychology specializing in employee attitude and organizational culture research. After 7 years as a management consultant, he left the corporate world to establish and manage North America's largest volume guitar repair facility before embracing music fulltime.
