## **MANAGEMENT DISCUSSION OF FUND PERFORMANCE**

This annual management report of fund performance presents management's view of the significant factors and developments during the period that have affected the fund's performance and outlook. In this report, "Matco" refers to Matco Financial Inc., the Manager of the Fund.

### **Investment Objective and Strategies**

The objective of the Matco Global Equity Fund (the "Fund") is to achieve above-average long-term, risk-adjusted returns by investing in global equity securities. Capital will be allocated to the best global opportunities, which may include both large and small capitalization companies. The amount invested in any one country will vary depending upon the economic, investment and market opportunities within each region. The Fund will be primarily invested in equity and equity-related securities. This is an all-capitalization global equity fund that may also invest in short term, and money market securities from time to time. This Fund utilizes Matco's investment management expertise with an overlay of non-proprietary management in pursuit of a Growth at a Reasonable Price (GARP) style. Matco seeks to maintain a portfolio that is well diversified between asset class, style, and market capitalization. The Fund will generally be 100% exposed to stocks.

### **Risk**

The overall and specific risks of investing in the Fund are as described in the Fund's Simplified Prospectus dated June 3, 2025. There were no material changes to the Fund during the period that affected the overall level of risk associated with an investment in the Fund. The risk rating of the Fund is medium.

### **Results of Operations**

The Fund's net assets increased to \$179 million at December 31, 2025 from \$151 million at December 31, 2024. Total investment gain for the year ended December 31, 2025 was \$25 million, prior to other income and operating expenses, up from \$22 million investment gain for the year ended December 31, 2024.

Matco Global Equity Series O gained 14.78% vs 16.56% of the benchmark. Our currency hedged European position has been the largest contributor the underperformance. While selection and allocation were positive, the currency hedge has negatively impacted fund performance by 2% year to date.

## **Recent Developments**

The global economy is positioned in relatively positive territory for 2026. Accelerating GDP, increased private investment, and low energy commodity prices should support further economic expansion. While labour markets are in balance with a modest slow down, we believe the economic prospects for 2026 are positive.

Inflation in the U.S. is the biggest risk to markets. As a return of inflation would change monetary policy and shake markets. We would categorize this risk as a two out of five. It is there, and a spike in energy prices would be the catalyst for a return of inflation. We will have to wait to see how the economy operates and would not expect this to be upgraded to a three or four out of five until the third quarter of 2026 if not later.

Earnings momentum is strong and increased investment from the private sector should support Q1 and Q2 earnings in the first half of 2026. The monetization of A.I. is a key risk but we would expect that investment in the technology will potentially moderate in the second half of 2026 which would give way to another increase in free cash flows. This is a risk to 2027 but unlikely to be a risk in 2026.

Valuations are heightened. The multiple expansion globally in Ex-U.S. markets is a risk to global investors as the earnings will need to materialize in 2026 to justify that valuation. If that does not materialize the developed ex-U.S. markets could face a more subdued year as investors weigh their patience versus a return to U.S. markets for earnings growth. While the U.S. Market is priced at a premium to the rest of the world, there will need to be a significant shake in confidence for that valuation to contract. We would view this as a black swan event and will use diversification to moderate the potential impact while remaining fully invested.

## **Related Party Transactions**

### **Management Fees**

Matco provides the Fund with investment management services, including managing the investment portfolio, providing investment analysis and recommendations, making investment decisions, making brokerage arrangements for the purchase and sale of the investment portfolio and providing other services. In return, Matco receives a management fee based on the net assets of the Fund, calculated on a daily basis.

For the year ended December 31, 2025, the Fund incurred management fees payable to Matco of \$231,932 (year ended December 31, 2024 - \$195,596).

### **Investment Review Committee**

An Investment Review Committee ("IRC") has been established by the Manager in accordance with *National Instrument 81-107 Independent Review Committee for Investment Funds* ("NI 81-107"). The IRC must review and approve conflict of interest matters as referred by the Manager. The Fund did not refer any related party transactions or conflict of interest matters to the IRC during the year ended December 31, 2025 or 2024.

- (2) Net assets and distributions are based on the actual number of shares outstanding at the relevant time. The increase (decrease) from operations is based on the weighted average number of shares outstanding over the financial period.
- (3) Distributions were paid in cash/reinvested in additional shares of the Fund, or both.
- (4) The information is prepared in accordance with IFRS which uses the last trade price for investments that are traded in an active market where quoted prices are readily and regularly available. For investments that are not traded in an active market, the Fund uses valuation techniques that maximize the use of relevant observable inputs and minimize the use of unobservable inputs.
- (5) This information is provided as at the year shown, as applicable, except for Series N results for 2018 are from inception February 6, 2018 through December 31, 2018 and Series A results for 2021 are from January 1, 2021 through December 1, 2021.
- (6) Management expense ratio is based on total expenses for the stated period and is expressed as an annualized percentage of daily average net asset value during the year/period.
- (7) The Fund's portfolio turnover rate indicates how actively the Fund's portfolio advisor manages its portfolio investments. A portfolio turnover rate of 100% is equivalent to the Fund buying and selling all of the securities in its portfolio once in the course of the period. The higher a fund's portfolio turnover rate in a period, the greater the trading costs payable by the fund in the period, and the greater the chance of an investor receiving taxable capital gains in the period. There is not necessarily a relationship between a high turnover rate and the performance of a fund.
- (8) The trading expense ratio represents total commissions and other portfolio transaction costs expressed as an annualized percentage of daily average net assets during the year/period.
- (9) Effective December 31, 2025, the Management Expense Ratio for years 2020-2024 was restated to include the effect of underlying funds' expenses. This change does not reflect higher actual costs, and all expenses were processed correctly, with no impact on fund performance or returns.

**Management Fees**

The annual management fee rate, exclusive of sales taxes, is 1.15% for Series F. No management fees are charged directly to Series O.

During the year ended December 31, 2025, management fees totaled \$231,932 (year ended December 31, 2024 - \$195,596). Included in liabilities at December 31, 2025 is \$21,453 (December 31, 2024 - \$18,555) in respect of these fees.

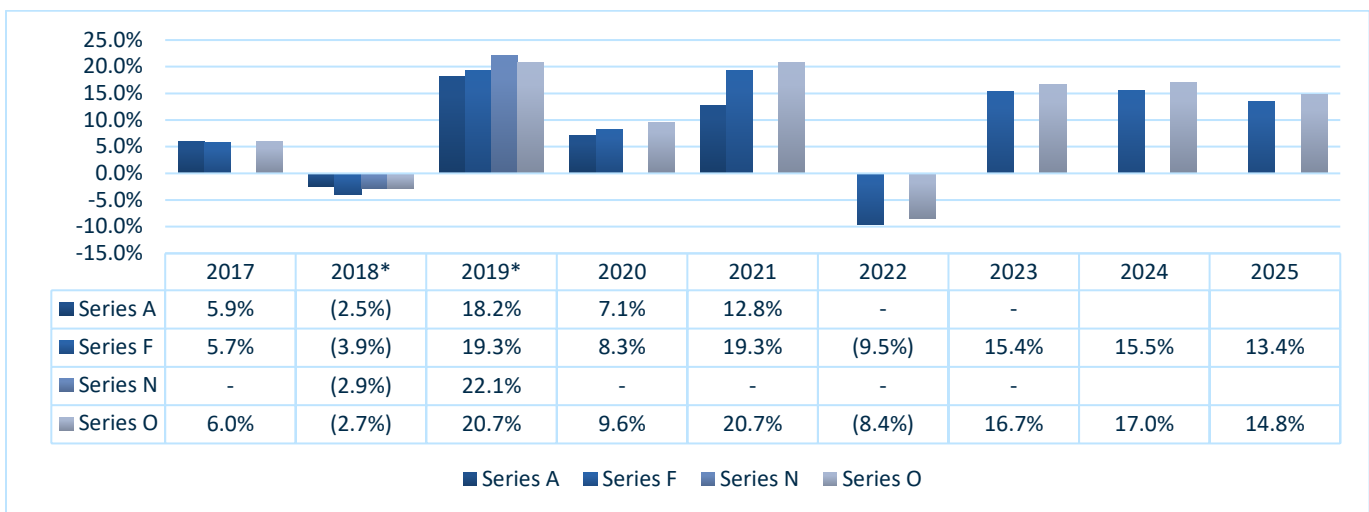
All management fees paid by Series F were applied to cover portfolio management and other services provided to the Fund by the Manager. No such fees were used to pay for external portfolio advisory fees, trailing or other sales commissions.

**PAST PERFORMANCE**

-The Benchmark of the Fund is Vanguard Total World Stock ETF, which better reflects emerging market exposures globally. In addition, given Matco's private client investor base, who often look at ETFs as a substitute for active investment solutions, the ETF better fulfills the investable portion of the benchmark suitability criteria. Matco has chosen to be consistent across all mandates by benchmarking against ETFs for this reason.
