What food items do you accept?

Accepted Donations

- Non-perishable, shelf-stable food items (must include ingredient labels)
- Produce from home gardens
- USDA-approved processed meat (must be labeled)
- Hard-frozen items in original packaging (must be labeled)

What food items do you not accept?

- Homemade canned goods
- Items without ingredient lists
- Unsealed packaging
- Damaged cans with spillage or rust
- Expired baby food, OTC medicines, or prescription medications

Will God's Pantry drop off and/or pick up blue barrels for food drives?

Yes, we can drop off and pick up barrels if you need more than 2 barrels or 4 large boxes. Please give us 2 weeks' notice.

How do I get a blue barrel or tote?

You can register your food drive here! In Fayette County, if you need 1 or less barrels, please pick them up at our **Distribution** Center (817 Winchester Road, Lexington, KY 40505).

• For more than 2 barrels, indicate this in your registration.

Can you pick up my donations from my house?

No, we are unable to pick up donations from individual residences.

How long should my food drive be?

Most food drives are successfully held for 2-4 weeks, but you can run yours for as long—or as short—as you'd like.

Choose a timeframe that works best for your group and goals.
