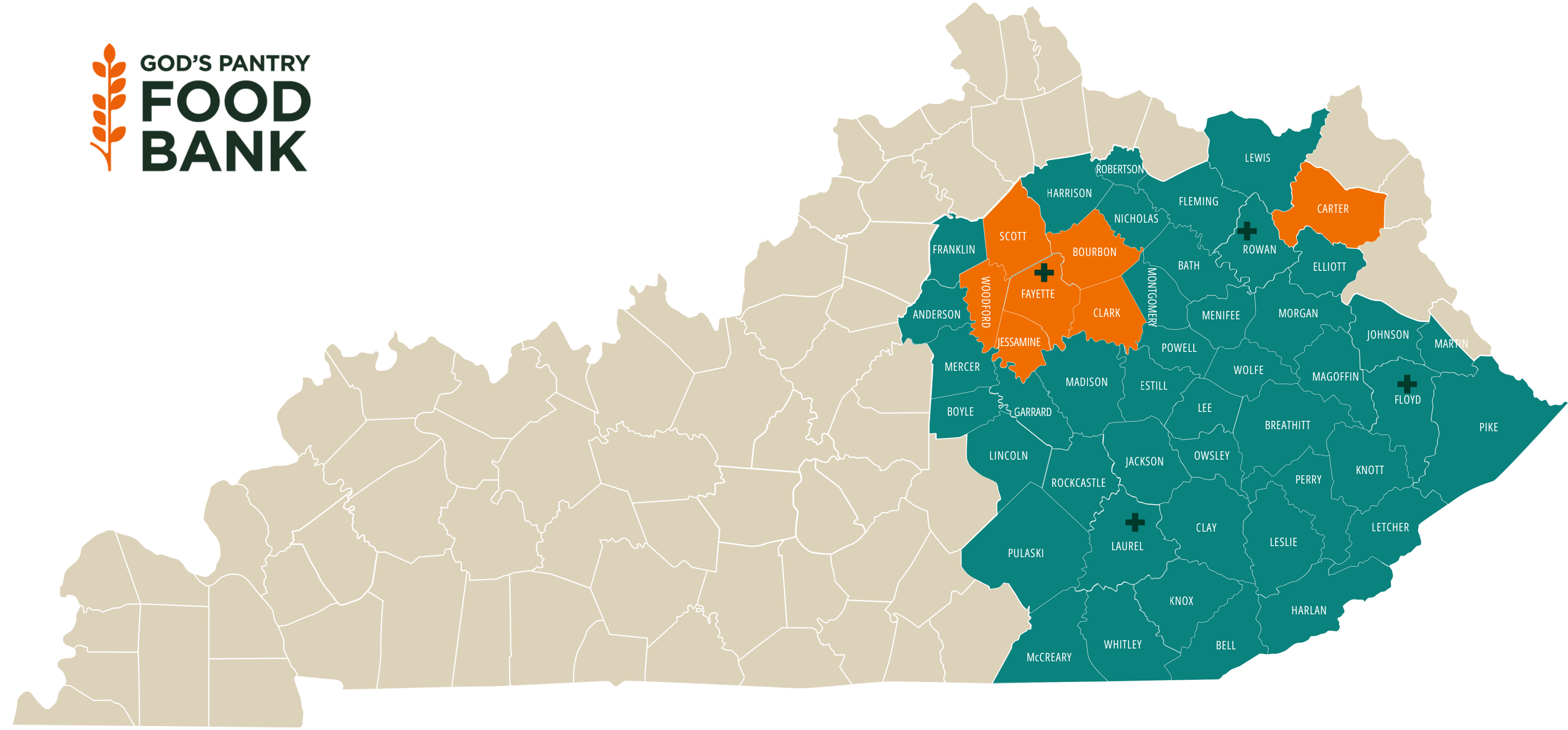

# HUNGER IN CENTRAL AND EASTERN KENTUCKY

- There are nearly 280,000 food-insecure individuals in God's Pantry Food Bank service area.
- 1 in 4 children are experiencing food insecurity in Central and Eastern Kentucky.
- 19 of most food-insecure counties in the country are in the God's Pantry Food Bank service area.

- Kentucky is the 7th most food-insecure state in the nation.

# FY 2025 HIGHLIGHTS

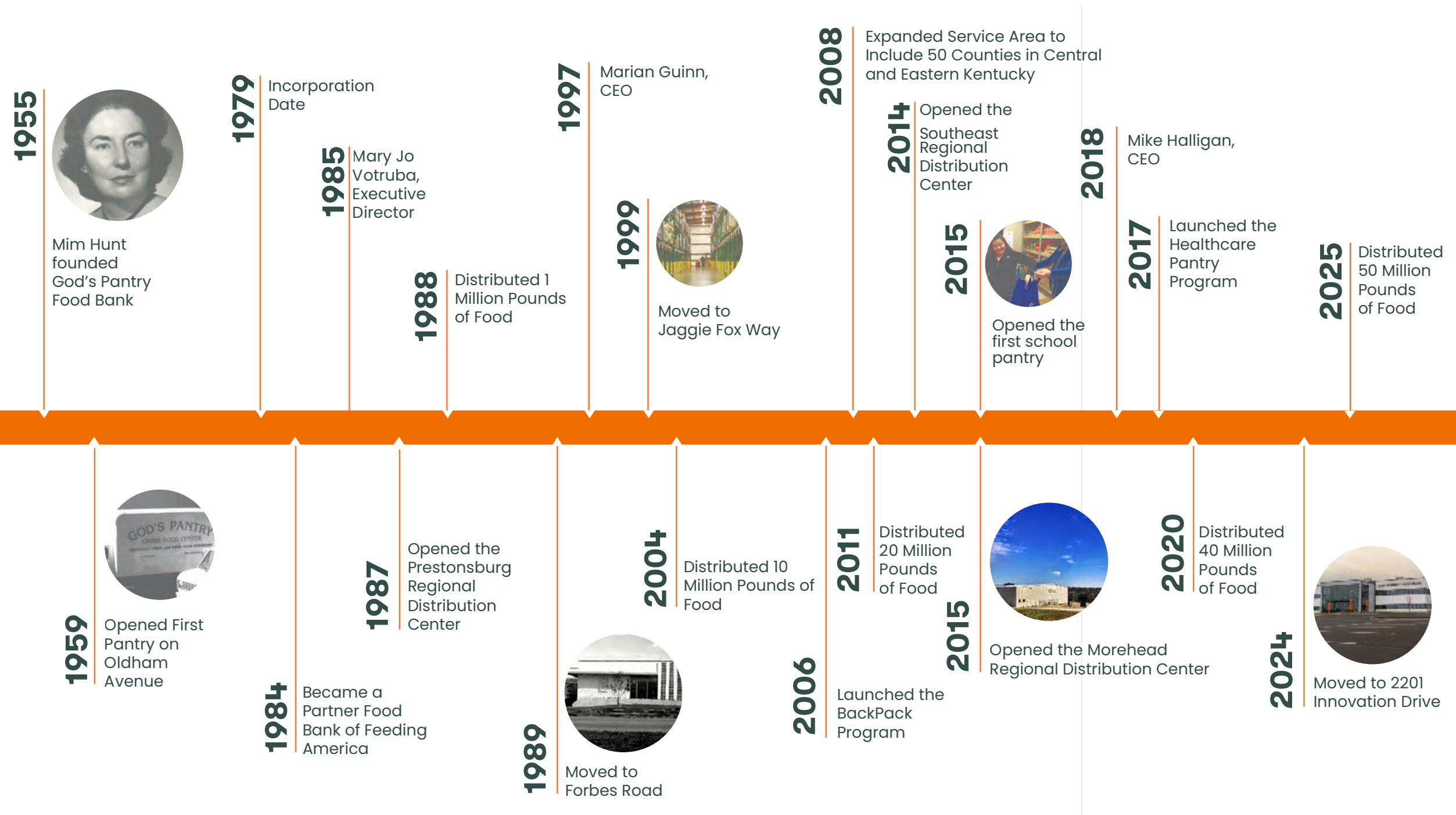
- 500+ partner food pantries and meal programs
- 51 million pounds of food distributed, helping create more than 42.5 million meals
- 20 million pounds of fresh produce distributed.
- 31,655 volunteer hours spent packing emergency boxes, sorting food, distributing food, and creating cards for our senior commodity boxes
- More than 12 million pounds of food rescued through our Food Rescue Program
