as The Maywoods. The band is named after Prine's hometown of Maywood, Illinois.

The Maywoods are coming to Clayton Hall on Saturday, May 11, with tickets available at TicketsPlease.ca. Doors open at 6:30 p.m., with the licensed event running from 7

to 8:30 p.m. General admission tickets are \$19.46 — the year Prine was born — plus processing fees. A limited number of tickets will also be available at the door.

As part of its mission to encourage live music in rural communities, the band is contributing 25 per cent of ticket proceeds to the care and upkeep of the hall.
