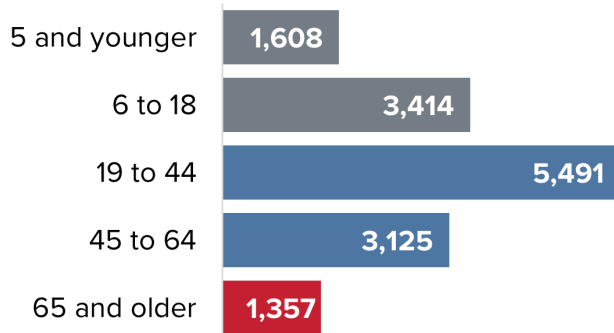
## Athens County



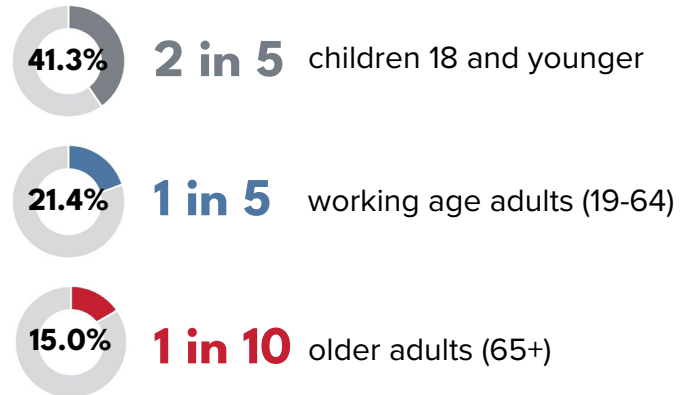
**14,994**

### Age of Medicaid Enrollees

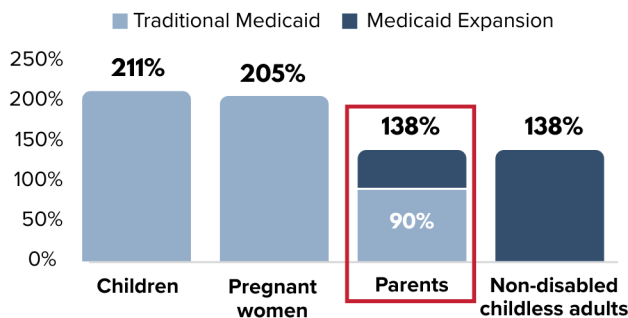


### In Athens County, Medicaid covers:

(100% FPL = \$15,650 for a single person; \$26,650 for a family of 3)



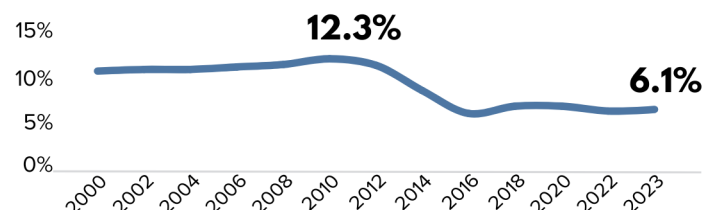
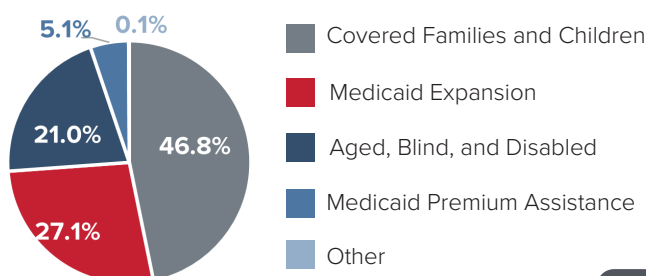
### Nearly half of all Ohioans with Medicaid Expansion work.

Others are students, caretakers, or dealing with a chronic health condition.

### Ohio's uninsured rate is half of what it was before Medicaid expansion.

Preventive care and treating conditions early reduce the need for high-cost emergency room visits, long hospital stays, and additional public spending.

4,056 adults are enrolled in Medicaid Expansion in Athens County. The Medicaid caseload is comprised of several major groups:
