



# Neighborhood, Built Environment, and Housing

### HOUSING AFFORDABILITY

About 4 in 10 houses in Ward 3 are owned, and 6 in 10 houses are rented. Of those occupied by homeowners, about 74.4% live in housing that is affordable to them, meaning their housing costs do not exceed 30% of the household income, compared to 47.5% of renters who live in affordable housing.


#### Housing composition in Ward 3


