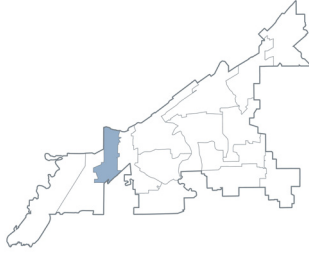

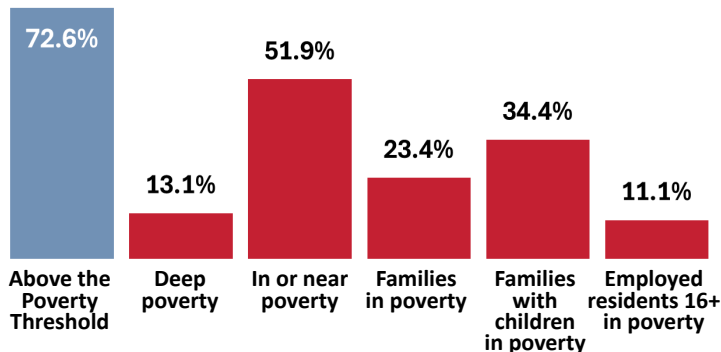

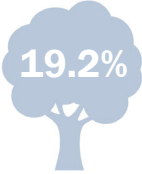

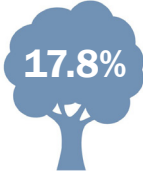

- ✓ Offering social, educational, & aesthetic benefits

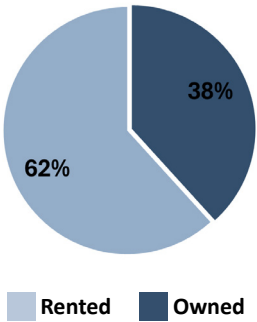

## Neighborhood, Built Environment, and Housing

### HOUSING AFFORDABILITY

About 4 in 10 houses in Ward 12 are owned, and 6 in 10 houses are rented. Of those occupied by homeowners, about 74.7% live in housing that is affordable to them, meaning their housing costs do not exceed 30% of the household income, compared to 59.2% of renters who live in affordable housing.

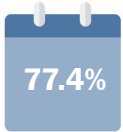
### ESTIMATED AVERAGE LIFE EXPECTANCY OF RESIDENTS

### POOR MENTAL HEALTH STATUS IN THE LAST MONTH

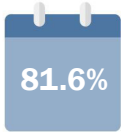
