



HOUSING AFFORDABILITY

About 6 in 10 houses in Ward 13 are owned, and 4 in 10 houses are rented. Of those occupied by homeowners, about 76.2% live in housing that is affordable to them, meaning their housing costs do not exceed 30% of the household income, compared to 51.0% of renters who live in affordable housing.
