Note:

1. For students who are also enrolled in Harley's **VCE Chemistry Units 3/4 Program**, we recommend attending the **Saturday 10:30-12:30pm or 4:30-6:30pm** as Harley will deliver his VCE Chemistry Units 3/4 session on **Saturday 2:00-4:00pm**.

Having both VCE English Language and VCE Chemistry sessions done on the same day would be more convenient.

2. **MacRob students** are encouraged to attend either Groups A-D in December 2025 and January 2026. In February 2026, you are encouraged to attend Group E. This is because MacRob is one of the only schools in Victoria to have Essay as part of their first SAC. Most other schools have AC or SAQ as their first SAC.

Essay SAC requires different preparation in terms of content and thus deserves its own group. If you are not from MacRob, but also have Essay SAC as SAC 1, you are also encouraged to join the same class as MacRob students.

In February, Group A-D students will focus on AC/SAQ SAC preparation, while Group E students will focus on Essay SAC preparation. After March 2026 (when Group E students have completed their Essay SAC), Group E will be available for all students to join as all groups will cover the same content for the rest of the course.

Masterclass Program

Each year, Harley will personally select **15-20 outstanding students** to form the **Masterclass**. This is an **invitation-only program**, offered **free of charge**, and designed exclusively for students who demonstrate exceptional potential.

- Students who score in the **top 80%** of the **entry test** will be granted immediate entry into the Masterclass, commencing in **late August 2026**.
- Students who do not qualify directly may remain under **further examination and observation** before final decisions are made.

- Progress will be **closely monitored** through ongoing assessments.
